# MINISTRY OVERVIEW 2021

I'd love to be able to tick off a long list of all the projects we completed this year and add to that all the countries we visited to minister the Gospel, but like all best-laid plans, it wasn't to be. 2021 has been a year for battles to be won in heavenly places and we have the testimony of amazing victories in being sustained through this pandemic.

As a traveling ministry based in Israel, we have felt the restriction of being grounded, but have used all of this to our advantage to share Yeshua and repositioning. From my experience in ministry, challenging times (storms) like these can only be navigated through the power of prayer and, when required, fasting our way to breakthrough!

We started this year by completing 40 days of prayer as a believing community. We didn't know at that time how difficult this year was going to be, but I believe that 40 days of prayer was good preparation for what was to come.

It is so comforting to know the God we serve never sleeps and watches over us continually.

January started with lots of opposition for our family personally with our businesses under fire. It seemed like the enemy's plan was to have me held up in the courts fighting multiple battles to destroy our finances and stop the work here in Israel. But through it all, we saw the protection and blessings of Yehovah. We didn't shrink back but kept moving forward, rejoicing as we went with many impacting responses to the fruit of our efforts to be salt and light.

Crossing Point was launched at the start of the year as the Father began raising a community of believers. It was established to be a community that would get to know each other as they walked and grew together and were accountable to each other.

The importance of a crossing point for us as believers is that there needs to be a place where we 'cross over' from a carnal state to a spiritual one. We then need to learn what it means to walk in the Kingdom of Yehovah so we can experience all His blessings keeping focused on why Elohim blesses us on the journey to set the captives free.

In May, violence came to our streets as Hamas made war with Israel. We watched as neighborhoods turned against each other. It was no longer safe to go out at night alone with the gangs of both sides attacking each other and innocent bystanders. Even though this war did generate a lot of attention worldwide, for us that live in Israel, we know that this is an ongoing Israeli-Palestinian conflict that has a long history and will flare up again in the future.

In June, a new Government was established as Netanyahu's era came to a close. The new thirty-sixth government of Israel is now being called the Bennett-Lapid government. Naftali Bennett is the current Prime Minister, and Yair Lapid is the Alternate Prime Minister. It is the first government to include an independent Arab Israeli party as an official member of the governing coalition.

The role of the government is based on parliamentary democracy. The prime minister is the head of government and leader of a multi-party system. Executive power is exercised by the government (cabinet). The Knesset vests legislative power. This is vastly different from how the government was run in Saul, David's, and Solomon's reign. Back then, it was called the United Monarchy. The Kingdom of Israel and the Kingdom of Judah were united as one kingdom and ruled over by one king.

Our family moved in August from Caesarea to a new location in a Moshav farming community near Akko. Yemenite Jews established this area in 1950. It has already been a rewarding experience for us. We have been drawn into the outstretched arms of welcoming neighbors wanting us to become a part of their community and families. We are always looking for ways to give back in our local areas and bring Yehovah's love and provision to those around us. We have an outdoor space in our front yard, and it's not uncommon for a neighbor or two to drop by for a chat. We are finding we can be a witness for the Yeshua as we keep the Sabbath and Biblical Feast days and minister the Gospel when the opportunity arises.

## Moving into the new 2022

It's hard to speculate what next year will bring as we live with Covid, vaccine mandates, and restrictions. Travel is not an option for us in the foreseeable future months, but that does not mean that Yehovah does not have big plans for the ministry here in the land. I am praying consistently for the following steps to be effective in the place where we live.

I don't believe any change or move goes to waste in Yehovah. He can use all of us no matter where we are because of life's circumstances.

At present, as you are aware, I am experiencing some challenges with my health, and this is a good time for a breakthrough as I joyfully praise Yehovah and wait for my healing and strength to return. Over the next five months, I will be concentrating on learning Hebrew 5 days a week as I seek to strengthen my witness to share the gospel and expand our work in Israel. This will include reopening a new center to establish our work in this region. I look forward to coming together in Crossing Point, and our zoom calls as we share our journeys united as one body in Messiah. As soon as I am well enough, we will resume the daily devotions as the Ruach HaKodesh leads. Thank you to everyone who has walked with us this year. We appreciate all your prayers, support, and encouragement which have been an enormous blessing. Many blessings, Kenny

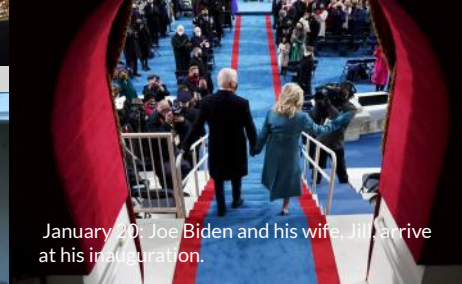
January 4: Motorists wait in lines for Covid-19 tests outside of Los Angeles' Dodger Stadium.

January 20: Joe Biden and his wife, Jill, arrive at his inauguration.

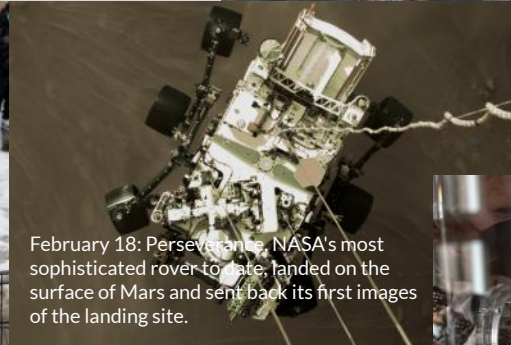

February 16: Camilla Swindle sits in a shopping cart as she and her boyfriend wait in a long line to enter a grocery store in Austin, Texas.

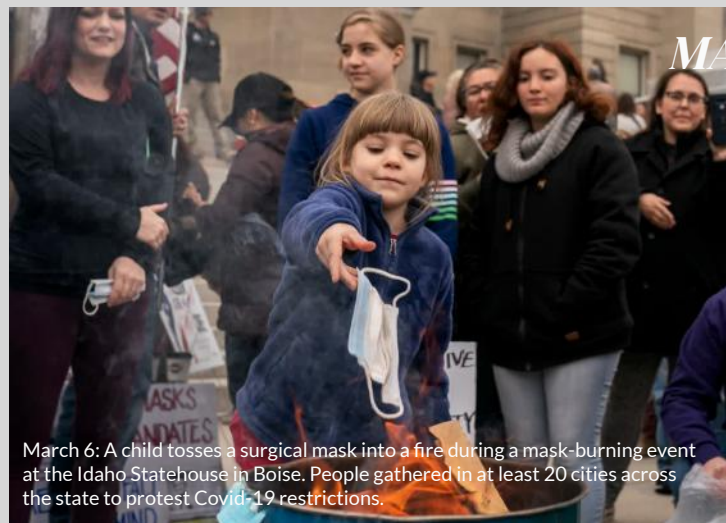


February 18: Perseverance, NASA's most sophisticated rover to date, landed on the surface of Mars and sent back its first images of the landing site.

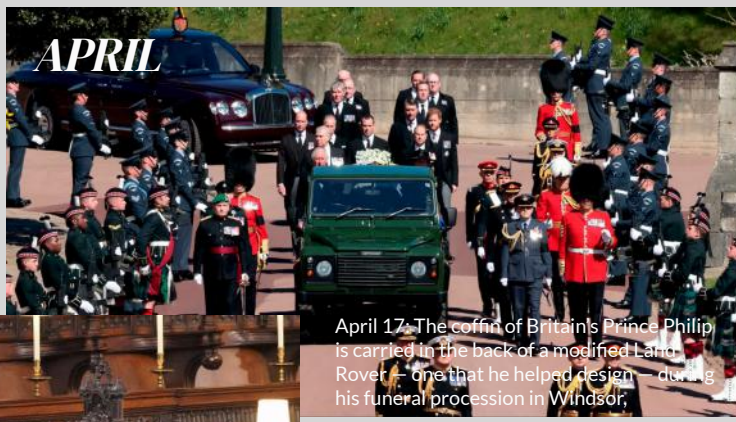


March 30: Migrant children lie inside a pod at a federal holding facility in Donna, Texas. 3,400 were unaccompanied children.

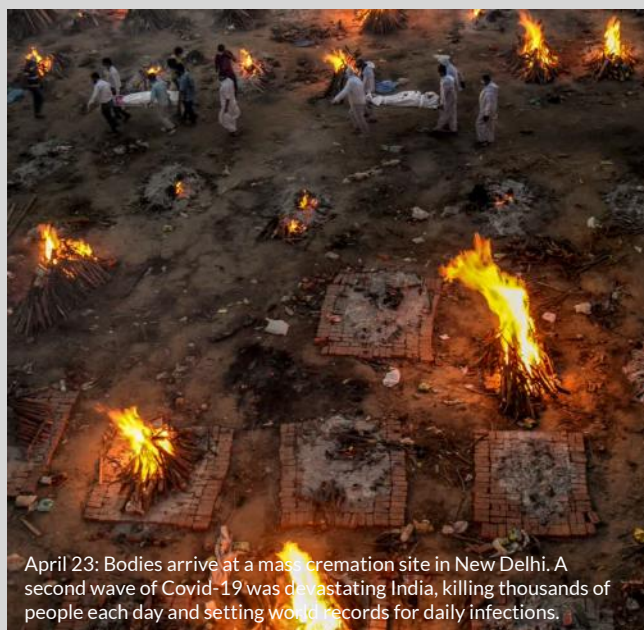


April 6: Lightning strikes near the intersection of Chicago Avenue and 38th Street, also known as George Floyd Square, in Minneapolis.

June 28: Actors perform at the National Stadium in Beijing during a celebration marking the 100th anniversary of the Chinese Communist Party.

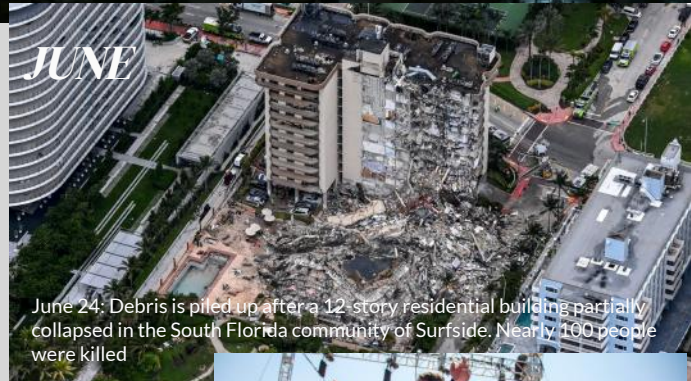
May 14: Israel's Iron Dome system intercepts rockets that were launched from Gaza toward southern Israel.

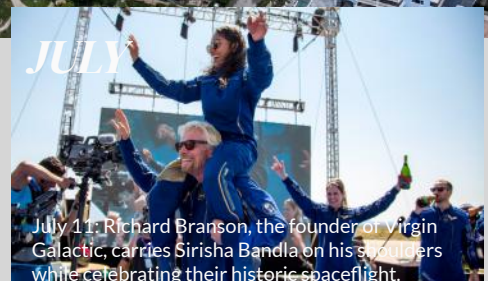


May 10: Palestinians clash with Israeli security forces at the Al-Aqsa Mosque compound in Jerusalem's Old City.

August 19: People sit inside a military aircraft during an evacuation from Kabul. The US Air Force evacuated approximately 3,000 people from Kabul's international airport that day.



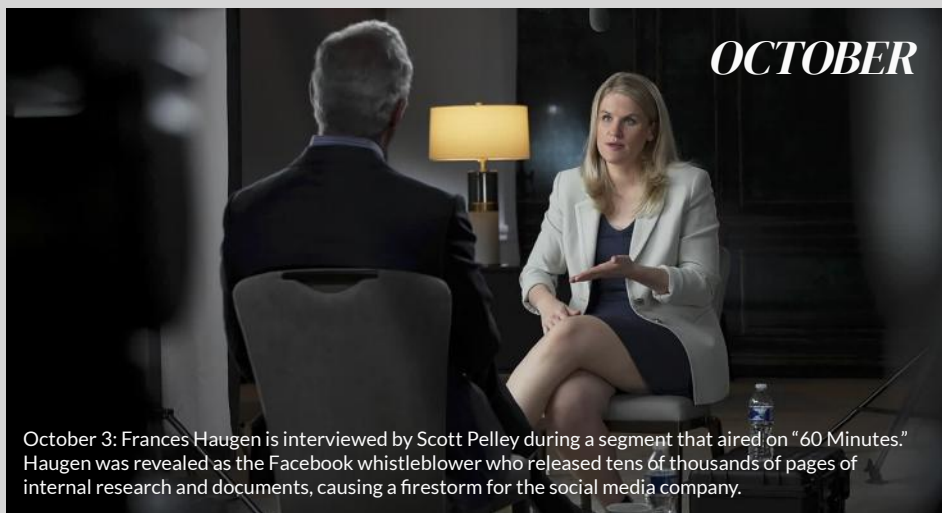
August 25: Health care workers treat Covid-19 patients at a chapel that had been converted into an intensive care unit in Quezon City, Philippines.

## OCTOBER



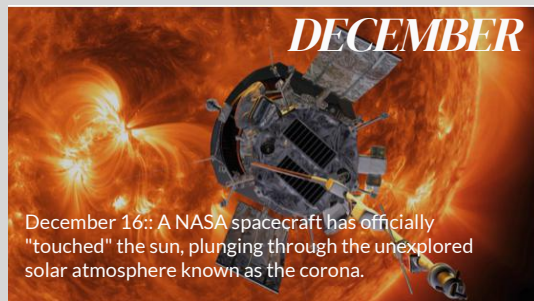

Rather than allowing his faith to waver like the Israelites, Moses remained firm as he remembered that the Lord had told him, “I will harden Pharaoh’s heart, and he will pursue them. But I will gain glory for myself through Pharaoh and all his army, and the Egyptians will know that I am the Lord.” (Exodus 14:4 NIV) So, lifting his voice over the panic that was rippling through the camp, Moses is the first person in the Bible to declare, “Do not be afraid. Stand firm and you will see the deliverance the Lord will bring you today. The Egyptians you see today you will never see again. The Lord will fight for you; you need only to be still.” (Exodus 14:13-14 NIV)

Be still while your enemy is charging toward you? Somehow, my mind pictures a bullfighter waving his red cape and waiting until the last second to move so the bull’s horns don’t pierce his body – testing how close to death he can come. Just as insane as that scenario is, I’m sure the Israelites hearts were pounding as they listened to Moses’ advice and watched as Pharaoh drew nearer. However, just as quickly as Moses tells the Israelites to be still, God commands them to “Move on.” Hang on, can someone be still WHILE moving forward? Surely there is a contradiction...

Until recently, I’d never correlated Exodus 14:14-15 with Psalm 46:10. I’d always thought that when we read “Be still” in the Scriptures, it truly meant that we were to stay in place. It wasn’t until the topic was broached in a recent zoom call and one of the participant’s words hit the bullseye when she said, “In your hearts, be still and know that God is in control; but, that doesn’t mean you should stop walking or doing whatever it is you’re doing.”

Even if the storm is raging around us and our overwhelming fear is saying that God has forsaken us, the story of Exodus is a great reminder that the Lord is always with us, fighting for us and protecting us. It doesn’t matter how imminent the danger or high-pressure the task; when we surrender our fears and worries to the Lord and remain firm in our faith, believing that God is on our side, the peace of the Messiah will fall onto us, and we will have the power to emerge from any storm victorious!

Just as the Israelites were delivered from the hands of the Egyptians, God wants to deliver us from the attacks of the Enemy. While we might not physically walk through the parted Red Sea, God is standing behind us with a shield, preventing the flaming arrows from harming us as we walk in faith and live out the calling He has placed on our hearts. Attacks will come, but all we need to do is BE STILL, AND MOVE ON!!



In a panic, their fear replaces their faith as they cry out to Moses, “Was it because there were no graves in Egypt that you brought us to the desert to die? What have you done to us by bringing us out of Egypt? Didn’t we say to you in Egypt, ‘Leave us alone; let us serve the Egyptians’? It would have been better for us to serve the Egyptians than to die in the desert!” (Exodus 14:11-12 NIV)
