THE TRIP BEGINS...



Interview with Kenny from the perspective of being on a Mission and stepping out in the name of Yeshua(Jesus) of Nazareth, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Jacob.

QUESTION: What was the high moment during your trip so far?

KENNY: I think the times where I connected with people in their grief over losing loved ones. Nothing can compare with that moment's importance when a total stranger opens up and trusts you with their stories. As you weep with them and share their pain, sometimes there are no words that come to mind to pray. It's just about being there with them at that moment, knowing God is the one who heals a broken heart.

QUESTION: What was the low moment during your trip so far?

KENNY: The only time I felt low was when I entered a new park to set up the prayer tent. I always arrive with an expectation that God is going to do miracles. Sometimes you will pick up on heavy oppression depending on what evil-doing has occurred in that area. It doesn't take long to claim that ground for Yehovah as you pray and ask the Holy Spirit how to break the strongholds. It's about taking the pain of what has occurred in that location and turning it around for the glory of Yehovah.

QUESTION: What was the funniest moment during your trip so far?

KENNY: I entered an Applebees one day to buy dinner and decided to sit at the bar with a bunch of guys who were all talking. This was at the time of the school shooting in Texas, so everyone was talking about what had happened. One guy made a comment, "One thing I know is that Jesus is coming back at any moment." to which I responded by saying, "Well, that's not actually true..." which then led to a two and a-half-hour Bible study around the bar at Applebees. Even people who weren't a part of our conversation had stopped watching their sports on the big screen and listened. Upon leaving thirty minutes after the place had closed, as the barmaid had let us stay while she was cleaning, she said to me, "I've worked here many years, and I'm a backslidden Christian, but I can tell you that there was more of God here in this bar tonight than I have ever experienced in church." I never expected to hear that!

QUESTION: How is this mission trip different from the ones you have done before?

KENNY: Every mission trip is a new experience with different opportunities to pray and help people. One thing the Father taught me at the very beginning of my ministry was "Never rely on yesterday's manna." I took this as no matter if yesterday was a great day and I saw the Holy Spirit work in many peoples' lives; I still needed to humble myself before the Father in preparation for the next day. Recognizing your vulnerability before God is a great strength. This is His work that I am doing, and I always want to seek His face and instructions for what He wants to happen. If you have followed our ministry for a while, you would have seen this happen many times as the Holy Spirit leads us. We don't have a "professional setup." When God moves, we move. Other than that, we stay put, pray and wait for the next move.

QUESTION: What effect has this trip had on your relationship with Yehovah?

KENNY: Two years ago, before Covid happened, the Father gave me a prophetic word about setting up a Mission Agency. I never question God over His timeframes to fulfill His promises, but I didn't thought it would take this long to happen. On this trip, I have been supernaturally energized and always rejoicing to be a part of what I am witnessing taking shape. Being a co-worker with God as He shows Himself and His love to people is the most incredible job I could ever do!! Every day is exciting, as He is showing me it is not just about this mission trip. This is the stepping stone to a much bigger picture of revealing His glory to the world, and it's not dependent on anything that man does.

QUESTION: Last thoughts about this trip?

KENNY: This has been a prophetic journey to demonstrate that God's word is true. There will be a Mission Agency established, and everything that we are witnessing confirms this is the will of Yehovah. Every person who has believed and supported this trip has been given a word from Yehovah on it's importance.

Isaiah 55:11, "so My word that proceeds from My mouth will not return to Me empty, but it will accomplish what I please, and it will prosper where I send it."

MARK 16:15-18, "He(Jesus) said to them, "Go into all the world and preach the gospel to all creation. Whoever believes and is baptized will be saved, but whoever does not believe will be condemned. And these signs will accompany those who believe: In My Name they will drive out demons; they will speak in new tongues; they will pick up snakes with their hands; and when they drink deadly poison, it will not hurt them at all; they will place their hands on sick people, and they will get well."

LUKE 24:46-49, "He(Jesus) told them, "This is what is written: The Messiah will suffer and rise from the dead on the third day, and repentance for the forgiveness of sins will be preached in His Name to all nations, beginning at Jerusalem. You are witnesses of these things. I am going to send you what My Father has promised; but stay in the city until you have been clothed with power from on high(Holy Spirit/RuachHaKodesh).

The Father gave me a clear word that this is the hour for the ministry to be full time on missions and involved in mission training. We are now in place and ready for the birthing of a new season of growth. This trip has set the foundation of change for BulldozerFaith to establish a Mission Agency to train, equip and release disciples into the world to make other disciples. There is no better way to teach what this looks like than to be an example. Our plan was to go for three months, staying in eight to ten locations as the Holy Spirit led. I didn't know all the plans of Yehovah at the time, only that He was saying, "Get mobilised and ready to go!"

We knew we would be doing street work and evangelising across different parts of the country; in parks, on coastal beaches, at markets, car parks—anywhere we could set up our prayer tent. We reached out to those in need as we went. This meant praying for opportunities to minister to the lost and brokenhearted, setting the captives free and sharing the joy of knowing Yeshua, our Savior. Those who want to be active in evangelism were able to join with us and experience how we witnessed. Some people travelled quite a distance to be a part of what we were doing which was amazing. We also connected with local fellowships and Pastors to share the Gospel and the Hebraic foundation of our faith. We prayed to experience many divine appointments. Even before I left Israel at the airport, God was at work. I met a fellow believer, Cornu and we shared the Gospel as we waited. I stepped out in faith with only the word from Yehovah, "To go!" and believed God for miracles to provide the finance, equipment, food and accommodation for the trip. We were also praying for the use of a ute and box trailer to carry all our gear for the next three months. As I flew out with not much money and a prayer in my heart, I didn't know where I was going to stay when I arrived at Charlotte. I didn't even know if someone was going to be there to pick me up. But what I did know is that Yehovah is faithfull and by the time I arrived in Charlotte, I had a lift from the airport, accommodation and the use of a ute and box trailer for the trip. Praise Elohim!

A SHEPHERD'S HEART

John 21:15-19, "When they had finished eating, Yeshua(Jesus) said to Simon Peter, "Simon son of John, do you love Me more than these?"

"Yes, Lord," he said, "You know that I love You."

Jesus said, "Feed my lambs."

Again Jesus said, "Simon son of John, do you love Me?"

He answered, "Yes, Lord, You know that I love You."

Jesus said, "Take care of My sheep."

The third time He said to him, "Simon son of John, do you love Me?"

Peter was hurt because Jesus asked him the third time, "Do you love Me?"

He said, "Lord, you know all things; You know that I love You."

Jesus said, "Feed My sheep."

Very truly I tell you, when you were younger you dressed yourself and went where you wanted; but when you are old you will stretch out your hands, and someone else will dress you and lead you where you do not want to go." Jesus said this to indicate the kind of death by which Peter would glorify God.

Then He said to him, "Follow Me!"

What I see here is a beautiful picture of God's redeeming love. Yeshua doesn't need to know if Peter really loves Him, He knows Peter's heart intimately already. Man looks on the outside but God looks to the inside.

He is showing Peter He still loves him and trusts him to care for His precious followers (sheep) after He has gone. But Peter had denied Yeshua not once or twice but three times. If you have ever messed up so bad that you feel you have blown things with God and He can't use you, remember this story. Think how Peter felt in that moment when the rooster crowed, confirming that Yeshua knew Peter better than Peter knew himself?

He must of felt there was no where to hide, his shame was

evident for everyone to see. He must of felt he had lost everything and any chance of serving his precious Lord and Savior. In His compassion for Peter and knowing his weaknesses, Yeshua is using this opportunity to teach Peter a valuable Kingdom lesson and one we all need to learn. It is one thing to say that you believe in Jesus and will lay your life down before Him but how do we know that it is real?

James 2:17 says, "...faith without works is dead."

"Most assuredly, I say to you, he who does not enter the sheepfold by the door, but climbs up some other way, the same is a thief and a robber. The Workers Are Few

Jesus went through all the towns and villages, teaching in their synagogues, proclaiming the good news of the Kingdom and healing every disease and sickness.

When He saw the crowds, He had compassion on them, because they were harassed and helpless, like sheep without a shepherd.

Then He said to His disciples, "The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few. Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field."

Matthew 9:35-38



CHARACTERISTICS OF SHEEP

Don't be fooled by the saying, "dumb sheep," because sheep are quite intelligent. It's just that God created them so that they would need a good strong leader to keep them in the good pastures and not stray away, potentially falling over a cliff. This is where they have earned the title, "dumb sheep," because they will all follow each other over a cliff to their death if they see the other sheep doing that very thing.

This is where you're parents got the saying, "If all your friends jumped off a bridge, would you?"

The idea is it's not good to do something stupid, even if someone else is doing it.

Sheep originally had hair that shed naturally during spring and summer. Sheep now are selectively bred for wool that does not shed and will continue to grow, weighing the animal down, and creating health and mobility issues.

A sheep/lamb was most likely the animal chosen by Elohim to be the first sacrifice, atoning for Adam and Eve's sin and whose skin became their covering.

Yeshua is described as the Lamb of God that takes away the sins of the world, so it appears to line up.

Sheep have distinctive personalities, rich emotional lives, and strong family ties, remaining in their maternal groups for life. Being highly social animals who like to be around other sheep they are familiar with, they will become distressed if you separate them from their flock. Sheep need other sheep to feel safe. You can tell they are happy when they do what other sheep do, which confirms their innate ability to learn from observing others. Of course, this also can be a negative if they are following "dumb sheep" or a shepherd who has no idea how to care for them. The health of sheep depends on a shepherd with good observation skills and extensive knowledge who is aware of the need to set extended boundaries, more so than other grazing animals. Because sheep are prey animals and therefore susceptible to predators, they have evolved to effectively disguise easily recognizable signs of suffering. This makes it difficult to spot when they are in pain or distress till it is too late. A shepherd who knows his sheep, knows the warning signs when something is wrong.

***"My sheep hear My voice, and I know them, and they follow Me."

Sheep will follow a leader. If you can get one sheep moving, the rest will follow. The leading sheep tend to be the most dominant in the flock. This is why they need a shepherd, as they will also follow someone they know and trust, recognizing a familiar face. They have specialized areas in their brain for facial recognition, much like humans. They can identify the face of fifty other sheep or human faces and remember them for up to two years. They can also differentiate between facial expressions, preferring a smile over a frown. What makes them so intelligent is their complex social interactions and how they communicate vocally to each other using different sounds to express different emotions, much like humans, cats, dogs and pigs.

They are meek in character, usually very quiet and gentle, holding themselves aloof from the world. To get sheep to like you, you must spend time with them and earn their trust. They can be affectionate in their own way. They are easily frightened by unexpected or loud noises, shadows, or anything that resembles a predator. This is why they are also hesitant to move into dark or enclosed areas, and only by turning on a light will you be able to lead them into an enclosed area like a barn, at night. Their vision is impressive. With their head down in a grazing position, sheep can see in all directions—an excellent defensive adaption against predators.

Made new friends who adopted me as family and fed me in the park!



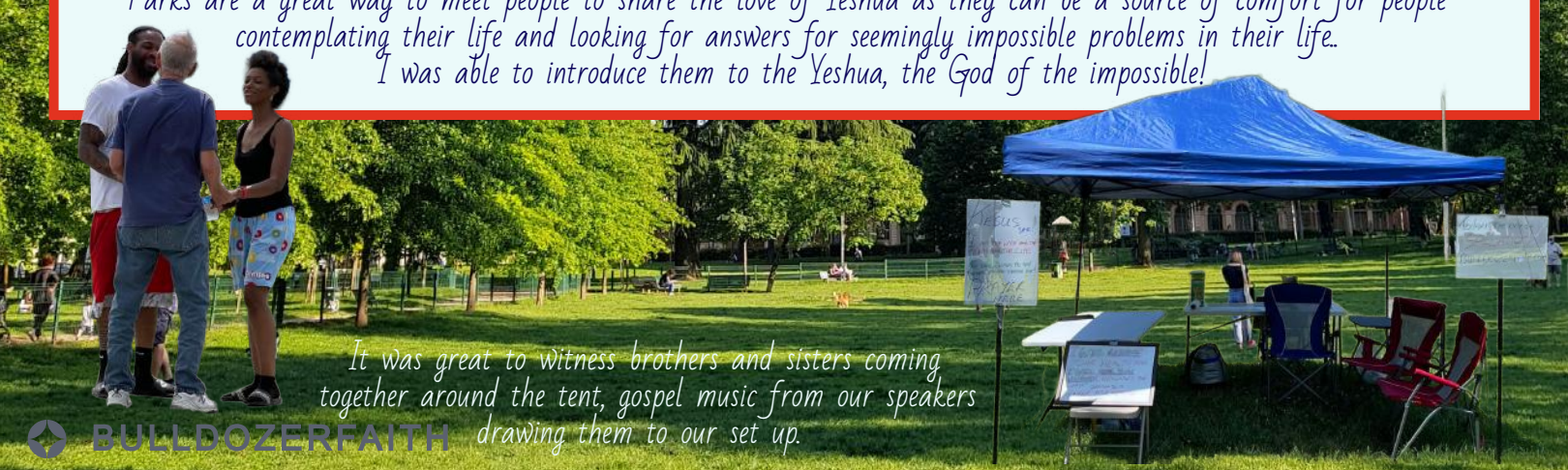
God cares for the broken hearted and ministers to those in need. This is Danny who drove miles to be in this park to pray for God's help.

Maybe today it could be your personal prayer?

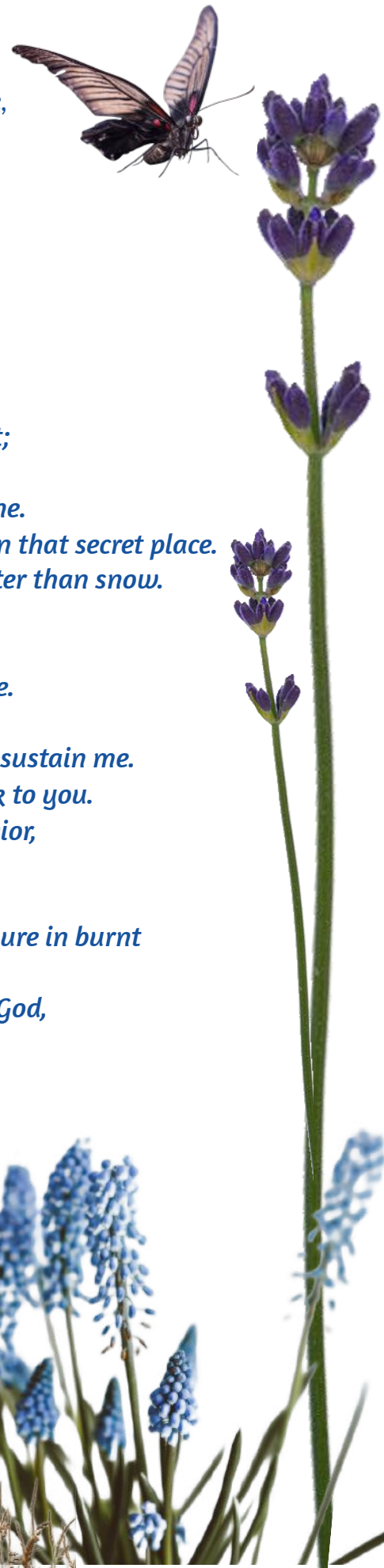
Psalms 51

In 2004 I came forward at a small country church in Missouri to tell the Pastor I felt a calling for a pastoral type of position. I felt the Spirit within me wanting to help others and teach the truth. For the next few years, I went to a couple of different churches trying to walk in the position of pastor assistant. I went to pastor training and seminars. I trained in the pastor position, but not the role of Pastor. It felt more like training for a job. I would go to church after church, and within six months, the Pastor would leave the church, and I would be relieved of my position. I was frustrated with the system of trying to walk in a position rather than walking in a "gifting."

In 2013 I was in a car accident and broke my back in 8 places. While recovering from a broken back, I studied the Bible for three years. Even though I could not go to churches, I kept fellowship and made sure I had mentors like Kenny Russell and a man named Michael. Over the years, several people came up to me and asked, "Are you a pastor?" or, "You should go to seminary." My family even told me to go and just receive a certificate from the State of Missouri and pay for an ordination. It did not feel right to me.

Our Father would make my ordination when it was time. I always thought I should "walk in the gift," not force the gift.

I was disabled, and now I could not work our farm. My wife and I bought a camper and started to work as volunteers on campgrounds. We would tell others about Yeshua (Jesus) and baptize those who wanted to walk in Him. I was finally walking in my gift. My family and I did this for three years.

Kenny Russell had stopped by the house on his last night in Missouri during his mission trip in 2022. I invited a friend over, and we sang worship songs with my wife and children. What a great night this was, laughing and singing. It was getting late, and Kenny looked at me and said the Holy Spirit wants me to ordain you as a Pastor. I was filled with emotion or the Spirit, maybe both. I told Kenny for a long time I was told I should be a Pastor. I walked in the gift of it but was never ordained in it. My faith in walking in the gifts was established from studying the Bible. It is very important to me to walk in those gifts being led by the Holy Spirit instead of trying to walk in a "position." I grabbed a chair and then Kenny, my friend, wife, and children, prayed over me. Kenny spoke these words over me.

**"I will give you the keys of the Kingdom of heaven.
Whatever you bind on earth
will be bound in heaven..."
Mathew 16:9**

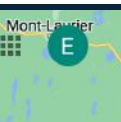
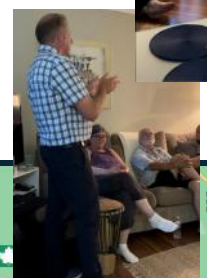

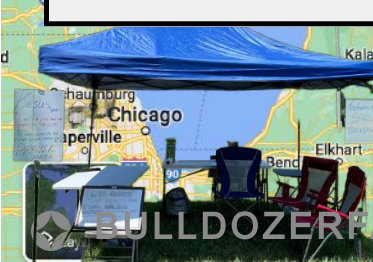
