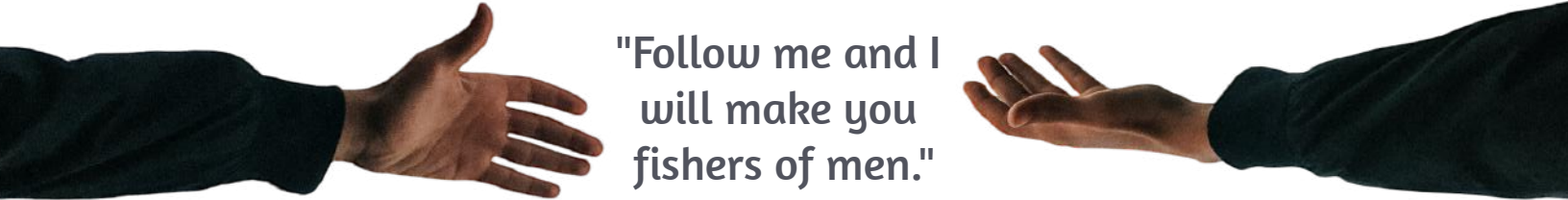

In these Workbooks we have provided exercises which will help you to write your account of how Yehovah, God has changed your life and who He is to you. This is your story and your testimony that you can confidently share with others. Your testimony is very important to overcoming and is a very real witness to unbelievers.

"I AM THAT I AM - I WILL BE WHAT I WILL BE"

EXODUS 3:14, "Moses said to God, "Suppose I go to the Israelites and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they ask me, 'What is His name?' Then what shall I tell them?"

God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM. This is what you are to say to the Israelites: 'I AM has sent me to you.'" God also said to Moses, "Say to the Israelites, 'The Lord, the God of your fathers—the God of Abraham, the God of Isaac and the God of Jacob—has sent me to you.'

"This is My Name forever, the Name you shall call Me from generation to generation."

This is the first instance in Scripture when "YHVH" is introduced as the Name of the One True Living God, "I Am That I Am" or more accurately, "I Will Be What I Will Be"

YeHoVaH, God eternal who is self-existing and has always been and will always be. HE IS THE CREATOR OF ALL.

LEVITICUS 11:45, "I am the Lord, who brought you up out of Egypt to be your God; therefore be holy, because I am holy."

LEVITICUS 19:37, "Keep all My decrees and all My laws and follow them. I am the Lord."

ISAIAH 43:11, "I, even I, am the Lord, and apart from Me there is no Savior."

ISAIAH 46:3-4, "Listen to Me, you descendants of Jacob, all the remnant of the people of Israel, you whom I have upheld since your birth, and have carried since you were born. Even to your old age and gray hairs I am He, I am He who will sustain you. I have made you and I will carry you; I will sustain you and I will rescue you."

ISAIAH 46:9-10, "Remember the former things, those of long ago; I am God, and there is no other; I am God, and there is none like Me. I make known the end from the beginning, from ancient times, what is still to come. I say, "My purpose will stand, and I will do all that I please."

ISAIAH 48:12-13, "Listen to Me, Jacob, Israel, whom I have called: I am He; I am the First and I am the Last. My own hand laid the foundations of the earth, and my right hand spread out the heavens; when I summon them, they all stand up together."

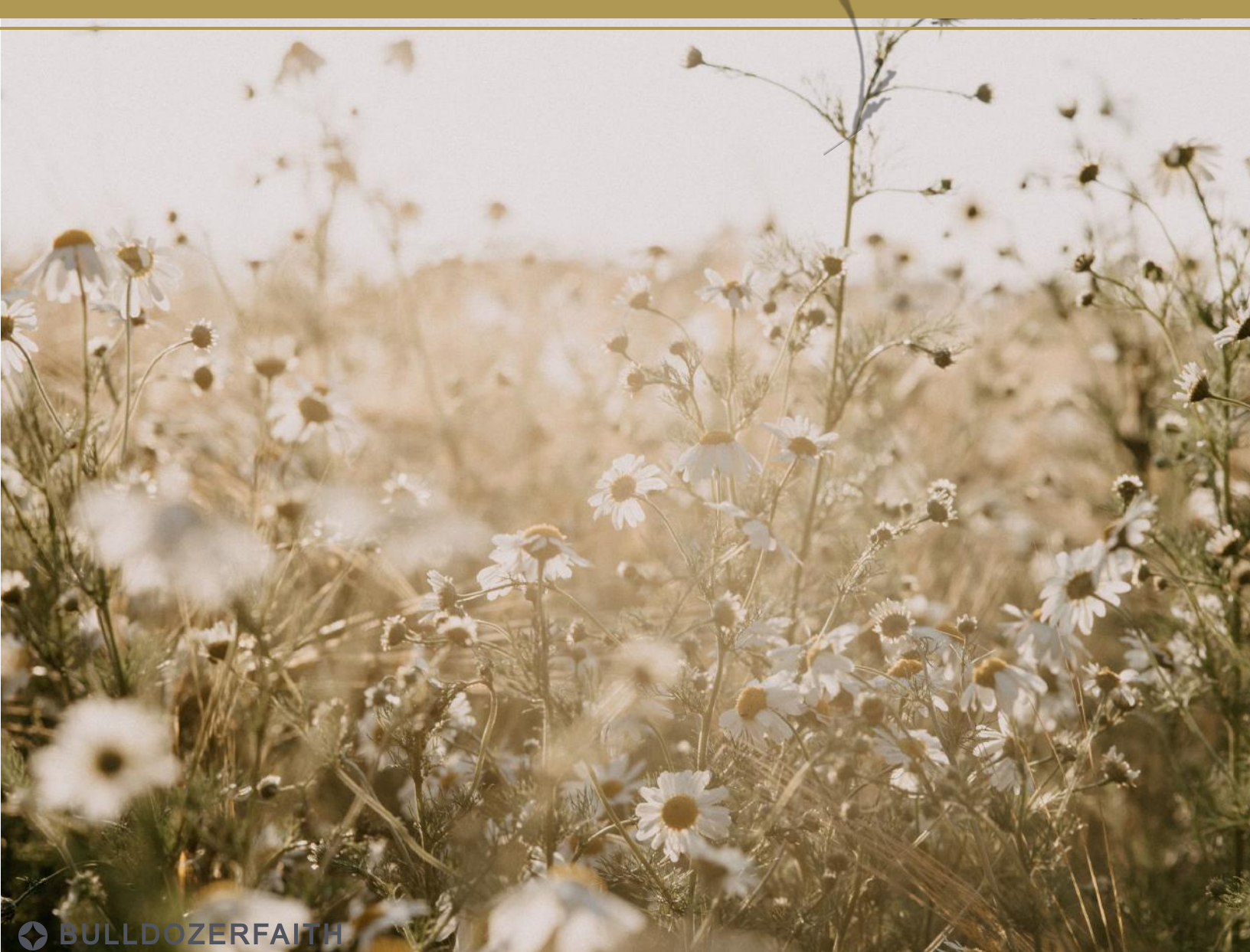

Recognizing Elohim's Love From The Perspective Of Being A Witness

- What is God's love all about?
- How do we recognize it?
- How important is it for us?

I'm so excited about what we will share because I want us to move into another realm where we are strengthening our witness and growing in Yehovah. We're talking about recognizing God's love and what He has to say to us from the position of "Being a witness."

You cannot be a witness if you've lost the fire of who Yehovah is within your life. You've got to be on fire to recognize what He has done for you.

What makes people go out and risk everything, including their reputation, to be a witness for Yehovah, even in the face of danger?

Yesterday, we talked about David Wilkinson and his little church, thinking, "What's all this about? We need to go out and be a witness." But David didn't just go anywhere; he went to a place of darkness and brought forth the Word of Yehovah to the worst gangsters in New York. Nicky Cruz's response when David Wilkinson said to him, "God loves you," was, "I could cut you up into pieces right here, right now." David replied, "You could cut me up into little pieces, spread them out all over the road, and every one of them will say, 'I love you, I love you.'"

How did David get to that place of confidence to make such a stand? It was because he recognized who Yeshua was and how much He meant to him.

Maybe you're struggling with witnessing and sharing your faith because you're feeling self-conscious, or perhaps you're thinking, "This is not for me."

Well, get ready because this series will ignite a fire in your belly and take you to a new dimension in the area of 'Being a witness' for Yehovah!

Have You Experienced The Love Of God?

When we look at the Scriptures and talk about God's love, we want to be able to communicate that love but to communicate the love of God, you have to experience the love of God.

I know many believers who are sincere and spend time in the Word, praying and going through all the right motions, but they're not excited or passionate about the love of God? It's almost like, "God, you need me, I'm here; I'm so glad you got me." Almost blasé.

John 3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life." When we recognize who Elohim is in the Scriptures, His desire for restoration becomes real to us. The plan of restoration from the fall of man is available to us through the power and work of Yeshua the Messiah.

In tough times and when tragedy strikes here in Israel, many Jewish people say, "Come, Messiah, come!" Why do they say, "Messiah come?" It's not just something we talk about at Sukkot when they brought the water up for the sacrifice during the daily offerings." Messiah, come!" is still said today in the land of Israel when difficulties are before people. That's how the religious see it.

RECOGNIZE GOD'S LOVE

As followers of Yeshua, Jesus we know that He has already come, and we want to experience the love of God.

"Father, I ask that You transform us with Your love, so we know how much You love us."

Yehovah sent His Son because He doesn't want anyone to perish. What an incredible opportunity for us, not just to experience the love of Elohim but to take the love of Elohim to this generation.

Romans 5:8, "But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." Please think about that for a moment.

1John 4:19, "We love because He first loved us." I want us to press in for a fresh outpouring of the love of God to a level that we will share our faith with others.

"But God demonstrates His own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us." You can't get a greater expression of love than that.

We need to understand that we do not deserve God's forgiveness, redemption, or love because we have all fallen short. We don't add up. But the Father's heart and desire is for His love to be revealed to us. He wants us to experience His love and recognize who He is.

TASK - I want you to take a moment right now to sit back and allow the Holy Spirit to minister the love of Elohim to you.

Find a nice quiet place where you won't be disturbed. This is your opportunity to experience His love if you have never felt it. God wants you to know that He is real and can reveal Himself to you in a way that you know it is Him.

Psalms 46:10, "Be still and know that I am God."

The Life Changing Events God Can Use To Change You.

We're about to share some verses from Psalm 139, and as we go through these verses, we recognize the heart of David towards his God and our God. [I want you to think about that for a moment.](#)

Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me." How do we get to the place of having this conviction in our hearts? Agreeing with what the Scripture says is not enough; we must have a life-changing event.

For many of us, even though we are of faith, it takes something in our lives to happen that makes us realize how precious our life is and how short our time is here on earth.

Have you ever faced a situation where you could have lost your life and seen God miraculously spare you? I have experienced that on a few occasions. One time was when I had Myocarditis which led to heart failure. Two or three times I sat down with my family, Haley and Hannah telling them how much I loved them and how much they meant to me. I didn't know if this would be my last day or if I would make it to another day.

What do we want to express in those moments? We want to communicate to others our love for them.

[I want you to picture this for a second:](#) Yehovah, God loved you so much that He gave His Son. When we experience the love of Yehovah, we are transformed by it.

When we magnify that within our lives, genuinely meditating on that point to understand it, our witness and delivery will be much more powerful.

Maybe the Father will bring events into our lives—trials and troubles for us to recognize just how important He is to us.

Should the Father have to use these things for us to experience and understand the love of Yehovah? Why can't we just come to the Word, to meditate and grow in it, in Yehovah? Why do we have to have tragedy and difficult events to open our eyes to the love of Yehovah? Unfortunately, the reality for us humans is that we are often focused on other things apart from the Kingdom of God. The enemy is fighting for our time to

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dilute us so we are not effective for the King. So, there are events that come into our life that bring change and challenge us in how we deliver and minister the love of Yehovah.

Are You Ready?

John 15:13, "Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends."

In this verse, Yeshua, Jesus is saying, "Listen, if you experience the love of Yehovah and you know who He is and what He has done for you, you will step out, even if it means laying your life down for the lives of others to bring them into a saving knowledge of salvation."

It doesn't take extraordinary people to bring supernatural change. We see a lot of transformation within our world today; it comes from ordinary people who catch the revelation of how to be connected to a mighty God. The supernatural should be our natural. We shouldn't think the supernatural might happen once every hundred years. We should be walking in the supernatural of Yehovah every day.

So, we want to identify the love of Yehovah; we want to experience the love of Elohim.

Are you ready to do that?

Knowing Just How Much God Cares For You.

Psalms 139:1-6, "You have searched me, Lord, and You know me. You know when I sit and when I rise; You perceive my thoughts from afar. You discern my going out and my lying down; You are familiar with all my ways. Before a word is on my tongue You, Lord, know it completely. You hem me in behind and before, and You lay your hand upon me. Such knowledge is too wonderful for me, too lofty for me to attain."

We recognize just how much God cares for us.

In these verses, David says, "God, you have a purpose for my life. I recognize that purpose is to take me forward to experience Your love for me. You protect me; You care for me."

Psalms 139:7-14, "Where can I go from Your Spirit? Where can I flee from Your presence? If I go up to the heavens, You are there; if I make my bed in the depths, You are there. If I rise on the wings of the dawn, if I settle on the far side of the sea, even there Your hand will guide me, Your right hand will hold me fast. If I say, "Surely the darkness will hide me and the light become night around me," even the darkness will not be dark to You; the night will shine like the day, for darkness is as light to You. For You created my inmost being; You knit me together in my mother's womb. I praise you because I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Your works are wonderful, I know that full well."

What are we witnessing as we experience these opening fourteen verses of the Scripture? Firstly, we recognize God's presence is everywhere.

When we go back to *John 3:16*, "For God so love the world that He gave His only Son," He didn't just put that out there; He desires that all will come to salvation.

That's why there's a judgment at the end of time, and every man will stand before Yehovah and give an account even just from the basis of creation.

Psalms 19:1-6, "The heavens declare the glory of God; the skies proclaim the work of His hands. Day after day they pour forth speech; night after night they reveal knowledge. They have no speech, they use no words; no sound is heard from them. Yet their voice goes out into all the earth, their words to the ends of the world. In the heavens God has pitched a tent for the sun. It is like a bridegroom coming out of his chamber, like a champion rejoicing to run his course. It rises at one end of the heavens and makes its circuit to the other; nothing is deprived of its warmth."

In these opening verses of Psalms 19, we see the power of the witness of creation. "There's no speech or language where their voice is not heard." It says, "Every single one of us has a God consciousness."

What causes people not to choose God is man's rebellion.

PSALMS 139

RECOGNIZE GOD'S LOVE

So, we can sit back and not choose Elohim and be in a rebellious state, but the reality is this; the Father has put within every one of us the desire to worship. He's given us the desire to know Him.

"He knits us together," as we read in Psalm 139, *"He created me, my innermost being. He knit me together in my mother's womb."* This is the God that I love and the God we are called to serve.

He didn't just create the universe and the world we live in, but He knit me together, He put me together, He knew me. He put the ability in me to choose life and to recognize who He is.

That's why we will come to a place of judgment based on 'man is without excuse.' You will have no excuse when you are before Yehovah because creation is a powerful witness.

Creation cries out at the beauty and wonders of who He is—it is speaking the reality of who He is.

When we look at the human body we can't even understand the brain or the eyeball in its fullness; it doesn't matter what technology we are using. The creation, by the hand of Elohim, the variations we see around the world, the animals He created, the flowers, the fish of the sea in the deep. Everywhere we look, we see the designing hand of a mighty God, a creative God who cares, who loves us. He created this environment for us to live in.

Man is very good at messing up the blessings of Yehovah. We have war, rumors of war, all these things going on right now. What happens at the hands of man? We see destruction.

When we look at what goes on within our hearts and minds, what does it take for us to be built up in Him? How do we get to that place where we experience the true love of Yehovah?

You cannot be a witness if you have not genuinely experienced the power of the love of Elohim because you will not have a desire to share your faith. So many people don't share their faith because it's like they have been disconnected from the truth and realization of the mighty hand of God and what He did within their life.

Delight In Yehovah, God's Word

Psalm 1:1, "Blessed is the one who does not walk in step with the wicked or stand in the way that sinners take or sit in the company of mockers." This should be our delight.

When we look around and see this wicked world, we've got to decide. Do we want to be a witness? Do we want to disciple and minister into the lives of our family members and people in our community? How are we going to do this?

We have got to get to that place where we delight in the instructions of Yehovah, His Torah, and on His Law, meditate day and night. What happens when we meditate day and night? We become empowered by the Spirit into a new realm, a new place. We move into a whole new dimension of who He is.

There is nothing more beautiful than hearing the testimony of God's love in others' lives. I said at the beginning, "If you have a testimony, share it with us so we can put it in our magazine newsletter each month." Why? Because people are so encouraged when they hear what God is doing.

So, what will you be like if you meditate on the Word day and night?

Psalms 1:3, "That person is like a tree planted by streams of water, which yields its fruit in season and whose leaf does not wither—whatever they do prospers."

It doesn't matter what storms or weather. You will be evergreen if it's icy, snowy, or cold. Hallelujah! Praise the name of Yeshua! You will be able to find comfort, assurance, and strength no matter what you face or what you're going through.

Maybe you are listening right now and are experiencing a tough time. Hear the word of Yehovah: "My love is growing deep inside you, My love will strengthen you, My love will empower you, My Spirit will comfort you." He will lift you.

You will be a witness and a testimony to the reality of God. People will say, "I recognize there is something different about you. You don't act like others in the things you experience and go through."

"Your leaf will not wither, whatever he does prospers." Hallelujah! Praise the name of Yeshua!

Kenny's Testimony Of Salvation

I want to share a little testimony with you because sometimes, when I sit back and take a moment to meditate on where I came from and where my life could have been if it wasn't for Yeshua. Where would I be right now?

I remember from a young age being so rebellious and demon-possessed. I went through my identity crisis at nine years old.

A new kid came to school, and we were all introduced, "This is Hamish, this is John, and this is Kenny, and he's a Christian!" My dad was a Pastor

I was thinking, "How could Hamish just be 'Hamish' and John be 'John?' Why have I got to be a 'Christian?' Why can't I just be "Kenny? Why can't I be who I am?" I was labeled because of who my dad was; they all knew Him as he would teach in the assemblies in the school.

I realized that something rose in me; it wasn't of God but rebellion. Every one of us will experience rebellion at some stage. We frequently minister to believers who often move into a spirit of rebellion through their difficulties and hardships.

If you're in that place right now, "I want to break that spirit of rebellion. As I share with you what happened to me, I pray that you will be set free right here and now. You will not continue down that road of destruction but will experience the fullness and the blessing of a mighty God."



So, I was nine years old, and the declaration that came out of my mouth was, "No one will ever call me a 'Christian' again because of who my dad is. I will have my own identity."

I started smoking immediately, got involved in violent and organized crime, and whatever I could do was against God. This behavior continued until I was 11 years old, and it got worse and worse.

You may think, "What can happen with a nine to eleven-year-old? Well, I'm talking about running away from home, stealing things. I had people locked up in jail at ten years old and all different types of crazy stuff because of what I did and said.

The chief of police nearly sent me off to a Borstal children's prison because of how I lived my life. I was involved in fights. I even had a baseball bat with broken glass on the bottom for battles and to come against people. I went to an extreme place of darkness, even at that young age.

When I was eleven years old, my parents sent me off to this Christian holiday camp on the island of Aaron. I don't want to tell you the whole story of salvation; I want to get to some critical points of what brought change to my life. I didn't go to any meetings because I was too busy wrecking the island, drinking, and doing all the things you shouldn't be doing. But it was my birthday, and they knew I had been skipping the meetings, so this time they made sure I was in the meeting.

An eleven-year-old boy stood up and shared his testimony of how God had supernaturally healed him of leukemia. As he spoke, the whole place was filled with the love of God; it was so powerful. The young boy was emotional, and it was difficult for him to speak. It was hard for him to share because he was so thankful that he had his life and that he had been supernaturally healed of leukemia in the name of Yeshua, Jesus.

He shared his testimony and talked about God. He spoke about how much he loved God and how much God cared for him. It was a testimony of being healed. As he shared, God's presence showed up. So, there I was, listening to this young boy sharing his testimony of how God healed him of leukemia. As he spoke, Yehovah's glory and manifestation filled the room.

I recognized the presence of Yehovah. I didn't confess faith in Yeshua; I was not a believer. I was in rebellion and demon-possessed, walking away from God.

Here in that moment, even in my sin, even in my brokenness, my rebellion, the presence of Yehovah was seeping in.

I proclaim right now that His presence is here. It doesn't matter what you've done, how evil or dark it might be because we just talked about, "I can go up to the heights, it doesn't matter where I go. I can cross the sea, go to the deep, go to that place of darkness. I will say, 'Surely the darkness will hide me and the light becomes night around me,' because our God will shine His light around you."

Suppose we are genuinely going to be a witness for God. In that case, we need to know what it means to break through into the fullness of His love, to experience the glory of the love of Yehovah.

As I walked out of that meeting that night, I encountered God; it was so powerful.

His presence was so real because this young boy was sharing his testimony. It wasn't just what happened to him; it was the reality that he spoke words of truth that impacted my life. These words of truth set you and I free; it's the knowing of the truth.

When we know the truth, we are set free.

We cannot be a witness or testimony if we have not experienced the fullness of the love of Elohim.

I believe today that you will experience an enriching of His love. You're going to experience the glory of Yehovah on another level. He is preparing our hearts to be a witness; He's preparing our hearts to be a testimony of the reality of God here on earth.

Like that young boy, when he shared his testimony on how much he loved God and how much God meant to him for healing him—that was what impacted my life.

That night in my tent on that holiday camp, I got my face before Elohim, and I repented. I laid aside all my rebellion and said to God, "I know I'm separated from you; I'm disconnected. I know I live in a house of love. I see your love in my father and mother and my sisters; I see your love all around." I got to sleep in a house of peace even though I was out jumping out the bedroom window and spending time with people filled with demonic spirits, evil, fear, and living in dangerous situations. My life was at risk; at any time, I could have been stabbed or killed.

But every night, I got to leave it all behind to go home and sleep in a house of love, a place where Elohim's love was established.

"I pray that every one of our homes will be a home that's established on the love of God so that our children and family will experience God's love throughout their lives."

So, as I said, I repented of my rebellion. I started repenting of all my sins and went through all the things I had done, all the shoplifting, stealing, violence, attacks against my parents and other believers, all the things I'd done; I repented before God. As I started to move into repentance and confess my sins before God, I felt the blood of Yeshua washing me, cleansing me, and setting me free. Oh! The joy that was coming into my life. As I was praying, "I love you, God, thank you for sending Jesus. I recognize now that you so loved the world and that you sent Yeshua. I recognize He is the Messiah. He was setting me free and transforming me. There was a gaping hole inside of me, which I was trying to fill with so many things that didn't fit. I was forcing them into that place, "This is my life, this is how I'm going to live my life, this is my decision, this is my way, my pride." I lived based on pride, and when I came to that place and humbled myself before Elohim, it was like all those things washed away. The glory of Yehovah filled me, and He cleansed me from the top of my head to the tips of my toes. He delivered me from all of my addictions; He set me free. It was an incredible time in the presence of Yehovah.

RECOGNIZE GOD'S LOVE

Growing In Yehovah, God's Love

I want you to think about the presence of God right now and how powerful the presence of God is? When you deal with love naturally and fall in love with your spouse, you're falling in love with another. You're connecting emotionally and everything that's associated with it. You feel so good; it's so wonderful and amazing. But, do we have that experience in the presence of Yehovah? Do we recognize God's love in an increasing measure? I believe that as we hear the testimony of lives changed and what God does in people's lives, it gives us an insight into a greater understanding of the love of God. As we look at the testimony of what we are reading here in Psalm 139, we see the confidence that David has in the will of God and the love that He shows for him. He recognizes that God's love was there before he was even born. God's love was set out before so he could come into an environment and experience the fullness of everything that God wanted to give him and had for him. *God's love is so full, and if you're in that place right now where you feel like His love is lacking and you're not experiencing the love of God, it's not because Yehovah doesn't want to pour His love into you.* What's stopping you from experiencing and embracing the love of Yehovah? What do you have in the way, and what barriers need to come down? *His glory and presence are here right now. He wants you to recognize His love, experience the joy of forgiveness, and experience healing.* Have you ever experienced the healing power of Yeshua? Have you ever been delivered? Look what Elohim has done. Has He set you free? Every one of us born again of the Spirit has encountered the living God. *I want you to think about your encounter right now; I want you to think about what Yeshua has done for you. I want you to recognize that right now and take a moment to say, "Thank you, God. Thank you that I'm not what I used to be; thank you for setting me free. You paid the price so I can be where I am today."*

Have You Made A Decision To Follow Yeshua, Jesus?

If you're watching right now and haven't made a decision for Yeshua, you know that you are hearing the truth concerning the word of God. You know that you are hearing it because you hear so much about Yeshua, Jesus, and people always talk about Him. They talk about their experience, and you don't have that experience, you don't have that knowledge, you don't have the understanding.

Hear the word of Yehovah, He wants you to hear, and He wants you to receive everything He has for you, right here. If you have never committed to Yeshua, stop now and don't wait another moment. You don't know how many days you have; you don't know how long your lifespan will be. We all think we're going to live forever, but the reality is, you don't know if this is your last day.

This is an urgent day for you; this is a day where you need to make a decision.

Do you recognize God's love and what He has done for you? Do you realize what He wants to do in your life right now? He wants to set you free. He wants to give you the authority to live your life in the freedom of Elohim; that's the God we serve. He is amazing, and He wants you to have victory. You cannot have success in the flesh over the devil; you need the Spirit of God living in you. You need Elohim within your life. Thank you, Father; what a blessing to open up on this Scripture.

Closing Prayer

"Father, I want to thank You for speaking to us. Thank you for changing my life, setting me free, and for the blood of Yeshua. Yeshua, You paid the price for me. I know what it is to be without You and the transformation that took place in my life when I received You. I want to thank you, God, for that transformation. Now, I ask you, Father, to speak through me. Will You minister to our children, our families our parents and whoever else we are to speak to? Father, every person who's hearing this right now and the person that we have to share the gospel with, I pray Father, for an increase in the anointing of the Holy Spirit; I pray for a greater revelation of the love of God, that we will be compelled because of Your love to share You with others, in Yeshua's name." Hallelujah!

This is how love is made complete among us so that we will have confidence on the day of judgment: In this world we are like Yeshua, Jesus. There is no fear in love. But perfect love drives out fear, because fear has to do with punishment. The one who fears is not made perfect in love.

We love because He first loved us. Whoever claims to love God yet hates a brother or sister is a liar. For whoever does not love their brother and sister, whom they have seen, cannot love God, whom they have not seen. And He has given us this command: Anyone who loves God must also love their brother and sister." 1John 4:17-21
