NAMES - Preferred is the Hebrew translation; using the names, Elohim, Yehovah, Yeshua and the Ruach HaKodesh but we also use the Greek translation; using the names, God, Jesus, Christ and the Holy Spirit as we seek to be reach people where they are.

BEING A WITNESS

1Peter 2:4-5, "As you come to Him, the living Stone—rejected by humans but chosen by God and precious to Him— you also, like living stones, are being built into a spiritual house to be a holy priesthood, offering spiritual sacrifices acceptable to God through Yeshua HaMachiach."

Being a witness is many things, but it starts with you and your transformation through Yeshua HaMachiach. When we look at the Scripture, and we talk about the love of God, you want to be able to communicate the love of God, but to communicate the love of God; you have to experience the love of God. I know many believers who are sincere and spend time in the Word, praying and going through all the right motions, but they're just not excited or passionate about the love of God? Sometimes we need to reflect and give thanks for all the ways that Yeshua has delivered us and set us free. The focus is on identifying who is Yeshua to me and what we have been through. The love that Yehovah has for me, the hope that we find within Him, the blessing of salvation and being delivered, transformed by the power of Yehovah. These are the experiences people can relate to, and most people love to hear personal stories. We don't want to offer up religion or a pre-written script when we share the truth of who Yeshua is. We want people to know He is not just words in a book, but He is a true living God who cares for them and their circumstances. We want people to know that Yehovah desires to be in a relationship with them. Maybe you struggle with witnessing? Perhaps you struggle with sharing your faith because you're self-conscious or think, "Well, this is not for me." As you make your way through these pages, I hope you will see a different perspective on being a living witness (living stone) and are encouraged to reengage with the Great Commission as Yeshua asked us all to do before He ascended into heaven. We all have a great story to tell, and it's really just about recognizing what your story is. As you take the time to remember and write them out, they will become fresh again in your mind, reigniting the passion and fire for Yehovah once again in your heart.

What does "Being A Witness" mean to me?

Witnessing to people outside my familiar circle is a big step into the great unknown, that's for sure, but it also has me been grasped in the clutches of anticipation and expectation to observe Elohim's redeeming love in action. I fully expect to feel uncomfortable because, no doubt, it will be way out of my comfort zone.

Zechariah 4:6, "Not by might nor by power, but by my Spirit," says the Lord Almighty."

I trust that when the time comes that I get a prompting from the Ruach HaKodesh to go that He would have prepared me spiritually and also prepared the way that I will go. He will guide me every step of the way.

I trust that the Holy Spirit will enable me with the mission's necessary gifts.

I trust that the Holy Spirit inside me will be the power source to complete the task.

I trust that whatever I require in the natural will also be provided and ready for use.

I may or may not fumble through it all.

How do I know this? Because this is the walk of faith when we do the Lord's work.

As long as I am diligent in reading His Word and stay connected to Yehovah through prayer, tuning into the voice of His Spirit, and being willing, I will be prepared as much as I can be.

As I lay my life down before Yeshua daily and enquire of Him, "Father, what are my steps for this day?"

I trust that He is faithful to fulfill His Word and will lead my steps. My job is to seek Him and obey.

I say these words very humbly, remembering the journey Yeshua has taken me on to come to this point in my walk where I feel I can step out to be a witness and answer His call. It was very challenging and, at times, confusing, not knowing what type of valley I was walking into but trusting Yeshua to bring me through as I knew He was holding my hand; I was not alone.

Psalms 23:4, "Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no evil, for You are with me; Your rod and Your staff, they comfort me."

I always hoped my path as a believer would bring me to this place because it has always been the desire of my heart to be one of Yeshua's disciples and be a part of the Great Commission. I know the first time I can lead someone to Yeshua and through the steps of salvation will be a precious gift. This is my life now.

Psalms 37:4, "Take delight in the Lord, and He will give you the desires of your heart."

I also now recognize that Yehovah placed these desires in my heart when He created me.

I have also experienced being a witness can take many forms. As I am sometimes learning, it can be more about who you are as a child of God; how you treat people, the kindness in your voice, the warmth in your eyes, a smile that lights up a room, spreading joy into the dark places of people's lives and giving them hope.

What you do and say is crucial as being in the body of Yeshua, we are his literal hands and feet to help someone in need or rush to someone's aid in an emergency. Sometimes, we can portray His loving heart and a place to belong through outstretched arms and a big, warm hug whispering, "It's time to come home."

I also see how our external lives can also be a compelling witness to those around us as to who Yehovah is to us personally. Are we changing as our relationship with Yeshua grows, and can other people see the gifts of the Spirit displayed in us?

Galatians 5:22-23, "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, forbearance, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control..."

As the Holy Spirit takes every one of us on a journey to be cleansed and set free, leaving no stone unturned, it may feel uncomfortable and chaotic for a short while, but then comes the "peaceable fruit of righteousness." HAPPINESS VS. JOY

YOUR COUNTENANCE IS A WITNESS



*"You make known to me the path of life;
You will fill me with JOY in Your presence,
with eternal pleasures at Your right hand." Psalms 16:11*

HAPPINESS

JOY

EMOTIONS THAT CREATE FEELINGS OF CONTENTMENT AND SATISFACTION BUT DIFFER BASED ON WHAT CAUSES THE FEELING

MEANING - An emotion in which one experiences feelings ranging from contentment and satisfaction to bliss and intense pleasure

CAUSES - Earthly experiences and material objects

EMOTION - Outward expression of elation

TIME FRAME - Temporary based on outward circumstances

EXAMPLE - In the midst of life's up and downs, happiness is still present

ANALOGY - Happiness is a state
Think of it as a 100-story building and each level corresponds to a happiness value. And that happiness will persist for quite a long time

LIFE - Happiness can be experienced from any good activity, food or company

ANTONYM - Opposite of happiness is unhappiness and misery

MEANING - A stronger and less common feeling than happiness. Witnessing or achieving selflessness to the point of personal sacrifice frequently triggers this emotion.
Feeling spiritually connected to God and people

CAUSES - Spiritual experiences, caring for others, gratitude, thankfulness

EMOTION - Inward peace and contentment

TIME FRAME - Lasting based on inward circumstances

EXAMPLE - Serving others, sometimes through sacrifice with no possible personal gain
Witnessing justice for the less fortunate
Feeling close to God

ANALOGY - Joy is that sudden burst of happiness
Joy is like the elevator in that building that takes you to a higher level of happiness only for a short amount of time and back

LIFE - Joy is a byproduct of a moral lifestyle

ANTONYM - Opposite of joy is fear

HOW WE ACT AS A FAMILY IS A WITNESS



I've been watching a series on Netflix called "Chicago Fire" which tells the story of Firehouse 51 with all the different character types, flawed, but the one thing they have in common is a zeal to save lives no matter how hard the mission is or who the person is, good or bad. The other thing that stood out to me was how seamlessly they worked as a team. Everyone working together for the one purpose and each firefighter knowing their specific role within the team. They know they have a responsibility to each other to do their job right otherwise people could be dangerously hurt or killed including themselves.

When the siren sounds an alarm that there is a fire to put out or someones needs saving, all issues or grievances are left at the firehouse and out they go with one accord to do their job! In that moment, its not about them individually, they are part of a team who is going to save a life.

The other thing that stood out to me was the camaraderie within the group, they all had each others back and saw each other as a brother or sister and regarded each one as family. They celebrated the highs and sympathized with the lows in each others lives and circumstances. The sense of family was strong. Yes, mistakes are made and at times that have to admit their wrongs and make amends but they do it because they know as a firefighter in Firehouse 51, this is what they want to be known for.

For their steadfast loyalty to each other and the community around them. They also know this is what the Chief of the Firehouse expect of them and through their respect for him and his authority, they do not want to let him down.

Ephesians 4:1-6, "As a prisoner for the Lord, then, I urge you to live a life worthy of the calling you have received. Be completely humble and gentle; be patient, bearing with one another in love. Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit through the bond of peace.

There is one body and one Spirit, just as you were called to one hope when you were called; one Lord, one faith, one baptism; one God and Father of all, who is over all and through all and in all.

Ephesians 4:14-16, "Then we will no longer be infants, tossed back and forth by the waves, and blown here and there by every wind of teaching and by the cunning and craftiness of people in their deceitful scheming. Instead, speaking the truth in love, we will grow to become in every respect the mature body of Him who is the head, that is, Christ. From Him the whole body, joined and held together by every supporting ligament, grows and builds itself up in love, as each part does its work."

Of course life isn't scripted and we can all be messy but still I love these elements of the show because I believe this is a good representation of how Yehovah wants us to work together as a team and have each other's back. To be able to look to each other for comfort and support and be able to share the joy of the good times in our life. To really listen when the other person is speaking and try to hear what they are saying. To value and respect the differences we have and to know that we were each created with different purposes to live out the God-given plan for our life.

Yeshua Washes His Disciples' Feet

HOW WE HUMBLE OURSELVES IN TRUE LOVE AND DEVOTION TO EACH OTHER IS A WITNESS!

It was just before the Passover Festival. Jesus knew that the hour had come for Him to leave this world and go to the Father.

Having loved His own who were in the world, He loved them to the end.

The evening meal was in progress, and the devil had already prompted Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot, to betray Yeshua.

Yeshua knew that the Father had put all things under His power, and that He had come from God and was returning to God; so He got up from the meal, took off His outer clothing, and wrapped a towel around His waist. *(Yeshua knew where He was going they could not follow, so He showed them instead.*

He cleansed the stain of their sins away and wiped their conscience clear.)

After that, He poured water into a basin and began to wash His disciples' feet, drying them with the towel that was wrapped around Him.

He came to Simon Peter, who said to Him, "Lord, are you going to wash my feet?" Yeshua replied, "You do not realize now what I am doing, but later you will understand." "No," said Peter, "you shall never wash my feet."

Yeshua answered, "Unless I wash you, you have no part with Me!"

"Then, Lord," Simon Peter replied, "not just my feet but my hands and my head as well!"

Yeshua answered, "Those who have had a bath need only to wash their feet; their whole body is clean. And you are clean, though not every one of you." For He knew who was going to betray Him, and that was why He said not every one was clean. When He had finished washing their feet,

He put on his clothes and returned to His place.

"Do you understand what I have done for you?" He asked them. "You call me 'Teacher' and 'Lord,' and rightly so, for that is what I am. *Now that I, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also should wash one another's feet.*

PART TWO - HELP IS ON THE WAY

PART 3 - SALVATION ONE WAY

PART 4 - CHRIST IN ME

In this teaching we are talking about sharing our faith and inviting people to receive Yeshua. We are saying you need to be born again of the Spirit. What does it mean to be born again of the Spirit?

Romans 10:9-11, "If you declare with your mouth, "Jesus is Lord," and believe in your heart that God raised him from the dead, you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved."

These verses are talking about the response of our heart. When we talk to people we are inviting them to ask Yeshua into their hearts. We are really saying they will be inviting Yeshua into the very centre of who they are as a person. This is a very important life changing decision they will be making. It's not about the circumcision of the flesh, its about the circumcision of the heart. The Torah talks more about the circumcision of the heart than of the flesh.

PART 5 - TRADING MY SORROWS

In this teaching we are identifying, "Who is Yeshua to me?" As we go back to the time we were saved, we recognize the journey we have been on to discover our salvation. Never forget where you have come from.

When we look at the opportunity we have on an ongoing basis, there are two turning points. The first turning point is when we realize we are lost in our sin and the second point is when we get to that place that we call out to Yehovah.

PART 6 - THE FOUNDATION IS LAID

I have taken comfort in Jesus and the Bible has shown me how much God loves me and even though He created all things He has time for me and for you.

One time God said to me, "Do not be afraid, you will not be put to shame. Do not fear disgrace; you will not be humiliated."

When we hurt it is only natural to close up and protect our own hearts, we put our heads down and don't want to look people in the eyes. Many of us have stopped asking questions for fear of rejection. God also says, **"You will forget the shame of your youth"**

We have all done things we regret and sometimes we think we are the only one, but I came to find out that I was not alone, in fact everybody has walked in shame!

Cleanse me with hyssop, and I will be clean; wash me, and I will be whiter than snow.

Let me hear joy and gladness; let the bones you have crushed rejoice.

Hide your face from my sins and blot out all my iniquity.

Create in me a pure heart, O God, and renew a steadfast spirit within me.

Do not cast me from your presence or take your Holy Spirit from me.

Restore to me the joy of your salvation and grant me a willing spirit, to sustain me.

Then I will teach transgressors your ways, so that sinners will turn back to you.

Deliver me from the guilt of bloodshed, O God, you who are God my Savior,
and my tongue will sing of your righteousness.

Open my lips, Lord, and my mouth will declare your praise.

My sacrifice, O God, is a broken spirit; a broken and contrite heart you, God,
will not despise.

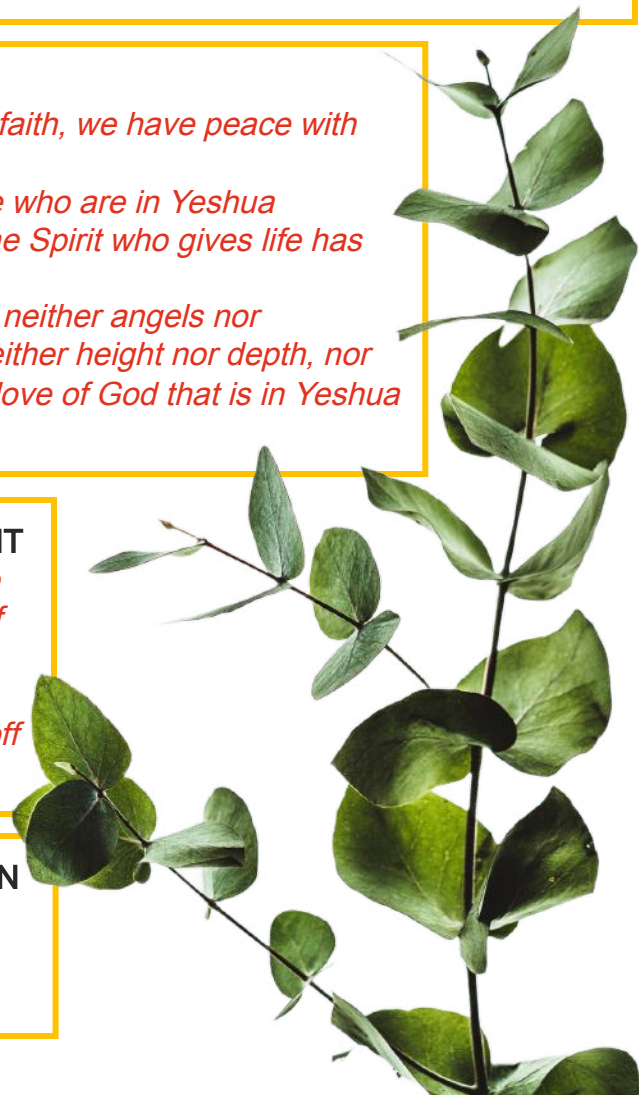

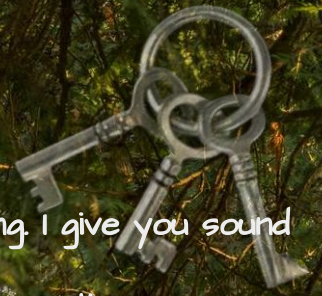

It is important to be honest with each other and explain yourself properly.

Ephesians 4:25, "Therefore each of you must put off falsehood and speak truthfully to your neighbor, for we are all members of one body. "In your anger do not sin": Do not let the sun go down while you are still angry, and do not give the devil a foothold."

We've got to protect what goes into us because that is what is going to go out.

I was at home reading the Word and having my time of prayer when I heard a "Yoo-hoo" at our front gate. On the other side was a lady and a young girl, who looked about 12 with an armful of books and a face full of intent. The lady stood to the back and I was quite aware they were probably from Jehovah's Witness or something like that but I let the little girl speak and say what she came to say.

They were selling books and as it turned out she had a book which grabbed my attention so I bought it.

We were just chatting for a little while and the lady mentioned how confronting it is to witness face to face and how everyone is now living behind screens. The young girl with her was part of a youth witnessing program from their church which I found out later was Seventh Day Adventist.

So then I opened up about how I write newsletters for an online ministry and this month we were going to be focusing on that same subject, "How to witness" and how this was something I was soon to be facing myself.

(I just didn't realise in that moment that my first encounter was about to happen!)

So they left and I went back to my day not giving it another thought except to be very grateful because the book turned out to be a good buy, easy to read, and will be very helpful.

Fast forward two hours and I had a thought that I should have given her one of the Newsletters as I had only just recently printed them all out. I was cranky at myself that I didn't think of it earlier but then I thought, "I'm just going to get in the car and see if I can find them." I didn't even think about what I was going to say and by this stage I was on autopilot and now myself, full of intent.

I grabbed one of the Newsletters, checked the contents and off I went driving down random streets around my suburbs hoping I would see them on the footpath as they were walking. I wasn't planning on driving out of my area and as I had prayed beforehand, I was leaving it up to God if this was of Him or not. I asked Him to lead me to them and was prepared to be amazed if I actually found them. I was expecting the "unexpected!"

I did feel I was getting a slight prompting to head in the direction of the park which is about five blocks away, so I drove in the general direction, scanning the streets as I went and ended up at the park as I still hadn't seen any sign of them in the streets.

Then, you wouldn't believe it, there was a large group of people hanging around under a big ole' shady tree having their lunch, about twenty of them, many of them African and this is how I recognized it was them.

because the young girl who sold me the book was also African and I saw her stand up as I drove past.

I pulled a park and sat there for a few seconds wondering how I was going to approach them. I stopped and asked the Holy Spirit to direct me in what to say because I knew if I stayed another second, I would talk myself out of getting out of the car. So I walked up to the group, madly searching for the lady who had been at my door thinking I could discreetly hand it to her and leave without anyone noticing me.

I couldn't see her because as it turned out she had her back to me. As I approached the group another lady walked toward me and I explained to her how I had just bought a book from them and wanted to give the lady a gift which was the Newsletter. I pointed out the young girl who sold me the book and they asked her who she was with? As she spoke out her name, the lady who had been at my door, turned around.

By this time all twenty or so sets of eyes were on me, probably wondering who I was and what I wanted. I looked at the lady and said, *"Remember, I told you I wrote Newsletters for an online ministry, I wanted to give you this one. I wasn't even sure if I could find you but I prayed and asked God to lead me to you so I have been driving around the streets and here I am. So I hope you enjoy it and it will be a blessing to you."* cont.

She was surprised, happy and very grateful, thanking me with a huge smile as she took the Newsletter. The rest of the group were all excited and amazed that I had found them, recognizing GOD'S HAND at work! At that point, I turned to go, believing I had done what Yehovah wanted me to do and next minute, I heard a young girl's voice call out, "What's your name?"

"Esther, " I said with a smile, "and my middle name is Faith," knowing they would appreciate the significance. She looked at me and grinned, "Would you like us to pray for you?" I was surprised because I was not expecting that but they were so welcoming so I said, "Yes." It was a very surreal, sweet moment. She made everyone stop talking and asked the young man beside her if he wanted to pray, poor kid, he looked mortified and by that stage so was I, but she wasn't to be put off and started praying herself. It was a simple pray for myself and my family and I remember, the words, "Be a light to those around her." It was awesome. I left to go again and heard another voice say, "Bye Esther, see you upstairs one day, " to which I replied, "You surely will," and turned to face a different lady with black framed glasses and a big smile that reached to her eyes. Later at home and upon reflection of what had just happened, I felt the impression that maybe I had just responded to an angel because there was a presence about her that was different to everyone else and she was literally beaming. It's a nice thought anyway!

I left my name and number on the Newsletter thinking if the lady I gave it to had any questions, she could call me. The March Newsletter is all about how we are called to walk in the supernatural realm but it is also very strongly based on the Word. I'm not sure where the Seventh Day Adventists stand in their beliefs about walking in the Spirit but I know they are very strong in the Word so I knew they would identify with the Scriptures in it and hopefully also receive a revelation of the Gift of the Holy Spirit. I am praying. I believe today was a divine appointment as I don't normally talk to people that come to my door like that and but because it was a child, I didn't want to put her off or make her feel rejected in any way. So I listened. Was it the Holy Spirit who put the thought in my head to chase them down and give them the Newsletter? I believe so. I hope the reason I was to give it to her when she was with everyone else was so it could be shared. This is my prayer, that the words in the Newsletter will speak to each and every one of them.

And as I write this, I am remembering a conversation I had with my sister a few days ago about witnessing. Her words were, "We need to get out of the house more because God is not going to bring people to our door." and look what happened today, He bought them literally to my door and THEN I had to get out of the house!! lol

Another thought that comes to mind is about "Preparation." Early in my journey of coming back to our "Hebrew roots" and learning about the Torah, I received a word from the Holy Spirit to, "Prepare." Straight away I began preparing in the natural things of this world and that was good but I know now what God was really saying, "To prepare in the Spirit" and that has been my journey. Yeshua made sure I was prepared for this encounter as the Newsletter was already printed out two weeks earlier, each month is sitting in a plastic sleeve waiting to go into a folder and when they knocked on my door I was reading in *Psalms 104:14*, "He makes grass grow for the cattle, and plants for people to cultivate-bringing forth food from the earth." Hence why I bought the book. God knew.

Finding Joy In A Sea Of Pain

Being in pain sucks. It's as simple as that. You can try to sugarcoat what you're going through, but at the end of the day, I know you are crawling into bed with a prayer of healing on your lips. After ten years of severe (repeat, severe) migraines, I understand the pleas you're silently screaming to the Father.

"Lord, please just let me wake up with less pain!"

In most of my blogs, I have written about living a life for the Kingdom and the reality that commitment comes with. I make it clear that living for Jesus (Yeshua) is freeing but also full of trials and tribulations. As we follow in His footsteps, we will be tested, and every part of our flesh will be exposed. Dying to our selves and living for God is a battle, but that doesn't mean we should measure our faith by the struggles we go through.

After a month of nursing a broken toe, fighting fatigue, and trying to keep a migraine at bay, I've been lagging on my time with God, filling my days with mindless scrolling and binge-watching to numb the pain. However, the other morning, I woke up feeling hallow and asked myself, "How do I get back to making God my focus rather than only going to Him to ask for healing?" I'd allowed myself to be comforted by worldly pleasures, but as soon as the episode ended or the final word of the book was read, my despair returned, and I felt empty again.

"Consider it pure joy, my brothers and sisters, whenever you face trials of many kinds, because you know that the testing of your faith produces perseverance. Let perseverance finish its work so that you may be mature and complete, not lacking anything" James 1:2-4

Many of us have memorized the passage above, but have you ever thought about how strange it is that the writer says we should think of trials as pure joy? I don't know about you, but the tribulations I've gone through and am currently facing are not joyful; they're painful, stressful, and rough. So, how can there be joy in pain?

This week, I went in search of answers and found a few revelations while reading Lecrae's devotional, Restoration. On day one, he writes, *"While pain and suffering are essential ingredients to growth and maturity in our faith, we should be careful to avoid boiling Christianity down to a suffering existence. Instead of interpreting our faith through the lens of suffering, we are encouraged to look at our suffering through the lens of faith. When we experience hardship, and see the brokenness of our world's systems, we are encouraged to consider it joy. As citizens of God's kingdom, these things should serve as reminders our hope is beyond fulfillment in this world—our hope is in Christ! This hope made fully mature in us has the power to change the world"* (emphasis added)

Without hope, who are we? Without Yeshua, what hope do we have? **Romans 15:13** says, *"May the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace as you trust in him, so that you may overflow with hope by the power of the Holy Spirit."* I know I'm not the only one who struggles with their spiritual strength when they're physically weak, but, over the last few days, I've been asking myself why that happens. Why does my faith feel weak when my energy is low, or the pain is too much to bear? I think part of the answer can be found in what I'm filling my days with, while the other part has to do with where I'm putting my hope. I know for me, opening the Bible is so much more work than turning on Netflix or reading a book when I'm not feeling well.

I often make the excuse that I want to be in the right headspace to retain what I'm reading in the Word, but the truth is that it's easier to temporarily numb how I'm feeling rather than breaking the barrier that's separating me from God.

There will always be days where we feel beaten down, but they don't have to get the better of us. Our faith should not be categorized by what is going on in our lives. While we live in this world, we are not to look at our circumstances through a worldly gaze. (I'm preaching to myself here) Sure, it's not easy to look at the positive when your head is screaming in pain; but we have a choice, do we choose to take the wide road, finding comfort in temporary reprieves, or will we lean on God and ask Him for the comfort spoken about in **2 Corinthians 1:3-7?**

"Praise be to the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of compassion and the God of all comfort, who comforts us in all our troubles, so that we can comfort those in any trouble with the comfort we ourselves receive from God. For just as we share abundantly in the sufferings of Christ, so also our comfort abounds through Christ. If we are distressed, it is for your comfort and salvation; if we are comforted, it is for your comfort, which produces in you patient endurance of the same sufferings we suffer. And our hope for you is firm, because we know that just as you share in our sufferings, so also you share in our comfort"

As I've been reading Lecrae's devotional, studying the Word, spending time with God, and making a choice to shift my focus whenever I start to lean into the temptation of entertainment and social media, I've found that my pain has decreased and I no longer feel empty and weighed down. The first step is always the hardest, but once we take it, change follows! It is important to listen to what our bodies need and take care of them, but there comes a time when we have to take authority and redirect our attention to the Father, away from the feelings of our flesh.

Yeshua is our comforter, healer, teacher, and encourager; if you're feeling depressed or overcome by pain, there is hope. Joy during tribulation can only be found through Him, and if you want to break free of the bondage you are feeling trapped in, I'm here to tell you that it is possible! Being in pain sucks, but it doesn't have to control the strength of our faith.
