"Then He opened their minds so they could understand the Scriptures.

He told them, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in his name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem.

You are witnesses of these things.

I am going to send you what my Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high." (Luke 24:45-49)

For the last few months, we have been focusing on the importance of walking in the truth of the Gospel in Yeshua's Kingdom. There is a reason Yeshua warned us over and over again that in these last days, there would be many false gospels taught and an endless stream of false teachers. We see this in the online community the most because it has expanded our reach globally, and anyone can create an account and call themselves a teacher of the Word without any accountability to anyone but themselves.

What we have to remember is that there were two trees in the garden, one produced the 'TRUTH' which is the Word, who is Yeshua, and the other produced "the knowledge of good and evil.' which is a counterfeit word that satan uses to take Yehovah's people off track. But really, what it does is weed out the false followers of the Word. The ones who want all the glory but have no commitment. The ones who walk after the flesh but not the Spirit of Elohim.

"You belong to your father, the devil, and you want to carry out your father's desires. He was a murderer from the beginning, not holding to the truth, for there is no truth in him. When he lies, he speaks his native language, for he is a liar and the father of lies." (John 8:44)

So satan cannot speak the truth because he has no truth in him, he only has the 'knowledge' of truth and this is how he deceives.

So when someone is talking, and you hear words of truth being spoken by them, it is not a sign that they are from Elohim. Yes, they may be speaking some truth, even satan, some truth. But it's not the "knowledge of the truth' that sets us free. It the "TRUTH" itself, Yeshua who is the TRUTH.

"Not everyone who says to me, 'Lord, Lord,' will enter the Kingdom of heaven, but only the one who does the will of My Father who is in heaven. Many will say to Me on that day, 'Lord, Lord, did we not prophesy in your name and in your name drive out demons and in your name perform many miracles?' Then I will tell them plainly, 'I never knew you. Away from me, you evildoers!" (Matthew 7:21-23)

You can see from this scripture, spoken by Yeshua himself; He knows the plans of the enemy and how he will deceive many in these times.

That's why He told his disciples to wait for the Ruach HaKodesh to come before they went out and preached the Gospel. The Holy Spirit gives us the power to walk in the TRUTH and not to be deceived. We are the 'elect' when we walk in the Spirit of God and in the will of the Father. The Spirit warns us where to go and where not to go, He gives us the leading, and it is by walking this way that our steps are 'ordered' by the Lord, and we walk in LIGHT, not darkness.

"Trust in the Lord with all your heart and lean not on your own understanding; in all your ways submit to Him, and He will make your paths straight." (Proverbs 3:5-6)

"By their fruit you will recognize them. Do people pick grapes from thorn bushes, or figs from thistles? Likewise, every good tree bears good fruit, but a bad tree bears bad fruit. A good tree cannot bear bad fruit, and a bad tree cannot bear good fruit. Every tree that does not bear good fruit is cut down and thrown into the fire.

Thus, by their fruit you will recognize them." (Matthew 7:16-20)

So, 'by their fruits, you will know them." We should all be showing signs of the Fruit of the Spirit in our lives as we grow in Yeshua and allow Him to change us from the inside out. This is how we can be discerning when we are listening to a new teacher or another believer. We can look for the fruit of the Ruach HaKodesh in their lives, and if we are in a position to be teaching anyone in the Kingdom of Elohim, we should be able to hear the voice of the Spirit and to be speaking only Yeshua's TRUTH.

"Very truly I tell you Pharisees, anyone who does not enter the sheep pen by the gate, but climbs in by some other way, is a thief and a robber.

The one who enters by the gate is the shepherd of the sheep.

The gatekeeper opens the gate for him, and the sheep listen to his voice.

He calls his own sheep by name and leads them out.

When he has brought out all his own, he goes on ahead of them, and his sheep follow him because they know his voice.

But they will never follow a stranger; in fact, they will run away from him because they do not recognize a stranger's voice." (John 10:2-5)

Yeshua was telling this parable to the Pharisees, and of course, they didn't understand because they were ruled by a religious spirit, not by the Spirit of God. This is the same for any religions today that are not baptized in the Spirit as is necessary for salvation. This is why Yehovah gave us His Spirit to live inside of us - to lead us into salvation. He guides our every step because the way is fraught with danger on every side that leads to our destruction. We have to keeps our eyes and ears on Him at all times and not look to the left or the right. The WORD (Yeshua) says HE is a 'lamp to our feet and a light to our path" (Psalms 119:105)

"The Spirit of the Sovereign Lord is on me, because the Lord has anointed me to proclaim good news to the poor.

He has sent me to bind up the brokenhearted, to proclaim freedom for the captives and release from darkness for the prisoners, to proclaim the year of the Lord's favor and the day of vengeance of our God, to comfort all who mourn, and provide for those who grieve in Zion—to bestow on them a crown of beauty instead of ashes, the oil of joy instead of mourning, and a garment of praise instead of a spirit of despair.

They will be called oaks of righteousness, a planting of the Lord for the display of his splendor." (Isaiah 61:1-3)

## FRUITS IN THE KINGDOM

FRUIT OF THE FLESH (Galatians 5:19-21)

SEXUAL IMMORALITY - any sexual activity that does not conform to Yehovah's revealed laws.

DEBAUCHERY - excessive indulgences in bodily pleasures including sex, alcohol or drugs

IDOLATRY - the worship of someone or something other than Elohim as if it was Elohim.

WITCHCRAFT - sorcery and divination, dealing in black magic and spells.

HATRED - intense dislike or ill will towards others.

DISCORD - distrust among one another.

JEALOUSY - very watchful or careful in guarding or keeping someone or something, resentfully 'envious.'

FITS OF RAGE - displaying a very bad temper

SELFISH AMBITION - desire to put one's self forward without a spirit of humility

DISSENSIONS - a state or condition marked by a lack of agreement or harmony.

FACTIONS - a small organized group within a larger one working in opposition to the main group.

ENVY - a feeling of discontented or resentful longing aroused by someone else's possessions, qualities or good fortune.

DRUNKENESS - the state of being drunk, intoxication with strong liquor.

ORGIES - secret ceremonial rites in honour of Greek or Roman dieties characterized by multiple sexual encounter

FRUIT OF THE SPIRIT (Galatians 5:22-23)

LOVE - more than just romantic attraction or strong feelings towards those close to you. It also stands for the truth, respect and obedience believers hold for Yehovah.

JOY - a feeling of good pleasure and happiness that is dependant on who Yeshua is rather than on who we are or what is happening around us - comes from the Ruach HaKodesh, abiding in God's presence and from hope in His Kingdom.

PEACE - restoration leading to a state of wholeness and completeness through the work of the Spirit.

FORBEARANCE - also known as patience. We need persistence and patience to see the harvest of our work despite the obstacles.

KINDNESS - selfless, compassionate and merciful - its greatest power revealed in practice to our enemies.

GOODNESS - Holy, pure, righteousness, Godliness - can be seen in the actions of a pure heart.

FAITHFULNESS - comes from a place of trust and loyalty, requires us to submit our ways to Elohim.

GENTLENESS - showing care and respect for others in the way you act and speak.

SELF-CONTROL - choosing to give up trying to control things on our own, surrendering to Yehovah for help, and submitting to Him for change.

"So I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not gratify the desires of the flesh.

For the flesh desires what is contrary to the Spirit, and the Spirit what is contrary to the flesh.

They are in conflict with each other, so that you are not to do whatever you want.

But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the law."

(Galatians 5:16-18)

Yeshua was not born because of man's will but He was born of Elohim. Through Yeshua came GRACE and **TRUTH.** As Torah observant believers in Messiah, we are looking to the Torah to identify Yeshua. We are not looking for what is represented in the flesh but we are looking for that which is born of the promise. That's why we can go through the Torah and recognize who Yeshua is and stand on His promises.

Yeshua is the 'SEED' of Abraham, the Son of promise.

Yeshua came from the line of Judah, one of the twelve tribes of Jacob.

"The scepter will not depart from Judah, nor the ruler's staff from between his feet, UNTIL, He to whom it belongs shall come and the obedience of the nations shall be His." (Genesis 49:10)

So, Judah does not hold the scepter today and what we see in Israel now is founded on modern-day Zionism, not biblical Zionism. We don't see Yeshua, the Messiah represented in the land through modern-day Zionism as they are against Yeshua of Nazareth, and even as we see the increase of salvation in the land of Israel, it is only a manifestation of the Kingdom from above through believers. A full representation of His Kingdom is still to come. For us to be connected to Yehovah and living in the Kingdom, we have got to receive the Messiah (born of the Spirit)

"If we confess our sins, He is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9)

The truth that Yeshua brought is a 'saving' truth, not just any truth. The truth that comes from Yehovah concerning His promises brings freedom to your LIFE if we hold to His teachings.

"Then you will know the truth, and the truth will set you free." (John 8:32)

Moses bought the children of Israel up out of Egypt and brought them to Mount Sinai for marriage. This was His answer to restore fallen man. His desire was also to pour out the Ruach HaKodesh on them so Messiah could empower them to live and walk in the fullness of the promises of Yehovah. But when the commandments were spoken over them they could not handle it and asked for Moses to be the mediator. The Israelites soon broke the covenant and sinned by making and worshiping the golden calf after they had already been sprinkled with the blood of the covenant. They were standing in a place of responsibility so their failure required death. Yehovah was going to wipe them all out but Moses pleaded on their behalf for another way for atonement to be made to cleanse the people of Elohim.

Yeshua is the way and atoned for ALL of our sins and paid the debt for you and me with His body by shedding His own blood for the FINAL sacrifice.

"HE IS THE PASSOVER LAMB"

Only two people, Joshua and Caleb, from the generation that came out of Egypt went into the promise land. The rest died in the wilderness because of their continual grumbling and complaining. They did not believe, and refused to walk in the promises of Yehovah. It was the following generation, their children, those who were twenty years and younger upon leaving Egypt that crossed over the Jordan into the promise land with Joshua as their leader.

"For this reason Christ is the mediator of a new covenant, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance—now that He has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant." (Hebrews 9:15)

## THE PROMISE



### YEHOVAH MADE A PROMISE TO ABRAHAM AND HIS "SEED"

"Then the angel of Elohim called to Abraham a second time from heaven, and said, "By Myself I have sworn, declares Elohim, because you have done this thing and have not withheld your son, your only son, indeed I will greatly bless you, and I will greatly multiply your seed as the stars of the heavens and as the sand which is on the seashore; and your seed shall possess the gate of their enemies.

In your seed, all the nations of the earth shall be blessed, because you have obeyed My voice." (Genesis 22:15-18) The Scriptures

"The promises were spoken to Abraham and to his seed. Scripture does not say "and to seeds," meaning many people, but "and to your seed," meaning one person, who is Yeshua"

What I mean is this: The law, introduced 430 years later, does not set aside the covenant previously established by Elohim and thus do away with the promise.

For if the inheritance depends on the law, then it no longer depends on the promise; but Elohim in His grace gave it to Abraham through a promise.

Why, then, was the law given at all? It was added because of transgressions until the seed to whom the promise referred had come.

The law was given through angels and entrusted to a mediator.

A mediator, however, implies more than one party; but Elohim is one.

Is the law, therefore, opposed to the promises of God? Absolutely not!

For if a law had been given that could impart life, then righteousness would certainly have come by the law.

But Scripture has locked up everything under the control of sin, so that what was promised, being given through faith in Yeshua HaMachiach, might be given to those who believe.

Before the coming of this faith, we were held in custody under the law, locked up until the faith that was to come would be revealed.

So the law was our guardian until Yeshua came that we might be justified by faith.

Now that this faith has come, we are no longer under a guardian.

So in Yeshua HaMachiach you are all children of God through faith, for all of you who were baptized into Yeshua have clothed yourselves with Yeshua.

There is neither Jew nor Gentile, neither slave nor free, nor is there male and female, for you are all one in Yeshua HaMachiach.

If you belong to Yeshua, then you are Abraham's seed, and heirs according to the promise." (Galatians 3:16)

"It is you who are the sons of the prophets and of the covenant which Yehovah made with your fathers, saying to Abraham, 'And in your seed all the families will be blessed,"

(Acts 3:25)

"O seed (Yeshua) of Abraham, His servant, O sons of Jacob, His chosen ones! (Psalms 105:6)

## **BLESSINGS AND CURSES**

"When all these blessings and curses I have set before you come on you and you take them to heart wherever Yehovah disperses you among the nations, and when you and your children return to Yehovah and obey Him with all your heart and with all your soul according to everything I command you today, then Yehovah will restore your fortunes and have compassion on you and gather you again from all the nations where He scattered vou.

Even if you have been banished to the most distant land under the heavens, from there Yehovah will gather you and bring you back.

He will bring you to the land that belonged to your ancestors, and you will take possession of it. He will make you more prosperous and numerous than your ancestors.

Yehovah will circumcise your hearts and the hearts of your descendants, so that you may love Him with all your heart and with all your soul, and live.

Yehovah will put all these curses on your enemies who hate and persecute you.

You will again obey Yehovah and follow all His commands I am giving you today.

Then Yehovah will make you most prosperous in all the work of your hands and in the fruit of your womb, the young of your livestock and the crops of your land.

Yehovah will again delight in you and make you prosperous, just as He delighted in your ancestors, if you obey Yehovah and keep His commands and decrees that are written in this Book of the Law (Torah) and turn to the Yehovah with all your heart and with all your soul."

## We are called to return to the land of promise!

"Now what I am commanding you today is not too difficult for you or beyond your reach. It is not up in heaven, so that you have to ask, "Who will ascend into heaven to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?"

Nor is it beyond the sea, so that you have to ask, "Who will cross the sea to get it and proclaim it to us so we may obey it?"

No, the Word is very near you; it is in your mouth and in your heart so you may obey it. See, I set before you today life and prosperity, death and destruction.

For I command you today to love the Lord your Elohim, to walk in obedience to Him, and to keep His commands, decrees and laws; then you will live and increase, and the Lord your Elohim will bless you in the land you are entering to possess.

But if your heart turns away and you are not obedient, and if you are drawn away to bow down to other gods and worship them, I declare to you this day that you will certainly be destroyed.

You will not live long in the land you are crossing the Jordan to enter and possess.

This day I call the heavens and the earth as witnesses against you that I have set before you life and death, blessings and curses.

Now choose life, so that you and your children may live and that you may love the Lord your Elohim, listen to His voice, and hold fast to Him.

For the Yeshua is your life, and He will give you many years in the land He swore to give to your fathers, Abraham, Isaac and Jacob."

"In Matthew, Yeshua is proven to be the King legally;

in Luke, His genealogy as the Son of man is presented, linking Him with all of mankind.

In Matthew, Mary's husband Joseph is a descendant of David through the house of Solomon.

In Luke, Mary, the virgin, is a descendant of David through the house of Nathan.

As a woman, she did not have a claim to the throne.

In order for Yeshua to have that legal right to the throne, He had to be born to the wife of a man who had a perfectly legal, unchallenged right to the throne.

Through Joseph, Yeshua is the legal heir.

Because He was the Son of man and, finally, Son of God, He had the absolute, indisputable right to claim the throne.

Luke's genealogy begins in chapter 3, verse 22-23 and ends with the incredibly beautiful words,

"Which was the son of Adam, which was the son of God."

No one but Yeshua has ever, or ever will, fulfil the prophecies of a baby born of a virgin, in the city of Bethlehem, who would legally be King and Messiah, and through whom would come salvation for all mankind."

## YESHUA CAME FROM YEHOVAH, HIS FATHER

"In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with Elohim, and the Word was Elohim.

He was with Elohim in the beginning.

Through Him all things were made; without Him nothing was made that has been made.

In Him was life, and that life was the light of all mankind.

The light shines in the darkness, and the darkness has not overcome it.

There was a man sent from God whose name was John. He came as a witness to testify concerning that light, so that through him all might believe. He himself was not the light; he came only as a witness to the light.

The true light that gives light to everyone was coming into the world.

He was in the world, and though the world was made through Him, the world did not recognize Him.

He came to that which was His own, but His own did not receive Him.

Yet to all who did receive Him, to those who believed in His name, he gave the right to become children of God—children born not of natural descent, nor of human decision or a husband's will, but born of God.

The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us.

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We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.

John testified concerning him. He cried out, saying, "This is the one I spoke about when I said, 'He who comes after me has surpassed me because he was before me.'"

Out of his fullness, we have all received grace in place of grace already given.

For the law was given through Moses; grace and truth came through Yeshua Messiah.

No one has ever seen Elohim, but the one and only Son, who is himself Elohim and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known."

(John 1:1-18)

## THE PROPHET (Moses speaking to the Israelites)

The Lord your Elohim will raise up for you a Prophet like me from among you, from your fellow Israelites.

You must listen to him.

For this is what you asked of the Lord your Elohim at Horeb on the day of the assembly when you said, "Let us not hear the voice of the Lord our Elohim nor see this great fire anymore, or we will die."

The Lord said to me: "What they say is good. I will raise up for them a Prophet like you from among their fellow Israelites, and I will put my words in His mouth.

He will tell them everything I command Him."

(Deuteronomy 18:15-19)

"However, the days are coming," declares the Lord, "when it will no longer be said, 'As surely as the Lord lives, who brought the Israelites up out of Egypt,' but it will be said, 'As surely as the Lord lives, who brought the Israelites up out of the land of the north and out of all the countries where he had banished them.' For I will restore them to the land I gave their ancestors. (Jeramiah 16:14)

There is a day coming when we will no longer talk about the first exodus because of what's taking place. When we keep the Passover meal, we have 'lamb' because we recognize Yeshua and what He has done. When we read these scriptures in Jeremiah, we place it in a time up ahead when we see everyone returning back to the land but think about when we keep the Passover, the rejoicing is over the lamb! We are no longer talking about, "coming out of Egypt" even though when God bought His people up out of Egypt the miracles were truly amazing! It was a manifestation of the Kingdom on the earth, pillar of cloud by day, fire by the night. They experienced the provision of Yehovah as their clothes grew with them and manna came down from heaven. God looked after all their needs and protected them in ways that you could never imagine. It was a living reality for them and it can be our reality in these days as well.

## How are we living in the Kingdom today?

The way we move forward is to accept Yeshua the Messiah and walk in His Kingdom. Then the authority of Yehovah will be upon our lives to bring us through, no matter what we face. We are called to be overcomers in Yeshua.

Yeshua said, "I am come that they might have life, and that they might have it more abundantly." (John 10:10)

"More abundantly" means to have a 'superabundance' of a thing. "Abundant life" refers to life in its abounding fullness of joy and strength for spirit, soul and body."

The biggest hindrance that mankind faces is their desire to be in control of their own life, and have it ordered in a way they understand, according to their plans, and the things they want to accomplish. But the Scriptures are clear that we are to 'present our bodies as a living sacrifice" (Romans 12:1) If we want to receive the fullness of life, we have to live the life the Father has called us to live. We can walk in our natural talents and abilities and it feels good. We are self-assured and confident. But to walk in Yehovah's calling, we need the power of the Ruach HaKodesh. We can't do it on our own. He enables us to walk an 'abundant' life. We are called to be disciples of Yeshua and walk in His ways.

We are not called to build that which is of the flesh but that which is of THE PROMISE!

"By faith Abraham, when called to go to a place he would later receive as his inheritance, obeyed and went, even though he did not know where he was going. By faith he made his home in the promised land like a stranger in a foreign country; he lived in tents, as did Isaac and Jacob, who were heirs with him of the same promise. For he was looking forward to the city with foundations, whose architect and builder is Elohim." (Hebrews 11:8-10)

Abraham had a great faith and attitude. He made his home in the promised land and lived in a tent because he was not interested in building his own kingdom or taking wealth from other kings. His declaration was that everything he had would be a witness of his Father's provision and eternal promises.

## The Song of Moses and Miriam

Then Moses and the Israelites sang this song to the Lord:

"I will sing to the Lord, for He is highly exalted. Both horse and driver He has hurled into the sea.

"The Lord is my strength and my defense He has become my salvation."

"If you declare with your mouth, "Yeshua is Messiah," and believe in your heart that Elohim raised him from the dead, you will be saved." (Romans 10:9)

"However, the days are coming," declares the Lord, "when it will no longer be said, 'As surely as the Lord lives, who brought the Israelites up out of Egypt,' but it will be said, 'As surely as the Lord lives, who brought the Israelites up out of the land of the north and out of all the countries where He had banished them.' For I will restore them to the land I gave their ancestors." (Jeramiah 16:14-15)

We are not looking for a kingdom on earth that is built on the flesh. We are on the earth after salvation so we can be carriers and proclaimers of the Kingdom here on earth.

"Our Father which art in heaven, Hallowed be your Name Your Kingdom come, Your will be done, on earth as it is in heaven." (Matthew 6:9-10)

We are not following the fleshly order of the covenant because the Torah talks about a 'new covenant' that came forth. It is a NEW covenant of promise made to bring us into the Kingdom of Yehovah.

"The days are coming," declares the Lord, when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah.

It will not be like the covenant I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they broke my covenant, though I was a husband to them," declares the Yehovah. "This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel after that time," declares the Yehovah. "I will put My law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be My people. No longer will they teach their neighbour, or say to one another, 'Know Yehovah,' because they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares Yehovah.

"For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more." (Jeramiah 31:31-34)

This Kingdom was offered to Israel at Mt Sinai but they broke that covenant so they were not able to walk in the promises of Elohim at that time.

Before the foundations of the earth and creation, Messiah had already died because the Father knew what was going to take place. Yehovah knew the sin of man and how he was going to respond. Even Abraham, from the place of the promise, could not work out how Sarah wasn't with child at ninety years old. And still, Isaac was no where to be seen! Sarah told Abraham to go and sleep with Hagar which produced Ishmael who was born of the flesh. He was not the son of the promise.

"These things are being taken figuratively: The women represent two covenants. One covenant is from Mount Sinai and bears children who are to be slaves: This is Hagar. Now Hagar stands for Mount Sinai in Arabia and corresponds to the present city of Jerusalem, because she is in slavery with her children.

But the Jerusalem that is above is free, and she is our mother." (Galatians 4:24-26)

If we only focus on the restoration of natural Israel, all we will have is an "Ishmael" brought about by the works of the flesh. As believers in Messiah, we should be investing in the Kingdom of Yeshua and sharing the importance of repentance and the gospel of the Kingdom with the next generation. It's the same when we compare the Levitical priesthood to the order of Melchizedek, we see a huge difference between the two and Yeshua is superior! The Levitical priesthood was only in place while the physical temple was needed. We, as followers of Yeshua are now the temple of the Holy Spirit, the body of Messiah. This is a big key when we are evangelizing because we don't want to go out preaching about the feasts. We keep the feasts as a memorial only; BECAUSE we are in the Kingdom. As we know, it's not the keeping of the feasts or our works that bring us onto the path of salvation. Salvation comes by grace alone and then we experience freedom in Messiah within the NEW Covenant. We are living stones, part of the Commonwealth of Israel. To see miracles and transformation taking place, we've got to activate the Kingdom in our lives. If we are so focused on that which is in the flesh, we are going to miss the promises of Yehovah.


## "I AM WHO I AM"

One of the joys of attending gatherings, barbeques, parties, Bible studies, and other social events is having fellowship with people. But, have you ever gotten all dressed up and gone out in high hopes of having a great evening, only to spend it listening to people attempt to fit you in a box or give their opinion on how you should be living your life? This week, I reached my tipping point and began asking God how I should respond when these kinds of people set their sights on me. As I searched the Scriptures and spoke to friends about the topic, I learned that the Bible does not shy away when talking about meddling people and that I'm not the only one who gets questioned about their life choices.

"Fools find no pleasure in understanding but delight in airing their own opinions."

#### Proverbs 18:2

As a twenty-two-year-old single woman living in Israel, people are always trying to take me under their wings and make it their responsibility to encourage me to "expand my horizons." They hear snippets of my life and automatically assume that I am either unhappy, missing out, or isolating myself — none of which is true. After nine years of living in the Land, people cannot understand why I'm not fluent in Hebrew, going to school, spending time with people my age, or pursuing the 'typical' activities and careers like other young people my age.

While I know that these people mean well and only want to see everyone connecting and thriving as a community, I'm not someone God has called to stay on one particular path or in one place. He has given me a specific calling, and I'm not about to disobey His plans because people can't understand my life. Nevertheless, this does not mean that people's words do not hurt or catch me off guard. I am always trying to think the best of others, so when someone starts talking to me, it feels like a slap on the face when they're not actually interested in speaking with me but at me.

Upon returning home from a meeting the other night, I felt utterly drained and went straight to bed. After sending a few voice messages to my friends, sharing my frustrations about the evening, I had an epiphany. We can use all of our energy trying to explain our lives to others, but unless they take a walk in our shoes, they will never understand our lives. All we do when we expel this energy is weaken ourselves before the real battle begins. The enemy is lying in wait, and the moment we let down our guards, Satan gives the signal to attack.

I have spent years trying to defend my life and answer people's questions, but I'm learning that most people are not looking for a good explanation. In fact, a lot of the time, my answers only make the other party more passionate about their point of view! There have been many occasions where I've left a party or meeting feeling deflated and full of self-doubt. Playing with my thoughts, Satan uses these moments to make me question my life. "Is there really something wrong with me? Could I be doing more? Should I be making more of an effort even though I'm already overwhelmed with my responsibilities? Am I committing an injustice to myself for being so happy? Is it true that I'll never find friends or a spouse living the way I do? Have I heard God correctly? Am I truly in the right place?"

If it weren't for God's reassuring voice, these questions and people's constant badgering have the ability to lead me away from His promises. Believing these deceptions would not only guide me into the darkness, where only fruits of evil await me, but allow anxiety, depression, loneliness, self-hatred, hopelessness, and other emotions pull me further away from God. I would drown into such a depth that it would seem like His hand was entirely out of reach. However, my God is faithful and has shown me time and time again that the lies of the enemy do not have power over me!



Determined to fill my mind with His voice, I rebuke Satan's whispers and listen to the words of the Father, who is loudly proclaiming, "You are exactly where you need to be. Stay the course, Daughter. I have so much in store for you that people will never be able to comprehend. Satan doesn't want you to experience all that I have planned, but keep going; I am with you."

As the body of believers, we are called to uplift one another and share Biblical wisdom when prompted by the Lord, but that does not give people the right to share their carnal opinions as they tend only to sprout seeds of doubt rather than encouragement into our minds.

Romans 14:13 Says, "Therefore let us stop passing judgment on one another. Instead, make up your mind not to put any stumbling block or obstacle in the way of a brother or sister."

Every single one of us is called to do something specific for the kingdom of God. None of our journeys will be the same, and it's not for us to judge where God is taking someone else. #### Galatians 1:10
