Firstly, let's establish CHRIST In Me

"And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of His Spirit who lives in you."

2CORINTHIANS 13:5, "Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. **Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you**—unless, of course, you fail the test?"

ROMANS 8:9-11, "You, however, are not in the realm of the flesh but are in the realm of the Spirit, **if indeed the Spirit of God lives in you**. And if anyone does not have the Spirit of Christ, they do not belong to Christ. **But if Christ is in you**, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of righteousness. **And if the Spirit of Him who raised Jesus from the dead is living in you**, He who raised Christ from the dead will also give life to your mortal bodies because of **His Spirit who lives in you**."

2CORINTHIANS 4:6-7, "For God, who said, "Let light shine out of darkness," **made His light shine in our hearts** to give us the light of the knowledge of God's glory displayed in the face of Christ. But **we have this treasure (Yeshua) in jars of clay (us)** to show that this all-surpassing power is from God and not from us."

GALATIANS 1:15-16, "But when God, who set me apart from my mother's womb and called me by His grace, was pleased **to reveal his Son in me** so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, my immediate response was not to consult any human being."

GALATIANS 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ and **I no longer live, but Christ lives in me**. The life I now live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me."

GALATIANS 4:19, "My dear children, for whom I am again in the pains of childbirth **until Christ is formed in you**."

EPHESIANS 2:6-10 "And God **raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him** in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, in order that in the coming ages He might show the incomparable riches of His grace, expressed in His kindness to us in Christ Jesus.

For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast. For we are God's handiwork, **created in Christ Jesus to do good works**, which God prepared in advance for us to do."

EPHESIANS 2:13, "But now in Christ Jesus you who once were far away **have been brought near** by the blood of Christ."

EPHESIANS 3:16-20, "I pray that out of His glorious riches He may strengthen you with power **through His Spirit in your inner being, so that Christ may dwell in your hearts through faith**. And I pray that you, being rooted and established in love, may have power, together with all the Lord's holy people, to grasp how wide and long and high and deep is the love of Christ, and to know this love that surpasses knowledge—**that you may be filled to the measure of all the fullness of God**. Now to Him who is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine, **according to His power that is at work within us**,"

COLOSSIANS 1:25-27, "I have become its servant by the commission God gave me to present to you the word of God in its fullness—the mystery that has been kept hidden for ages and generations, but is now disclosed to the Lord's people. To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, **which is Christ in you, the hope of glory**."

2THESSALONIANS 1:8-10, "He will punish those who do not know God and do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus. They will be punished with everlasting destruction and shut out from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of his might on the day **He comes to be glorified in His holy people** and to be marveled at among all those who have believed. **This includes you, because you believed our testimony to you**."

JOHN 14:20 "On that day you will realize that **I am in My Father and you are in Me and I am in you**."

JOHN 17:22-24, "**I have given them the glory that You gave Me**, that they may be one as we are one— **I in them and you in me—so that they may be brought to complete unity**. Then the world will know that You sent Me and have loved them even as You have loved Me."

JOHN 17:26, "I have made You known to them, and will continue to make You known in order that the love You have for Me may be in them and **that I Myself may be in them**."

PHILIPPIANS 4:13, "**I can do all this through Him who gives me strength**." (Christ dwelling within you)

Introduction

In Part 4, we are talking about Messiah in us and the importance of what it means to have Yeshua within our lives. It is vitally important because we're dealing with being in a relationship; it's not about religion. What does "Christ in you the hope of glory" mean?" It means to have Messiah in us. We share this when witnessing our faith and talking to people about salvation and the need to receive Yeshua. I will talk about how we receive Yeshua as we walk out this life in Messiah. Hallelujah

Opening Prayer

"Father, I want to thank You for this day. Thank you, Father, for the blessing of being found in You—Messiah in us, the hope of glory. You alone have set us free and transformed us by the blood of the Lamb, and we bless you, Father, for what You are doing in our lives. We pray that Your Name will be glorified through everything we say and do, in Yeshua's name." Amen

Significance Of Being Born Again

When we share our faith and invite people to receive Yeshua, we're saying, "You need to be born again of the Spirit." So, what does it mean to be born again of the Spirit?

Romans 10:9-10, "If you confess with your mouth Yeshua is Lord and believe in your heart that Elohim raised Him from the dead you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved."

What's interesting about this scripture is that it talks about our heart's response, and I want you to think about this for a moment. We talk about inviting people to ask Yeshua into their hearts, but what are we saying when we're saying, "Invite Him, Yeshua, into the heart, into the very center of who you are as a person?" This is an important decision that we are making because we are also dealing with circumcision. It's not about the circumcision of the flesh; it's about the circumcision of the heart. Hallelujah.

I don't know if you know this, but the Torah talks more about the circumcision of the heart than in the New Testament, which I like to call "The Messianic Writings."

So, we see here that if you "*Confess with your mouth that Yeshua is Lord and you believe in your heart that Elohim raised Him from the dead, you will be saved.*" We must identify with the Messiah's death, burial, and resurrection. This is the blessing and good news of the Gospel—Yeshua is alive!

The religious Jews don't want you to know about that because they want you to think those people who believe in Yeshua or Jesus have another religion. They see Jesus as just a 'good man who came and did a lot of good things. But historically, you can identify that after Yeshua was raised from the dead, He was seen by four hundred people who witnessed Him appearing over forty days before He was taken up before their very eyes to be caught up with the Father in heaven. Hallelujah

So, the importance of identifying with the risen Saviour is vitally important.

The Marriage Contract

Why did Yeshua have to die, and why was He raised? He died for our sins which is so important, "Christ in me the hope of glory." But He also died because He is the bridegroom, and we are His bride, the bride of Messiah.

Why do we have to be the bride, and why do we hear this bride language in the work of Yeshua?

ISRAEL WAS DIVORCED/JUDAH WAS NO LONGER MARRIED WHEN YESHUA (THE HUSBAND) DIED SO THERE WAS NO MARRIAGE CONTRACT ANYMORE!

"How long will you wander, unfaithful Daughter Israel?"

The Lord will create a new thing on earth —the woman will return to the man." Jeremiah 31

The Ten Commandments

And God spoke all these words:

"I am the Lord your God, who brought you out of Egypt, out of the land of slavery.

"You shall have no other gods before Me.

2. " You shall not make for yourself an image in the form of anything in heaven above or on the earth beneath or in the waters below. You shall not bow down to them or worship them; for I, the Lord your God, am a jealous God, punishing the children for the sin of the parents to the third and fourth generation of those who hate Me, but showing love to a thousand generations of those who love me and keep my commandments.

3. "You shall not misuse the name of the Lord your God, for the Lord will not hold anyone guiltless who misuses His Name.

4. "Remember the Sabbath day by keeping it holy. Six days you shall labor and do all your work, but the seventh day is a sabbath to the Lord your God. On it you shall not do any work, neither you, nor your son or daughter, nor your male or female servant, nor your animals, nor any foreigner residing in your towns. The Ketubah

(marriage contract)

"The days are coming," declares the Lord, "when I will make a new covenant with the people of Israel and with the people of Judah.

It will not be like the covenant I made with their ancestors when I took them by the hand to lead them out of Egypt, because they broke My covenant, though I was a husband to them," declares the Lord. "This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel after that time," declares the Lord.

"I will put MY LAW in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be My people. No longer will they teach their neighbor, or say to one another, 'Know the Lord,' because they will all know Me, from the least of them to the greatest," declares the Lord. "For I will forgive their wickedness and will remember their sins no more."

Jeremiah 31:31-34

"I will give you a new heart and put a new spirit in you; I will remove from you your heart of stone and give you a heart of flesh. And I will put My Spirit in you and move you to follow My decrees and be careful to keep My laws."

Ezekiel 36:26-27

"You show that you are a letter from Christ, the result of our ministry, written not with ink but with the Spirit of the living God, not on tablets of stone but on tablets of human hearts."

2Corinthians 3:3

CHRIST IN ME

In the Torah, we see the bride language through the work of Yeshua at Mt. Sinai because it's a marriage. The Ten Commandments are the Ketubah, the marriage contract.

Jeremiah 31:33, "This is the covenant I will make with the people of Israel after that time," declares the Lord. I will put My law in their minds and write it on their hearts. I will be their God, and they will be My people." He will put His commandments on our hearts, not on a stone like when He gave them to Moses, but on the flesh of our hearts. This new covenant is still a marriage contract, the Ketubah.

I am emphasizing this point so you understand why Yeshua died. It was so He could remarry Israel because, in Jeremiah, we see the divorce of the northern Kingdom. *Jeremiah 3:8, "I gave faithless Israel her certificate of divorce and sent her away because of all her adulteries."*

Through the work of Yeshua on the cross, we also see the separation from Judah, which took place because of Yeshua's death—marriage is only unto death. Once death happened, the marriage covenant was finished. Man sinned and was separated from Elohim, but when Yeshua died, He did a much deeper work than just dying for our sins. He was dying so He could remarry Israel.

That's why these things may sound a little complicated when we go back to Scripture, but we are trying to keep it simple. The Scriptures tell us we have a new covenant in Messiah. Hallelujah.

The Plan Of Redemption

Yeshua said when you go back to Torah, you will find out that it's all about Me; in fact, you will find Me on almost every page of the Torah. The stories in the Torah from Genesis to the end of Deuteronomy are about the Messiah and the redemption of all humankind. What is the Father's plan to redeem us?

He says that He will redeem us through the promises of Abraham, and as we read in the book of Hebrews, Abraham is the father of our faith.

It's not about the law because we received the righteousness of Yehovah by faith, and Yeshua died so He could remarry the whole house of Israel. That's why Ephesians talks about one new man.

Ephesians 2:14-15, "For He, Himself is our peace, who has made the two groups one and has destroyed the barrier, the dividing wall of hostility, by setting aside in His flesh the law with its commands and regulations. His purpose was to create in Himself one new humanity out of the two, thus making peace."

It's not about you from the concept of Israel and the church because it's talking about the Southern Kingdom and the Northern Kingdom coming together as one—the new man. That's why the covenant in Jeremiah, which we received by the blood of Yeshua in the work of Yeshua, is not a covenant for the Jews but for the House of Judah and the House of Israel. It is also not a covenant for the gentiles or the covenant of "The blood of Jesus" because the blood ratifies or confirms the covenant making it valid—it is not the covenant itself. We need to receive salvation in Messiah and be grafted into the Commonwealth of Israel with the promises of Israel.

Confession Of Faith

Romans 10:9-10 "If you confess with your mouth Yeshua is Lord and believe in your heart that Elohim raised Him from the dead you will be saved. For it is with your heart that you believe and are justified, and it is with your mouth that you profess your faith and are saved." This is why it's vital that we speak out our confession of faith. **You might speak it out to receive Him when you are on your own, but you still need to confess Yeshua before man. You can't deny Him; you must confess His Name. Hallelujah.**

Romans 10:11, "As Scripture says, "Anyone who believes in Him will never be put to shame." Those words are also found in the last few lines of *Isaiah 28:16, "So this is what the Sovereign Lord says: "See, I lay a stone in Zion, a tested stone, a precious cornerstone for a sure foundation; the one who relies on it will never be stricken with panic."*

Romans 10:12-13, "For there is no difference between Jew and Gentile—the same Lord is Lord of all and richly blesses all who call on Him, for, "Everyone who calls on the Name of the Lord will be saved."

A Risen Saviour

So, we want to recognize the salvation power at work within us. As we go back to the Scriptures, we can identify Yeshua was raised from the dead.

Take time to study the portions of Scripture that talk about the risen Saviour that we find within the Gospels and the book of Acts. Be encouraged as you read those scriptures because when we're sharing our faith with people, we are not just communicating to believe in Yeshua or Jesus; we're sharing for them to believe in a risen Lord and Saviour.

1Corinthians 15:55, "Where, O death, is your victory? Where, O death, is your sting?" The victory is in Messiah. He has risen from the dead, and He is the High Priest in the order of Melchizedek.

What's so unique about that is that Yeshua will never die and is the perfect sacrifice. When we are prepping for Passover, it's an excellent time to recognize Yeshua as the Passover lamb. When we come to Firstfruits, it represents the resurrection from the dead. Messiah rose from the dead on the third day, the day of Firstfruits. Hallelujah.

So, I want to encourage you to understand who we are in Messiah and our covenant with Him. We have to revisit our theology on this to gain a deeper understanding of the full message and teachings concerning the gospel of the Kingdom and our identity in the Messiah.

Test Yourself

2Corinthians 13:4-5, "For to be sure, He was crucified in weakness, yet He lives by God's power. Likewise, we are weak in Him, yet by God's power we will live with Him in dealing with you. Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves. Do you not realize that Christ Jesus is in you—unless, of course, you fail the test?"

Our focus as we look at the "I'm A Witness" series is that we take time to identify in our life who we are and are we walking in Yeshua. Are you in Messiah today, and do you choose to walk with Him? We talk to people about making Yeshua Lord of their life, receiving Him as their Lord and Saviour but is He Lord and Saviour of your life today?

How do we test and examine ourselves to see if we are found in Him? We do this by identifying if we are yielded to the Holy Spirit and living for Yeshua.

We can also look at some other Scriptures concerning the Messiah in us. **Galatians 2:20, "I have been crucified with Christ, and I no longer live, but Christ lives in me."**

So, when we are looking at examining ourselves, we look at who's in control of our lives and who's running our life. Do we recognize if it's, "No longer I that live but it's Messiah who lives in me and the life I now live in the flesh, I live by faith in the Son of Elohim who loves me and gave Himself for me?"

A Living Sacrifice

Let's think about the words, "I've been crucified." I've come to that place where I've taken up my execution stake to follow Yeshua and seek to lay my life down, to present my body as a living sacrifice as it says in **Romans 12:1, "Therefore, I urge you, brothers and sisters, in view of God's mercy, to offer your bodies as a living sacrifice, holy and pleasing to God—this is your true and proper worship."**

If you want to be in the perfect will of God, then we need to understand what it truly means to worship God by the sacrifice of our desires and own ways. These things are made easy when we receive Yeshua. You can't do it on your own, but when you receive Yeshua, you have the strength of God living in you. We have the authority of God dwelling within us.

Colossians 1:27, "To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory." Hallelujah.

This is why you can have confidence in your witness and who you are in Messiah. God will make a way where there seems to be no way. **Psalms 40, "He lifted me out of the slimy pit, out of the mud and mire; He set my feet on a rock and gave me a firm place to stand."** He lifts me out of the miry clay, He gives me that

firm place to stand. Yeshua, You are the hope of glory within my life!

When we deal with examining ourselves to see whether we are in the faith, Messiah in me, do we identify that we are His workmanship? *Ephesians 2:6, "And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus,"*

What's so important about this when we talk about Messiah in us is that we identify that it's no longer I that live, it's Messiah living in us. We just spoke on Colossians 1:27, Messiah in me is the hope of glory. So I no longer see myself from this earthly perspective. So when you look at yourself, who are you? I'm a new creation in Messiah; the old has gone. Hallelujah!, behold; all things are new!

Yes, there's a work that has to take place, and we want to examine ourselves to identify if there are any areas where Messiah doesn't have me. Are there areas in your life where He is not in control? How do we surrender those areas before Him?

It Is A Gift From God—Not By Works

Elohim raised us with Him; why? Because it's by grace, we have been saved, and this is the blessing when we share the Gospel. When you think you're helpless and don't have a future, you can receive Messiah in you, the hope of glory. We are called to be spiritually minded. We have the strength of Yehovah within our life.

Ephesians 2:6-9, "And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus, in order that in the coming ages He might show the incomparable riches of His grace, expressed in His kindness to us in Christ Jesus. For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God— not by works, so that no one can boast."

Never forget that! Some people get saved; it just takes bad theology steeped in works to get them all bogged down into a religious place instead of relationship. They lose confidence in what it means to walk in the Spirit.

Something happens with another person or a group of people, and they think, "If that's the witness and testimony of the Spirit, I don't want it." They end up backing away into a place where they lose the power and the authority of the Spirit within their life.

I want to call you back to that place and identify what it truly means to have Messiah in us. I want you to picture that day, that time when you said yes to Yeshua. I want you to picture that moment when your life was supernaturally changed, when you became born again of the Spirit.

What joy we receive when we identify who He is and what He has to say to us. For it's by grace you have been saved, so never lose the grace of Elohim. Many people say, "Well, it's just the grace unto salvation." We don't want greasy grace where you receive Yeshua and live like hell and say, "It's ok, I'm under grace, I can do whatever I like." No! You can't. That's why in 2Corinthians 13, we talked about how to examine ourselves. Test yourself!

Come on! be real. If you lie to yourself, you're the greatest fool of all. Lying to yourself is the most foolish thing you can ever do. Don't lie to yourself. In being real before Yehovah, you can break through and have authority.

When we confess our sins before Yehovah and man, we say, "I'm holding myself accountable to be right standing before my God. I recognize the grace that has saved me and that I was in a place of lack and needed a Saviour."

"Father, You are the one who sent your Son, the Saviour of the world. It says here we've been saved through grace, through faith, and it's not from yourselves. It's a gift from God."

One thing I want us to capture is just how much Elohim wants to grant you and give you gifts. We talked about receiving the gifts of the Spirit and the importance of what it truly means to be spiritually minded, to operate and function in the Spirit. It is vitally important.

So, it's not by yourselves; it's by the gift of Elohim. It's not by works because you didn't do anything for this

salvation, Yeshua did it all. He paid it all for you and me that no one can boast. We are Elohim's workmanship created in Messiah Yeshua to do good work, which Elohim prepared in advance for us to do.

The Heart Of The Message

This is the heart of what I want to get to in this message, *John 3:16*, "For Elohim so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son that whoever believes in Him would not perish but have everlasting life," and so we have the foundation.

This is why He's sending His Son so we can be one with the Father and be reunited through Yeshua and the Gospel of salvation.

We also understand where we are heading because we are Elohim's workmanship. We're testing to see if we are in the faith. Is Yeshua dwelling in you, or are there areas in your life where your response is, "No, no, no, You're over here, but I'm over here. This is my little corner!" Let's surrender those areas before Him, for we are Elohim's workmanship created in Messiah Yeshua to do good works, which Elohim prepared in advance for us to do. We are called to be effective for the Kingdom.

Now I want you to think about your life. Do you feel like you're out on a limb and going through the motions each day, trying to do things to build your faith, but you're not applying your life to the work that Elohim has prepared in advance for you to do?

I know what it's like to be on the battleground, in rough, hard places. How do I handle the difficult times and the challenges of life? I look back at the areas of identification of Messiah in me. I know the word He's given me.

Maybe He spoke a word to you, and you've forgotten it. Perhaps you don't want to talk about the word of Yehovah over your life because when you look at that word. You look at your circumstances, and you recognize they are not the same, and the life you are living now seems so far away from that word. Then draw near to Him right now and make this confession. "Messiah, you are in me. You are my hope of glory." Draw near to Him today, and He will draw near to you.

It comes back to that scripture in *2Corinthians 5:17*, "Therefore, if anyone is in Christ, the new creation has come: The old has gone, the new is here!"

So is Messiah in you? Do you feel like you're living in the Spirit, the new life, or do you compartmentalize things of Messiah and live life in the flesh, not making room for Messiah and the works He has created for you to do? I want us to identify what we are doing with our life. Only the things we do in Messiah count; anything else will pass away, so it doesn't matter. We should be striving for the things of Elohim. When we go back to *2Corinthians 13*, "Examine yourselves to see whether you are in the faith; test yourselves," ask yourself these questions; Am I walking in the faith and pressing forward in the word of Yehovah?

Yehovah Is Your Source

What is one of the things that cause the disconnect? When people see a lack of provision, they try and do things their way, and in many regards, we can start slowing down the purposes of Elohim. We're not seeing the supernatural transforming power of the Spirit and what it truly means to wait before Yehovah. Where my God leads, He provides. In the middle of pandemics, crisis after crisis, and all the things going on in the world as well as attacks because of your faith, you might not see that manifestation of *Philippians 4:19*, "And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus."

Maybe you're in that place where you're like, "Father, I need you. I don't see your provision or blessings. I need your provision and blessing."

"Then, Father, we ask that You breakthrough in the midst of the persecution and difficult things we face. We will see the abundance of a mighty God and be equipped to do the works of ministry in Yeshua's name. Amen."

CHRIST IN ME

Romans 8:10, "But if Christ is in you, then even though your body is subject to death because of sin, the Spirit gives life because of righteousness." So what is Yeshua bringing to you today?

He's bringing you the Spirit of life, the Ruach HaKodesh. He says, "Receive My life, My righteousness. Your righteousness is as filthy rags, so receive My righteousness. You are right standing before Me." says Yehovah. As we saw in *Ephesians 2:6, "And God raised us up with Christ and seated us with Him in the heavenly realms in Christ Jesus."* We have confidence in where we stand with a mighty God.

Oh! Hallelujah, Messiah in me, He is the hope of glory.

So, when we share our faith and say to someone, "Receive Yeshua into your heart, accept Yeshua as your Lord," we are saying, "When you do this and repent of your sins, you receive the grace of God. That gift has nothing to do with your work; it's a gift from Elohim, so you can't boast. When you receive this gift from Elohim, you will experience the supernatural, the life of the Messiah. It will become your very life as you walk in Messiah's power and authority."

Surrender Your Life To Jesus

You might be in a place where you feel like you have no purpose; you don't know how to function or what to do with your life. Then surrender your life to Yeshua and allow Him to bless you richly. Allow Him to use you to make a difference in this generation and this world.

The transformation that happens when we receive Yeshua is incredible; it's beautiful and unique. That's why it says in the Scriptures that Messiah in us is our hope of glory.

Colossians 1:27, "To them God has chosen to make known among the Gentiles the glorious riches of this mystery, which is Christ in you, the hope of glory."

This is the mystery, the richness, and the glory that He wants to give you.

Messiah in you is the mystery. He is the key and the reason we rejoice in our salvation.

We're not just agreeing with a message when you accept Yeshua. He says, "I'm coming to dwell with you."

Revelation 3:19-20, "Those whom I love I rebuke and discipline. So be earnest and repent. Here I am! I stand at the door and knock. If anyone hears My voice and opens the door, I will come in and eat with that person, and they with Me." Yeshua is not speaking to the lost; He's talking to the believer.

What's so beautiful about this scripture is that many people share this scripture when people are initially coming to faith in Messiah, but this is a scripture for you even if you have been saved twenty, thirty, forty, or one hundred years. Yeshua says, "I want to dine with you. I want to fellowship with you. I stand at the door and knock."

Are there areas in our life that we need to repent of? Is there stuff that needs to be done in our lives? Let's turn around and come back and say, "Yeshua, I need you to 'sup with me,' 'dwell in me' in the fullness of your glory." It doesn't matter what you face in your life in this realm; you are rich in Him. "Father, help us to use the gifts and talents that you have given us for your Kingdom and to make a difference for your Kingdom." Please receive this word today as we read, Messiah in me. as the hope of my glory.

Closing Prayer

["Father, I want to thank you for this time in Your word, to stand upon Your promises and lift Your Name to proclaim your Lordship over our lives. Messiah, dwell in us richly. If there are areas in our lives that we need to repent, then bring that to your attention so we can deal with it to see the fullness of Your glory manifest within our lives. I also pray, Father, as we test and identify if we genuinely are found in You, examining ourselves to make sure. Father, I thank You for the blessing of the transformation You have done in my life, and this is my testimony, "My God is able, He is an awesome God, a righteous King, ruler over everything, and I stand in the authority of Yeshua.](#)

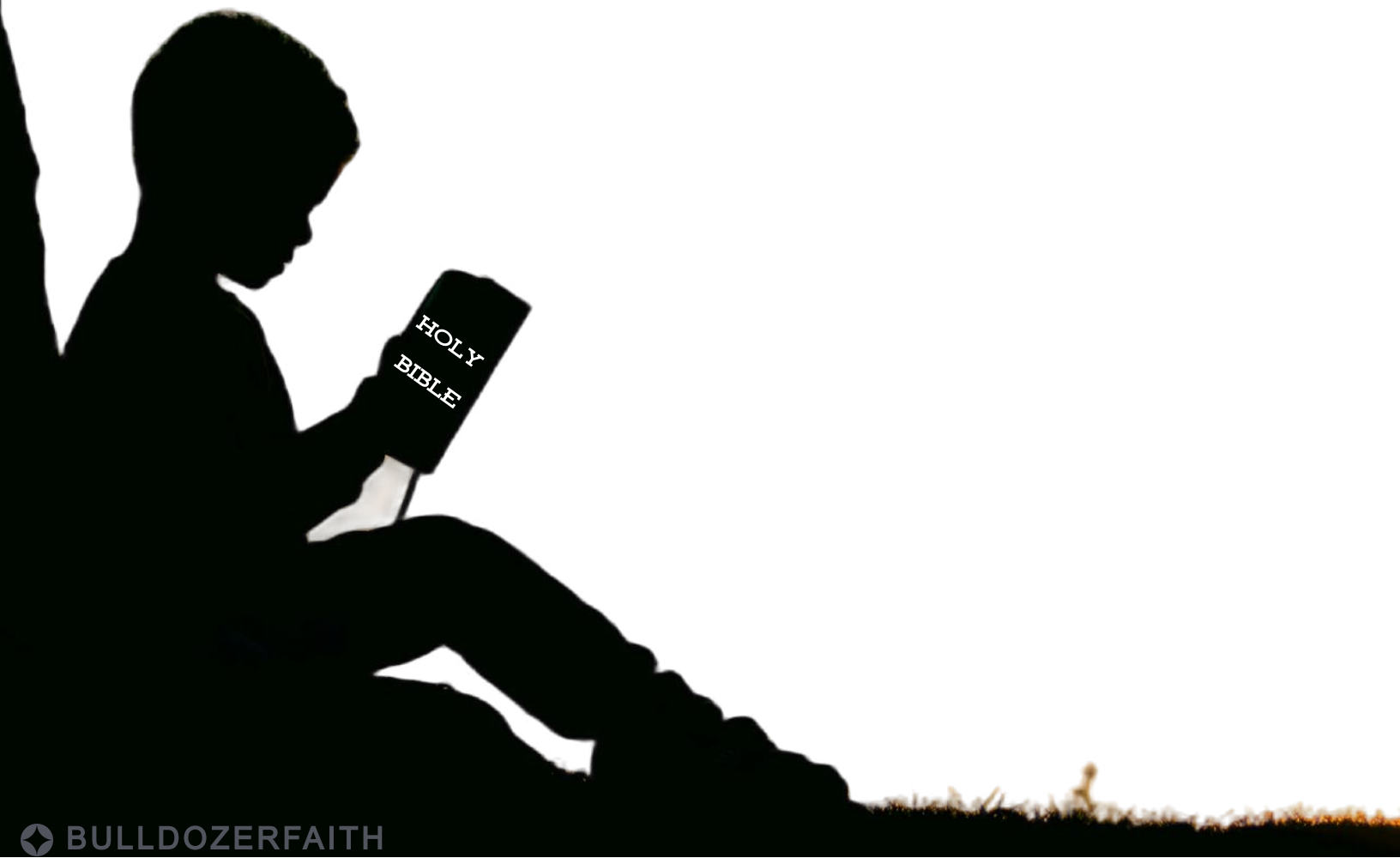



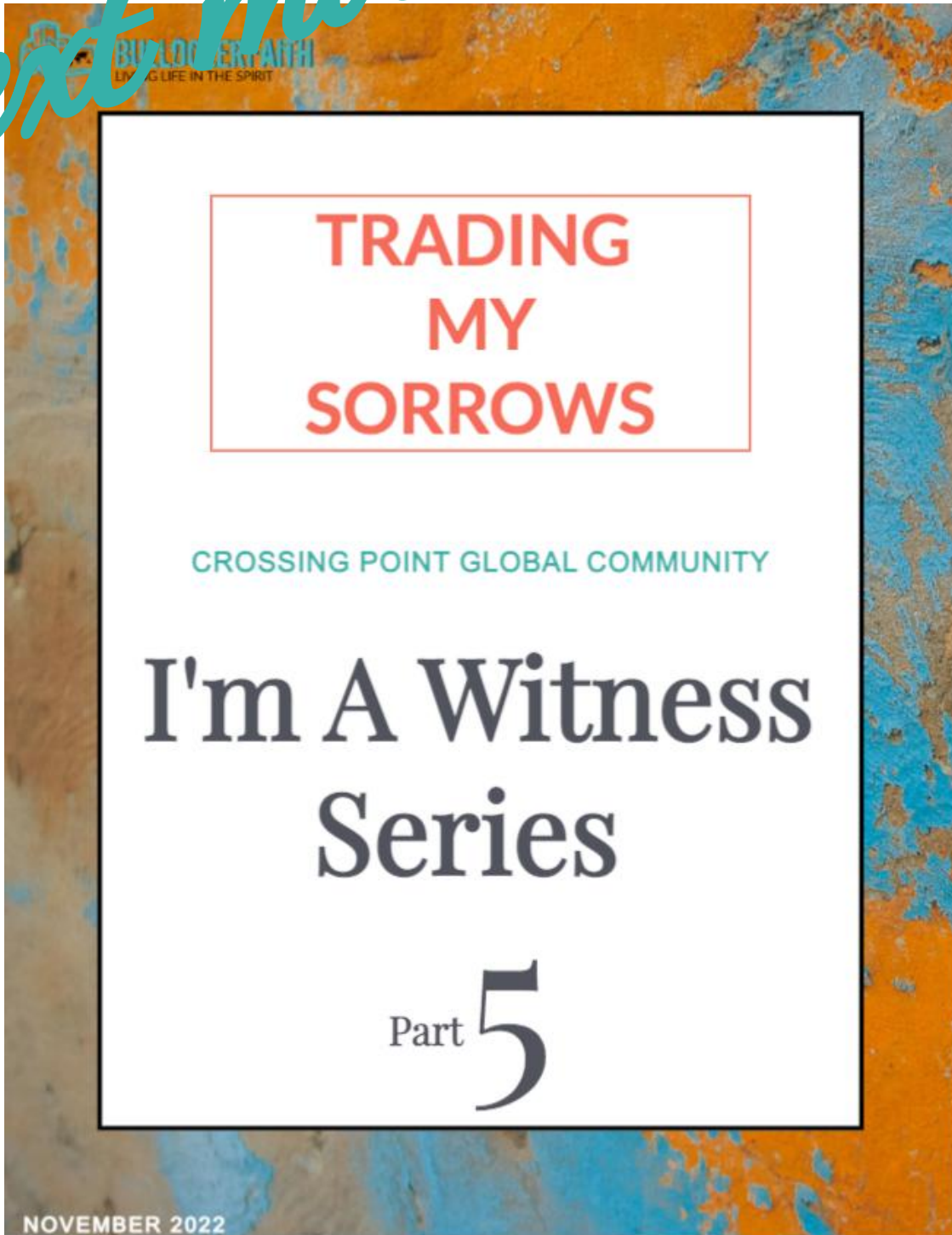
