

This Series aims to highlight some of the key elements we need to have established within our lives to increase our witness and share our faith in Yeshua with the lost and broken-hearted.

In Part 1, we discussed the importance of love, recognizing that God loves us.

In Part 2, we will be looking at the area of 'help' and understanding how much Yehovah, God loves us and how He provides help for us, especially in our time of need.

Who is Yeshua, Jesus here for? He is here to reach out to those in trouble, those who recognize they need salvation and deliverance. We want to reflect on what that means to us in life, so we have authority when we minister the Word to this generation.

Prayer

"Father, we want to thank You for this day. I pray, Father, as we come around Your Word, You will minister to us. Our desire Father is that we will be a witness for You and understand the transforming power of what You have done within our lives. We want to identify our walk and how we experience You through connecting who You are within the Scriptures.

We want to know the Word on which we stand because Yeshua, You are that solid rock. We stand upon the rock of Yeshua at this time. We understand how important it is to be secure in You and within Your Word. So, as we spend time in the Scriptures, I pray that Your Word will come alive to us, and You will minister to us. I pray Your fire will be within our hearts, and You will supernaturally transform us.

The supernatural is meant to be our natural. Father, we ask You to give us eyes to see in the Spirit, that You give us ears to hear by the Spirit so we can function in accordance with Your will and purpose. We ask that signs, wonders, and miracles be a significant part of our lives for You to reveal who You are to those in need, those who are broken-hearted.

Father, we know that You are with us, and this is not religion; it's a relationship. We recognize that we need You. As we press in today in the area of "Help is on the way," we know that You are the God who supplies all of our needs and the one who delivers us. You're the one who makes a way where there seems to be no way. So, Father, we thank You for the Word and as we delve into the Word, have Your way in our hearts today, in Yeshua's name." Hallelujah

Who Is Yeshua, Jesus In Your Life?


Isaiah 41:10, "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand." The focus I want to look at is the combination of when you see a scripture concerning the help of Yehovah; you will always see that it is surrounded by who Yehovah, Jesus is, "Fear not, I am with you."

I want you to picture where Yeshua is within your life today. Is He with you? Have you made that decision to follow Him?

We are looking at critical areas where we should be concerning our faith as we are sharing and being a witness. We are a witness because the living reality of the Scriptures is alive within our lives. We want to be walking in the life of the Spirit. Hallelujah!

Isaiah 41:10, "So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with My righteous right hand."

What Elohim is saying in this verse is, "I'm going to make a way for you to become everything that I have created you to be." He will establish who He is within our lives. Thank you, Father.



Who Can You Share With Today?

In the area of help, one of the scriptures that I enjoyed is Psalm 121. I want to share this portion of Scripture for us to meditate on this word.

I hope you set time aside daily to press as we do in these devotion times to capture a word from Yehovah. In Part 1, we prayed, "Father, is there someone we need to minister to and bring the revelation of the Gospel of the Kingdom to? Who do we share the love of Elohim with at this time?"

As we inquire of the Father, I believe He will put people on our hearts. He'll open up the doors for us to speak out words of encouragement and open up the way for us to minister the truth of Yehovah to this generation.

So, don't forget that as we go through this and look at establishing the love of God, the help of God within our lives, we want to ask the Father, are there people in need that we can minister to?

Yehovah, God Is Bigger Than Your Circumstances

Psalm 121:1, "I lift up my eyes to the mountains—where does my help come from?" opens with that question, "Where does my help come from?" Sometimes we go through circumstances, and as we look at who we are, our abilities, and strengths, we recognize we are in situations far bigger than anything we can comprehend. As we lift our eyes to the mountains and see God's creation, we know Yehovah's authority. We recognize, "You are bigger than I am. Father, I want to be found in You. I lift up my eyes to the mountains; where does my help come?"

Verse 2, "My help comes from Yehovah, the Maker of heaven and earth." So, we recognize that He is the Creator and made us. In Psalms 139, we read that "He knit me together in my mother's womb." He is very much a part of every element of who we are.

This is very important in our witness as we minister to people and share the truth of the Gospel of the Kingdom. We recognize the Father knows every one of us. He is involved in every element of our lives.

You might be sitting in a place thinking, "Why does God even care about me? Does He cares about the small details in my life?" I want you to know that He is a loving and caring God and He is here for you today. Maybe you're reading right now, and you feel like the circumstances and things you face are way bigger than you can comprehend or overcome.

This is why we lift our eyes to the mountains. We recognize, "Father, You are my Creator, You are the Maker of heaven and earth. That's where my help comes; it comes from You."

It's interesting as we open up this portion of Scripture from the Psalmist. It's a cry for deliverance, "Where does my help come from?" This is a Psalm of hope because the Psalmist answers the question without waiting; he isn't without any hope; he already knows the answer.

I believe this happens within our hearts when we recognize we are in a place of need, even before we are saved. Will you lift your eyes and recognize that you must turn to Yehovah?

It's in our brokenness and the place where we can't move forward that we can call on the name of Yehovah. *Romans 10:13, "Everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved."* We have got to get to that place of receiving from Him.

"My help comes from the Lord, the Maker of heaven and earth." If you don't choose your help from the Lord, you're going to choose your help from a source that is inconsistent. Man's help is not what we need. It might get you through the odd trial and thing that you face but everything within this world will be shaken. We need to have a reliance on Yehovah.

Yehovah, God Is Faithful To Keep His Word

Verses 3-4, "He will not let your foot slip—He who watches over you will not slumber; indeed, He who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep." He's not saying, "My help comes from the Lord. He's the Maker of heaven and earth," he's bringing forth an answer; he's moving into the third person, "He will

So, it starts with, "I lift my eyes to the hills," and the Psalmist says, "follow my example," This is what we want to do as we witness and share our faith. We want people to see our lives and say to them, "He will not let your foot slip."

To understand when he says, "He who watches over you will not slumber." Yehovah will not fall asleep amid the needs and things you face, along with the difficulties that are before you.

You may be in a place of prayer and pressing in because you need help, and you need the Father to intervene. Let me tell you something; I believe God will do miracles today.

If you've been calling out for help and saying, "Father, I need your healing power and deliverance, I need You to come in on my behalf. Please bring us out of lack. I need You to bring us out of brokenness and bring forth your restoration."

He says this, "I'm a God who watches over. I will not let your foot slip; I will not slumber."

So, "He who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep."

He's not going to miss the mark concerning your life. He's not going to miss the mark concerning His promises for Israel.

You can look towards Israel, and you can see the testimony of who Yehovah is and everything that He stands for. This is vitally important that we take hold of what the Scripture says, "Indeed, He who watches over Israel will neither slumber nor sleep." The promises in the Word concerning Israel are going to come to pass. We'll see the fullness of prophecy as the Father gathers His people from the world's nations and brings complete restoration to the Kingdom of Yehovah on this earth. This is the day in which we are living where we are seeing prophecy being fulfilled.

So, you can rely on a God who's not going to slumber or sleep, and you might be thinking, "This is too good to be true. Are you telling me that God is not going to miss the mark? That He knows where I'm at, He knows what I'm going through; He knows what I'm facing?"

Yehovah, God Will Keep You From Harm

Verses 5-6, "The Lord watches over you—the Lord is your shade at your right hand; the sun will not harm you by day, nor the moon by night." We see here that it talks about from one side of your day to the other side of your day, from the brightness of the sun to the darkest of the night. He is saying that you will not be harmed, that you will be in the shade of His right hand.

Verses 7-8, "The Lord will keep you from all harm—He will watch over your life; the Lord will watch over your coming and going both now and forevermore." As we look at this portion of Scripture, it's not saying that you're not going to face difficult times in challenging places.

Still, He said, "I will keep you, I'm going to watch over your life, I'm going to bring you through if you will call on My Name." The key is that we've got to get to where we call upon His Name.

I was thinking about this importance when witnessing and sharing our faith. What are we sharing? We are sharing the good news of a mighty God. He is excellent and worthy of being praised. We shout Hallelujah at the good news of who He is, but good news is only good news when you're faced with a bad news situation.

So, when we are witnessing, we're witnessing to people in the place of need. We're identifying where people are at so we can minister to them and share His Word.

Hebrews 13:6, "So we say with confidence, "The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?" Paul is quoting from Psalm 118:6-7.

When we understand who we are from an eternal perspective we can understand the goodness of Yehovah and what He has for each and every one of us.

I want you to know this is a great day and God says this, "I am your help in a time of need."

Doing Right By Each Other

Hebrews 13:1, "Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters," This is the blessing of being in the body of the Messiah; we can be an encouragement and a strength to each other. One person might have a gift in one area; another has a gift in another area. How can we walk together with the differences and how the Father has made us when we are called to be those who love each other?

Hebrews13:2, "Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers, for by so doing, some people have shown hospitality to angels without knowing it." What an awesome Scripture. What do we learn from the opening of this portion of Scripture? We understand there is authority and power in the love of the Messiah. As we grow in Messiah, we should allow what Yeshua is doing in our lives to impact the lives of other believers and the broken-hearted's lives.

If you're struggling with being a witness, you've got to go over these foundational things to establish what brought the transformation within your life. Firstly, you received the love of Yehovah.

In Part 1, I talked about the testimony of a young man sharing how he was supernaturally healed of leukemia and how the glory and love of Yehovah fell on the place.

I was a heathen and separated from Elohim. Still, even in that lost state, I could experience and be surrounded by the love of Yehovah. I could even see how much He cared, not just for the young boy sharing the testimony of how God saved his life and delivered him from leukemia but also that God loved me. This is what's so important: we engage and connect with the love of Yehovah.

Verses 1-2, "Keep on loving one another as brothers and sisters. Do not forget to show hospitality to strangers" There are times when angels will show up in our entertainment, and it's sometimes identifying; we don't know if they're angels; they look like ordinary people.

Verse 3," Continue to remember those in prison as if you were together with them in prison, and those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering." This is about identifying with others.

So, what we see here in the place of help and the position of walking together is a testimony of an overcoming Spirit that we can share with the lives of others. Sharing a testimony with others gives them the confidence and encouragement to see deliverance within their lives.

Then it goes on to something that you think, what's that doing here in how we love and walk with each other?

Verse 4, "Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure, for God will judge the adulterer and all the sexually immoral. Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have because God has said, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."

This portion of Scripture is saying, "Keep your eye focused on Yehovah as your source. Don't get emotionally tangled into sin and other areas and things thinking that this is where your answer can come from."

The Father is saying, "You use this vulnerability of what it truly means to walk in brotherly love, and you use that to bring damage and sin into the community of believers. It's not going to go well for you." The Father is saying, "Keep your eyes fixed on me." "He says, "Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you." Psalm 118:6-7, "The Lord is with me; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me? The Lord is with me; He is my helper. I look in triumph on my enemies." I believe this is a word for someone right now where you are being falsely accused, attacked and people are seeking to destroy who you are.

The Father is saying this, "You can look in triumph on your enemy, it's better to take refuge in Yehovah then to trust in man."

It's amazing how you see this portion of Scripture from Psalm 118 and it's pushed into this little section on the importance of the love of Messiah in our relationship, in our social duties as believers in Messiah in Hebrews 13. We have those key areas on how we should live amongst the brothers and sisters in Yehovah. "Yehovah is my help, I will not be afraid. What can man do to me?" It's better to take refuge in Yehovah than to trust in man. This is our call when we go out and share the gospel.

Kenny's Testimony Of How Yehovah, God Helped Him

In the area of help and recognizing who Yeshua is in your life, where are the areas that He has helped you? Take a moment and think about where Where God has intervened and helped you? Has He stepped in and made a way?

I'll never forget the day when I was preaching the gospel on the streets in the UK. I was travelling up and down from London to Glasgow at night on the bus praying and ministering to people, it was awesome. One day I was in Buchanan St bus station in Glasgow and I was there praising the Father, everything is good. The next minute I was surrounded by a whole bunch of hooligans who started sticking knives into me. There were blades pressing into my stomach and back. They said to me, "Hey Mister, give us your money or we'll drop you right here, right now." That is a time where I needed the help of Yehovah. How did the help of Yeshua come at that moment?

Well firstly, one of the things that we teach on a regular basis at BulldozerFaith is about, "Living life in the Spirit." We talk about the importance of hearing and knowing the voice of the Spirit. How can we be effective in our faith if we are disconnected from the voice of Yehovah? We need to know His voice and every time we come to the Word, we come knowing this realisation and the importance of it.

"Father, as I read through the Word, I want to know your voice. I want to know not just what the Scripture is saying, yes within its context. But what are you saying to me, is this a Word for me?"

We don't need to be whacked out maniacs where we come up with all these different systems. One thing that makes me a little sick and gets me a bit mad is when people talk about special signs between them and God. "God's given me this sign, this is my number, when I see this number, I know it's God." You are not called to be blind, trying to feel your way through life with little signs. You can open your eyes in the Spirit and know what it means to be in intimate fellowship with Yehovah. You don't have to have the signs of the number 7 or 27, this is what Kabbalah and foreign gods run after. They set up all these different systems so that you can identify what way you should go and what truth is. I don't care about signs. If angels come along and they give you signs that goes against the Scripture, don't follow those signs as you'll end up in the pit. I'm not looking for those signs, I'm looking to be steadfast and secure in the presence of Yehovah, to know His voice.

So, when you hear teachers and people running after signs what they are telling you is that they don't know how to be secure in the presence of Yehovah or how to seek for His voice for His way and instructions. We've got to grow up in the faith, we've got to mature in the faith. Yes, as baby believers, you might see significance in all these little things, but we've got to get to that place where we are walking in true fellowship with Yehovah. Then we can receive from Him and understand what He is saying to us. So, in that moment because I spend time walking in the Spirit, listen to the voice of the Spirit, when the place and the time of need came and those knives were sticking in me, piercing through my clothes, the Father gave me a word. I looked at the one guy in front of me who was the leader, He was the one with the greatest boldness out of all the young people there. I said, "You have no idea who you're messing. I'm going to count to 10 and you better be gone from here or you will find out who I am." I started to countdown because this was a word from Yehovah in the place of need. "Father, I need your help," was my cry when that incident happened. All of a sudden, the words of the Spirit came forth to bring forth deliverance.I counted down, "10, 9, 8, 7," and there was no sign of deliverance, no sign of movement," 6, 5, 4, 3," and still no sign of movement. "What is behind this Word? Where is the authority of the Spirit in the midst of this countdown?"

Then when I got to that very last number, it was a supernatural moment in the presence of Yehovah. Boom! Every single one of those young boys scattered instantly and all those blades came out from me. They ran off as fast as they possibly could. I never had to give up any money, I didn't have to lose my life or end up in hospital because MY GOD IS MY HELPER. He will provide a way, He will make a way but we need to know how to listen to His voice.

Doing Right By Each Other Cont.

Everyone has their hands out looking for deliverance, for someone to come along and help them in their place of need. But guess what, you're going to find yourself right back there in that same place in a future date.

The help that the Father is offering through the Word is this, "I'm going to bring you to a place where you won't just experience help for that one moment, but you will experience what it truly means to walk with the Helper." I love what it says about the Ruach HaKodesh, the Holy Spirit. He will be our Helper; He will lead us into truth. We've got to recognize if we're in that place where we need help?

I was going through one of our past newsletters and reading one of the testimonies from a few months ago about the lady who had the toothache and what she was going through. She was identifying when I said, "Place your hand on the part of your body where you're sick." She was thinking, "Well, I don't know if I really want to do that," and then she said, 'It was like the pride rising up." She knew she had a need and needed help but it took a little bit of overcoming the pride of man to come to that place to receive help. Some people are in that place when it comes to sharing the Gospel. They know they are in a bad situation and in a place of need but the last thing they want to do is call out to Yehovah.

They don't want to call out to God and what did we see in *Psalm 121,"I lift my eyes to the hill-where does my help come from?"*

My testimony is this—I've been walking in faith for decades and through all of my time walking with Yehovah, there is many times where I have lifted up my eyes to the mountains. I've said, "Father, You are my source, You are my help. I know that you will bring me through this. I know that no matter what I face, You are the creator of the universe and I put my trust in you." There is something beautiful about identifying the help the Father has for us.

Be Bold In Your Witness

What happens if people don't want help? During the life and ministry of Yeshua and I love what He says in John 8 as there was a really big debate going on and Yeshua was not holding back any punches. He was coming against the religious Pharisees who were coming against Him and basically accusing Him, saying, "Who do you think You are?"

I want to read a few portions of Scripture here because I want you to see that we've got to be bold in our witness. Sometimes in the place of witnessing we will be before people who don't want to listen because they don't want to hear the truth. Can the words to the rebellious break through to bring forth salvation? I encourage you to read the whole chapter of John 8. We see how precise Yeshua is attacking that religious spirit. He's talking about, "Who's your daddy? You think Abraham is your dad, you're children of Abraham?" He starts hitting them so hard in those areas.

At the beginning of John 8, a woman is caught in the act of adultery and brought before Yeshua. The Pharisees tried setting a trap for Yeshua to trip Him up. They were hoping He would slip up and make the wrong decision so they could say, "Hahaha, You dealt with this wrong."

Verse 7, "When they kept on questioning Him, He straightened up and said to them, "Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." He's saying, "For all you who have not committed adultery, have you got the ability to throw a stone, or what about other sins within your life? Who are you because according to the law of Moses, you have to have both parties brought before the judge, so I am not going to judge based on one person coming forward." In the end, the testimony of Yeshua and the way He handled the situation brought that woman to a place where she could receive forgiveness.

This is what the Father does; He will bring us to the place of our sin where we can receive forgiveness. *Verse 10-11, "Yeshua, Jesus straightened up and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?" "No one, Sir," she said. "Then neither do I condemn you," Yeshua, Jesus declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin."*

JOHN 8, Verses 1-30

"...but Yeshua, Jesus went to the Mount of Olives. At dawn He appeared again in the temple courts, where all the people gathered around Him, and He sat down to teach them. The teachers of the law and the Pharisees brought in a woman caught in adultery. They made her stand before the group and said to Yeshua, "Teacher, this woman was caught in the act of adultery. In the Law Moses commanded us to stone such women. Now what do you say?"

They were using this question as a trap, in order to have a basis for accusing Him.

But Yeshua bent down and started to write on the ground with His finger. When they kept on questioning Him, He straightened up and said to them, "Let any one of you who is without sin be the first to throw a stone at her." Again He stooped down and wrote on the ground. At this, those who heard began to go away one at a time, the older ones first, until only Yeshua, was left, with the woman still standing there.

Yeshua straightened up and asked her, "Woman, where are they? Has no one condemned you?"

"No one, Sir," she said. "Then neither do I condemn you," Yeshua declared. "Go now and leave your life of sin."

Dispute Over Yeshua, Jesus' Testimony

When Yeshua spoke again to the people, He said, "I am the light

of the world. Whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life."

The Pharisees challenged Him, "Here You are, appearing as Your own witness; Your testimony is not valid." Yeshua answered, "Even if I testify on My own behalf, My testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going. But you have no idea where I come from or where I am going. You judge by human standards; I pass judgment on no one. But if I do judge, My decisions are true, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father, who sent Me. In your own law it is written that the testimony of two witnesses is true. I am one who testifies for Myself; My other witness is the Father, who sent Me."

Then they asked Him, "Where is Your father?"

"You do not know Me or My Father," Yeshua replied. "If you knew Me, you would know My Father also." He spoke these words while teaching in the temple courts near the place where the offerings were put. Yet no one seized Him, because His hour had not yet come.

Dispute Over Who Yeshua, Jesus Is

Once more Yeshua said to them, "I am going away, and you will look for Me, and you will die in your sin. Where I go, you cannot come."

This made the Jews ask, "Will He kill himself? Is that why He says, 'Where I go, you cannot come'?" But He continued, "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world. I told you that you would die in your sins; if you do not believe that I am He, you will indeed die in your sins." "Who are You?" they asked.

"Just what I have been telling you from the beginning," Yeshua replied. "I have much to say in judgment of you. But He who sent Me is trustworthy, and what I have heard from Him I tell the world."

They did not understand that He was telling them about His Father. So Yeshua said, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He and that I do nothing on My own but speak just what the Father has taught Me. The One who sent Me is with Me; He has not left Me alone, for I always do what pleases Him." Even as He spoke, many believed in Him."



When we come to Yeshua to receive the help, He won't just give us help to get us out of that situation; He will bring forth the transformation that needs to take place within our lives by the power of the Holy Spirit. We are born again of the Spirit.

If you are reading and have not received Yeshua, Jesus, you are thinking, "Well, I'm too dirty; I've got too many sins. I've got too many troubles; I'm too prideful to come before Yeshua."

Then hear the word of Yehovah, "Come to Yeshua and leave your life of sin, allow Yeshua to be your help."

In that testimony, as I was going through the newsletter of the woman with the toothache, I loved the part when she started to be obedient to the word the Father gave me during that broadcast. It was," Praise Him for your healing after you've laid hands on the place thats needs healing." That upset her, "I don't want to do this out loud. Why do I have to do that?" she said to herself.

In the action of obedience and following through, the manifestation of the total healing took place within her life, and immediately, she had no toothache and was experiencing the deliverance of Yehovah. That's how powerful our God is.

Go And Sin No More

I want to read a few more portions here in John 8 because of everything we're dealing with in this time together.

We're dealing with Yeshua being our help and the importance of how we witness as we share the Gospel. As we said in Part 1, you cannot be effective in evangelism if you lose connection with what Yeshua has done in your life.

So, we want to pray for that alignment and reconnection. Don't tell me how blessed you are in knowing more about the Scripture if you are not effectively sharing your faith and bringing transformation into the lives of those around you. Hallelujah! We are called to go out into the nations and make disciples, sharing the love of Yeshua.

John 8:12, "When Jesus spoke again to the people, He said, "I am the light of the world. Whoever follows me will never walk in darkness, but will have the light of life." What a powerful statement, and how does that relate to your life? Do you experience the Father delivering you from darkness through Yeshua Hamachiach? He takes us from darkness into His marvelous light when we experience salvation by accepting Yeshua and dealing with our sin.

"Go and sin no more." We left our sin behind and called on the name of Yehovah in the time of our need. In the place of brokenness, we will be saved and will experience salvation. Yeshua truly is the, "light of the world, whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness."

Living A Selfless Life

I can testify through all my years of walking in faith and through those times when I was walking through the valley of the shadow of death, I did not need to fear any evil or be afraid of what was in front of me because our God delivers us, even when we are facing death.

In Part 1, I talked about dealing with my physical heart and having myocarditis. I had those moments where I sat down with Hayley and Hannah and said, "I don't know if I'm going to live another day; I love you." I shared my love for them. We don't know how long our lives will be or if this day will be our last.

So, the question is—are we making decisions within our lives that have eternal value and eternal importance? Everything we do for ourselves dies with us, but everything we do unto Messiah and others will continue. As we minister to others, even if we die, that will continue.

Let that thought sink in for a moment. Isn't that powerful? Isn't it amazing that the Father is calling us to a place where we live a selfless life to serve the purposes of Yehovah? Suppose our whole focus is on being the better me. In that case, we're going to miss the glory in the blessing of what it truly means to minister to the helpless and the broken-hearted.

Who Are You And Where Do You Come From?

John 8:12, "I am the light of the World, whoever follows Me will never walk in darkness, but He will have the light of life." When Yeshua says this, He's not saying this in the house group with all the believers, no! Verse 13, "The Pharisees challenged Him, "Here You are, appearing as Your own witness; Your testimony is not valid." Opposition to the mission! It's ok when people oppose us when we speak the truth and allow the Holy Spirit to minister.

Verse 14-16, "Yeshua, Jesus answered, "Even if I testify on My own behalf, My testimony is valid, for I know where I came from and where I am going. But you have no idea where I come from or where I am going. You judge by human standards; I pass judgment on no one. But if I do judge, my decisions are true, because I am not alone. I stand with the Father, who sent Me."

We are called to be people who understand where we came from and who we are. Even in the place of opposition, when you are being persecuted for the truth, you do not have to shrink back or be afraid because of where you've come from and where you're going. This is what we learn from Yeshua, Jesus.

Is The Light Of Yeshua In Your Life?

Verse 17, "In your own law it is written that the testimony of two witnesses is true. I am one who testifies for Myself; my other witness is the Father, who sent Me." Hallelujah for the testimony of Yeshua.

Verse 18, "Then they asked Him, "Where is Your Father?"

Picture this. When the Jews start talking about the "Father," they are not calling Yehovah "Father." That would be like calling Him, "ABBA, Father. Are you kidding? You can't call God your Father."

Verse 19-20, "You do not know Me or my Father," Yeshua, Jesus replied. "If you knew Me, you would know My Father also." He spoke these words while teaching in the temple courts near the place where the offerings were put. Yet no one seized Him, because His hour had not yet come."

Verse 21, "Once more Yeshua said to them, "I am going away, and you will look for Me, and you will die in your sin. Where I go, you cannot come." As if what He had already said wasn't enough. "Let me poke you again in the eyeball." Why is Yeshua doing this? He's not doing this to have a bad day; He's seeking to save the lost!

He already opened up with the declaration, "I'm the light of the World, I'm calling all men unto Me." As we share right now and witness the testimony of how Yeshua has called us unto Him and the victory we have in Yeshua. "He is my help and deliverance, glory, glory, Hallelujah! We bless Your Holy Name."

I am so blessed at the work of the Messiah within my life because now I can minister the help of God to the broken-hearted. I can reach out because I have something in my tank to offer to those in need. I can bring people to the place and say, "Yeshua, He's the light of the World; you don't have to be in darkness. I was once in darkness, and I gave my life to Yeshua. I'm walking in His ways, and He set me free. He's transformed me. I'm offering you that same thing; the way I walked in deliverance is open to you today."

Recognize The Dangers Of Sin

So, Yeshua is not slowing down; He's dealing with these Pharisees and religious leaders filled with their laws. Isn't it interesting when He addresses them concerning the law? What does He say?

Verse 17, "In your own law it is written that the testimony of two witnesses is true." He says, "You are so full of the law that you should see who I am in your law."

Are you identifying yourself with that religious Spirit? Where do you stand, where are you, and what do we see?

Verse 21, "Once more Yeshua said to them, "I am going away, and you will look for Me, and you will die in your sin. Where I go, you cannot come." Here's a message of urgency, and this is something we have to minister in the area of "help" concerning others.

Listen! Don't delay deciding for Yeshua-choose life, choose Him today.

Please don't allow yourself to yield to temptation, as we saw in Hebrews chapter 13. We saw, "Ohh, brotherly love, everything's good, and then all of a sudden, this word of warning about how you conduct yourself, how you live your life."

I'll never forget the young man who was the Teen Challenge mascot in the UK. He had been delivered from drugs, transformed, and part of the leadership team, totally delivered. He ministered within Teen Challenge for several years. He then left Teen Challenge to work with the ministry in Wales.

While in Wales, he rented a room in a shared house. Everything was good in that shared house until someone moved out, and the other room was rented to a drug addict.

This young man had been delivered from drugs and was a preacher of the Gospel, having been restored. One day he came home, and the guy who was a drug addict was shooting up some heroin. He said to him, "Come on, just have one shot," That one shot of heroin had rat poison in it, which killed the young man.

I'll never forget being down at that morgue praying for him to be raised from the dead because his life had been taken from him. He died too young.

Recognize the danger of sin and what it can do to you. Ensure you have protection built into your life. The fear of Yehovah protects us.

Don't Delay

In this portion of Scripture, Yeshua is speaking to the not-yet saved and rebellious.

He's talking to those who haven't received Him, saying, "I am going away, and you will look for Me, and you will die in your sin. Where I go, you cannot come." "You are separated from Me; you can't come to where I am, you will die in your sin."

Hear the word of Yehovah, "We need to receive Him, we need to humbly come to Him no matter where we are within our life, help is on the way."

His help is right here, right now. The question is whether your pride is so high that you can't receive help from Yehovah. Do you want to take that moment and receive from Him?

Then do that, right here, right now, don't wait another moment. You don't know what tomorrow has in store."

"Where I go, you can't come." If you haven't come to that place of salvation, "Where I go, you can't come." So, this is the day of salvation, the hour of salvation. For us who are believers in Messiah, it's amazing how the word "salvation" and the word "deliverance" are the same. He is the God who delivers us. He is the one who makes a way.

Verse 22, "This made the Jews ask, "Will He kill himself? Is that why He says, 'Where I go, you cannot come?"

Verse 23, "But He continued, "You are from below; I am from above. You are of this world; I am not of this world." Let's just put the point further down your throat, clearer and further down your throats.

Verse 24, "I told you that you would die in your sins; if you do not believe that I am He, you will indeed die in your sins."

How powerful is this? "I've told you that you will die in your sins if you don't believe me."

This is important when we minister to the broken-hearted. We must tell them, "Listen, seek help from Yehovah, help is on the way; it's right here in Yeshua the Messiah.

Come to the saving knowledge of Yeshua. Don't get to that place where you die in your sins because you reject who He is."

"You will indeed die in your sins," Yeshua said, and what was their response?

Verse 25, "Who are You?" they asked. That's a very interesting question, "Who are You?"

If you don't know who Yeshua is, how can you receive Him, identity with Him, and who He is?

Who Is Yeshua, Jesus To You?

This is what we want to express when we minister to the lost. How Yeshua has helped us, who He is to us, and the blessing of sharing that testimony with others.

Who is Yeshua, Jesus to you? "Well, He's someone I read about and pray to."

Take time to meditate on this question, who is Yeshua to me??

Is He the One who brought deliverance?

Is He the One that you're born again of the Spirit and washed with His blood?

Is He the One that paid the price for you?

Is He the One that you walk with every day by the power of the Holy Spirit?

Victory In Yeshua

Verse 25, "Who are You?" they asked. Just what I have been telling you from the beginning," Yeshua replied.

Verse 26, "I have much to say in judgment of you. But He who sent Me is trustworthy, and what I have heard from Him I tell the world."

Verse 27, "They did not understand that He was telling them about His Father."

Verse 28, "So Yeshua said, "When you have lifted up the Son of Man, then you will know that I am He and that I do nothing on My own but speak just what the Father has taught Me."

Verse 29, "The One who sent Me is with Me; He has not left Me alone, for I always do what pleases Him." We have the testimony today of Yeshua. He didn't just die but was raised from the dead. Hallelujah! "Death has no sting." We see victory in Yeshua.

John3:16, "For God so loved the world that He gave His One and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."

As we look at the area of help within our lives today, I want you to identify testimonies within your life where you have seen the help of God and where He has delivered you.

I've shared a couple of things, and I still have mountains of testimonies that I could share. We could talk for days, weeks, and months about all the places and times when Yehovah has helped me through the power of the Spirit.

So, take a moment to pray. "Father, as we take this moment right now, I want to ask You, 'Who do I need to share with today, about Your help and Your love?

Listen to what the Spirit is saying to you today. Be bold, be strong, for Yehovah is with you!

Rise Up

Where is the body of Messiah that will rise and speak forth the word of Yehovah to a broken and hurting generation? This is how we see salvation and people rescued.

People don't have to die in their sin, but if they don't have a preacher or someone come and speak to them, maybe they will never have that connection through Yeshua.

John 14:6, "Yeshua answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

This might not mean much to you if you don't understand the connection between the Father and the Son. But here in Israel, when you talk to the religious Jews and you tell them, "You have no covenant with God because you deny the Messiah," it's a very real word that is very powerful to people here in the land.

As I share with religious Jews that word, it's amazing the response that I get and how people are open with a listening ear to hear the foundation of the Gospel of Yeshua of Nazareth. Hallelujah!

That feeling that you're feeling right now where you're feeling like— what's going on within your heart?

That's the conviction of the Holy Spirit.

He is saying, "I love you; I care for you. I want you to experience the fullness of joy found in Me, says Yehovah." Hallelujah!

Allow the Holy Spirit to minister to you right now, open your heart, and allow His words to wash over you, cleansing you and setting you free.



"Look Out For One Another"

The Word clearly states how we should treat each other in the Body of Messiah.

"A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another." another. By this everyone will know that you are My disciples, if you love one another."

John 13:35

After many days had gone by, there was a conspiracy among the Jews to kill him, but Saul learned of their plan. Day and night they kept close watch on the city gates in order to kill him. But his followers took him by night and lowered him in a basket through an opening in the wall."

Another example is in Acts 2:45, "They sold property and possessions to give to anyone in need." We know we don't want to control or manipulate people into doing what we think is right because we are called to work out our own salvation with fear and trembling. But we are called to walk together in peace and harmony and be ready to help a brother or sister out in their time of need. Esther

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
