Romans 11:11-12, "Again I ask: Did they stumble so as to fall beyond recovery? Not at all! Rather, because of their transgression, salvation has come to the Nations to make Israel envious. But if their transgression means riches for the world, and their loss means riches for the Gentiles, how much greater riches will their full inclusion bring!"

Over the years, I have focused on traveling to the nations, sharing the revelations the Father has shown me through the Scriptures, testing the messages and biblical interpretations with thousands to confirm their truth. We have also supported and edified the body of Messiah in Israel and the Nations while helping many avoid the pitfalls of religion and legalism as we minister from the Hebraic foundation of our faith, vigorously contesting Judaism and its Talmudic practices within the Yeshua believing communities.

As many of you know, I have been recovering from surgery for the past three weeks. I want to thank everyone for your prayers and messages. During this time, I have had a great time in the Scriptures and prayer, seeking Elohim's guidance and direction to increase our witness of Yeshua in this very challenging time here in Israel.

I have been blessed in the presence of YHVH and have seen a glimpse of what is to come.

In the ten years, we have been in the land, we have had great opportunities to share the Gospel in English and broken Hebrew with thousands of Israelis. Many of those individuals heard about Yeshua for the first time, listening intently as I uncovered the testimony of the Messiah through the Tanakh. What a blessing it has been to watch people's eyes open to Yeshua of Nazareth, many weeping as their hearts opened to the Messiah's presence! However, the extensive travel and business ventures to support the ministry has cost me greatly when it comes to learning the Hebrew language.

I believe that we are entering a new season of growth for me personally and for the ministry, as I prepare for what it will take to become fluent in Hebrew to minister locally. As a disciple in Yeshua, my goal is to bear much fruit in all that I do, so absorbing into the Land will now be my top priority of this season.

I know that accomplishing this goal will cause BulldozerFaith to need additional financial support, so I would like to ask you to stand with me as I restructure my time to learn the language.

Today, I am stepping out in faith, believing that YHVH will provide our family's every need, along with the needs of the ministry. To launch into the new, we are taking up a seed offering and asking that you consider sowing a one-time seed or, for those who don't already give monthly, to sow regularly into the ministry as we step into this new direction.

Discipleship has always been the passion of my heart; it is not enough to teach the Scriptures but to save the lost. In many areas where the Spirit leads, He takes us down the path of difficulty or impossibility, causing us to get out of our comfort zones. The weight of the calling Yah has on our lives is in identifying the best path of effectiveness. This is not always about the easiest route to take, but knowing the impact Yeshua will have in the Land will bring an increase of souls beyond anything we could imagine as we seek to be a blessing in Israel in everything that we do.

A big part of me wanted to move to an English-speaking country where I could be more effective, but I now see more clearly that we have been positioned in Israel for such a time as this and we need to absorb!

So, how do we maximize our witness and become a greater blessing to the Kingdom? I am gearing up to go on a new journey to master the ability to minister in modern Hebrew and biblical Hebrew, training in a higher level of Hebrew evangelism.

"How, then, can they call on the one they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the one of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they have been sent? As it is written: 'How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!'" Romans 10:14-15

S BULLDOZERFAITH

Before Yeshua started His ministry, John the immerser prepared the way for the Messiah by teaching repentance. He warned the religious leaders of the day every tree that did not produce good fruit would be cut down and thrown into the fire.

"I immerse you with water for repentance. But after me comes one who is more powerful than I, whose sandals I am not worthy to carry. He will immerse you with the Holy Spirit and fire. His winnowing fork is in His hand, and He will clear the threshing floor, gathering His wheat into the barn and burning up the chaff with unquenchable fire." Matthew 3:11-12

Even though Yeshua was not a sinner, He was mikvahed (immersed) to 'fulfill all righteousness,' and immediately after, the Holy Spirit came down and settled on Him.

"As soon as Yeshua was mikvahed, He went up out of the water. At that moment, heaven was opened, and He saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove and alighting on Him. And a voice from heaven said, "This is my Son. in whom I love; with Him, I am well pleased." Matthew 3:16-17

Mikvah (Immersion) is also one of the first steps we take as we come into salvation through Yeshua HaMachiach and follow His example.

"If you declare with your mouth, 'Yeshua is Elohim,' and believe in your heart that Yehovah raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved." Roman 10:9-10

Salvation through Yeshua is offered to everyone in the world.

"As the Scripture says, 'Anyone who believes in Him will never be put to shame.' For there is no difference between Yehudi (Jew) and Greek - the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on Him, for, 'Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved." Romans 10 11-13

After Yeshua went through a time of testing in the wilderness by Ha'Satan, He settled in Capernaum, fulfilling prophecy and starting His ministry with the same message that John the Immerser delivered. "Land of Zebulun and land of Naphtali, the Way of the Sea, beyond the Jordan, Galilee of the Nations - the people living in darkness have seen a great light; on those in the land of the shadow of death, a light has dawned. From that time on, Yeshua began to preach, 'Repent, for the Kingdom of heaven has come near.'" Matthew 4:15-17

It was not by chance that the Messiah began His ministry at the exact location where the Northern Kingdom was expelled and divorced because of their disobedience and unfaithfulness to Yehovah. The Northern Kingdom was captured by force by the Assyrians and taken into slavery. These eventually became the tribes scattered into the nations.

The Southern Kingdom was also taken into captivity by the Babylonians but not divorced; however, the marriage covenant ended following the death of Yeshua. Romans 7 and Ephesians 2. Yeshua came to eventually restore the two kingdoms together through His gift of salvation as their Savior and King. The ultimate purpose is a complete restoration back to the Father.

Ezekiel prophesied there would again be one nation under one King. Those of us who are of the nations are included in this promise. We are also called "Israel" and partake of all the blessings of being in covenant with Yehovah through Yeshua HaMachiach.

"The word of the Lord came to me: "Son of man, take a stick of wood and write on it, 'Belonging to Judah and the Israelites associated with him.' Then take another stick of wood, and write on it, 'Belonging to Joseph (that is, to Ephraim) and all the Israelites associated with him.' Join them together into one stick so that they will become one in your hand.

"When your people ask you, 'Won't you tell us what you mean by this?' say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I am going to take the stick of Joseph—which is in Ephraim's hand—and of the Israelite tribes associated with him and join it to Judah's stick. I will make them into a single stick of wood, and they will become one in my hand.'

Hold before their eyes the sticks you have written on and say to them, 'This is what the Sovereign Lord says: I will take the Israelites out of the nations where they have gone. I will gather them from all around and bring them back into their own land.

I will make them one nation in the land, on the mountains of Israel. There will be one King over all of them, and they will never again be two nations or be divided into two kingdoms.

They will no longer defile themselves with their idols and vile images or with any of their offenses, for I will save them from all their sinful backsliding, and I will cleanse them. They will be my people, and I will be their God.

"My servant David will be King over them, and they will all have one Shepherd. They will follow my laws and be careful to keep my decrees. They will live in the land I gave to my servant Jacob, the land where your ancestors lived. They and their children and their children's children will live there forever, and David, my servant, will be their prince forever.

I will make a covenant of peace with them; it will be an everlasting covenant. I will establish them and increase their numbers, and I will put my sanctuary among them forever. My dwelling place will be with them; I will be their God, and they will be my people.

Then the nations will know that I the Lord make Israel holy, when my sanctuary is among them forever.' "Ezekial 37:15-28



During Yeshua's ministry on earth, the example He left us to follow was not only to proclaim the Good News of the Kingdom but also to heal the sick of every type of disease, to cast out demons, to make the blind see and the paralyzed walk, and to speak in His Name and by His authority through the power of the indwelling of the Ruach HaKodesh, the Holy Spirit.

During the Sermon On The Mount, Yeshua taught the characteristics of the Kingdom through the Beatitudes. Matthew 5-7

"Blessed are you when people insult you, persecute you and falsely say all kinds of evil against you because of me. Rejoice and be glad, because great is your reward in heaven, for, in the same way, they persecuted the prophets who were before you. Matthew 5:11

The Great Commission is when Yeshua sent the apostles out to spread the gospel and make more disciples.

"Therefore go and make disciples of all the nations, immersing them in my name, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely I am with you always, to the very end of the age." Matthew 28:19-20

Once again, in Mark, Yeshua sends the disciples out to the whole world to share the gospel with signs that will accompany those who believe, confirming His Word.

"He said to them, 'Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation." Mark 16:15 "And these signs will accompany those who believe: In my name, they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well." Mark 16:17-18

"Then the disciples went out and preached everywhere, and the Lord worked with them and confirmed His Word by the signs that accompanied it." Mark 16:20

Yeshua calls the disciples His 'witnesses' We also are His witnesses. We can share what the disciples saw and our own experiences as a believer in Yeshua HaMachiach.

"But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you, and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth." Acts 1:8



Growing in Faith – Matthew 13

Matthew 13:2-9, "...A farmer went out to sow his seed. As he was scattering the seed, some fell along the path, and the birds came and ate it up. Some fell on rocky places, where it did not have much soil. It sprang up quickly because the soil was shallow. But when the sun came up, the plants were scorched, and they withered because they had no root. Other seed fell among thorns, which grew up and choked the plants. Still other seed fell on good soil, where it produced a crop—a hundred, sixty, or thirty times what was sown. Whoever has ears, let them hear."

At the end of most sermons, a pastor will end his Sunday service by asking if anyone would like to accept Jesus/Yeshua into their hearts. After leading them in a simple prayer, church members applaud those who were brave enough to accept their savior into their hearts publicly. In their minds, they have successfully brought people into fellowship with the Father; however, when the moment ends and the last song is sung, everyone begins to make their way to lunch and continue with their day, leaving the people who had just prayed the 'prayer of salvation' wondering to themselves, "So, what's next?"

Opening our eyes to the reality of the Messiah is an awakening experience, but what do we do once we hear the Good News and accept the Messiah as our savior? Our relationship with God might have begun with a simple prayer, but until we lay our lives at Yeshua's feet and welcome him wholly into our lives to guide and speak to us, our roots will not be planted deep enough into the soil.

I hear people proclaim that salvation is a gift from God, and while he has opened his heart to those who desire to follow him and forgives us of all of our sins when we ask, our salvation comes at the cost of the worldly lives we were living. To be a follower of the Messiah and fully embrace the calling he has placed on our hearts, we must not only proclaim that Yeshua is Lord but remove our carnal beings, putting on our new identity in Yeshua. This means turning away from our sinful desires and setting our hearts on the Father. (Galatians 5:16-26)

The call to salvation is so much more than attending church, accepting Yeshua into our hearts, and saying that we believe; but, where are the disciples who will minister the truth to these new believers, sowing them into good fruitful soil?

Whoever has ears to hear, let them hear!

The first step of faith is opening our ears to hear the Word of the Lord. All over the Bible, it speaks about inclining our ears to hear God's Word; but, once we hear the gospel, we must continue to grow and mature, keeping our roots firmly planted in the soil of the Word!

A new believer is like a child in need of guidance. One would never expect a newborn baby to have the ability to fend for itself, so why do we not think the same for those who accept Yeshua?

Maturity comes through discipleship and relationship; however, the growing process never stops! A person needs more than one teaching to lead them into a life of promise. While we must sow the seeds of God wherever we go, we should also be the workers who not only scatter but till, water and harvest the crop!

A farmer went out to sow his seed

As Believers in Yeshua, it is our duty to speak the Word of God and disciple people when they begin their walk of faith. God uses us all to sow seeds of his Word into people's lives, but our work is far from done when a person says yes to Yeshua. In fact, it is only the beginning!

The sun-scorched path

"When anyone hears the message about the kingdom and does not understand it, the evil one comes and snatches away what was sown in their heart. This is the seed sown along the path." Matthew 13:19

Speaking to a person about the Bible or Yeshua is a great way to open people's ears to his truth; but, unless a person is ready to hear the Gospel of Truth and have a two-sided conversation, the seed will ultimately be thrown on the sun-scorched path.

Asking the Father to show us who to speak to and what to say gives us spiritual insight to know who has ears ready to hear the Word of God. Many of us have people on our hearts who we want to see saved, but until their ears are opened to understand the love of our Heavenly Father, all we can do is continue to pray for them and show them who our savior is through the testimony of our lives.

On rocky ground

"The seed falling on rocky ground refers to someone who hears the Word and at once receives it with joy. But since they have no root, they last only a short time. When trouble or persecution comes because of the Word, they quickly fall away." Matthew 13:20-21

The road to salvation is a rocky path. Unless our roots have taken ahold of the soil, the moment persecution or trials come our way; our faith will be uprooted and tossed aside.

One of the statements preachers or other believers say to bring people to Jesus is that the Lord is a loving and accepting God, and being in fellowship with him brings complete freedom, joy, and forgiveness! While these are all true statements, there is no doubt that being a believer opens us up to major attacks from the enemy. Tiptoeing around this reality causes people to hear the truth under false pretense and will lead them to turn away from the joy they have found in the Messiah when the first trial comes their way.

Unless prepared by the farmer, a seed will not be protected from the world's harsh elements, and its root will have nothing to keep it in place when storms come it's way.

Deep in the thorns

"The seed falling among the thorns refers to someone who hears the word, but the worries of this life and the deceitfulness of wealth choke the word, making it unfruitful." Matthew 13:22

The world is an unforgiving place, and we must fight to survive. There is no comfort in the unknown, and the devil uses that worry to fill our minds with reasons why we need to take care of ourselves rather than trusting in the Father. Worry, entertainment, wealth, success, fulfillment, acceptance, comfort, and possessions are just some of the thorns that stifle us from growing and connecting closer to God. There are enough worries and distractions in the world to last us a lifetime, but let me ask you, how often have you seen your doubt or decisions hold you back from the calling God has placed on your heart?

In school, teachers ask us, "What do you want to be when you grow up?" Depending on your age, the answers are usually a profession that obtains success and money. Many of us are raised learning about the importance of finding a path that will bring us enough money to care for our future families, live in a nice home, and have a pension that will keep us comfortable in our retirement years.

For some, life and adventure can wait until retirement, when they have collected enough savings to fulfill the dreams they have had since childhood. However, Yeshua isn't calling us to wait until we have enough money to do what He is asking us to do; He's calling us NOW! I believe that everyone has a purpose, but not everyone will have the faith or courage to follow after that calling.

Those planted in the thorns keep Yeshua at arm's length, proclaiming their faith while continuing to hold onto the worries and cares of this world.

How many years will you remain choked by the thorns before you ask the Father to set you free? There are indeed essentials required to staying alive and healthy in this world, but do you not believe that God will provide and keep you alive while you live in obedience and walk by his leading?

In an era where the world is telling us that being successful is measured by our followers on social media, it is difficult to break the mold and decide on the path based on faith rather than man. Eyes will be watching you as you step out of the status quo and follow the voice of the Holy Spirit; however, whose opinions or thoughts are more important to you, the opinions of this world or God's?

Growth in the field

"But the seed falling on good soil refers to someone who hears the Word and understands it. This is the one who produces a crop, yielding a hundred, sixty or thirty times what was sown." Matthew 13:23

Being a disciple of Yeshua is not only about asking him to dwell in our hearts; it's also about living by the Spirit, using our time on earth to spread his truth, and following his voice when he calls. Being planted in fruitful soil means that we have the Holy Spirit living in us and rely on Him to direct our footsteps. Our lives are not our own, and while the trials will be many, our faith will not crumble, and Satan will not prevail because our roots are firmly planted in the foundation of the Word and Yeshua!

Growth, faith, and obedience take time to obtain, believe me, so please do not be discouraged if you face a trial and feel your balance shaking. Every day we are growing and learning more about the kingdom of God, and each morning we need to decide if we're going to continue walking by faith. There are many moments in the day where we will falter, but God is patient and willing to teach us if we are open to listening to his instructions.

We have the amazing advantage of social media and the internet to spread God's Word and be his disciples, so there is no excuse for using this time to sit at home and keep quiet while millions are scared, tired, lost, angry, needy, depressed, and crying out for someone to relieve their pain and suffering. Let us not be people who are looking to gain another notch in their belts; instead, let us pray for those who are lost, and be a listening ear and helper to those who have ears to hear, eyes to see, and hearts that understand the calling God has set on their lives.
