Firstly, let's establish YESHUA, ONE WAY TO SALVATION

"I AM THE WAY AND THE TRUTH AND THE LIFE"

Our focus in Part 3 is to identify key areas of transformation within our lives concerning salvation so we can rehearse together to strengthen our witness.

What are some of the critical areas we should share with others concerning our salvation?

We're going to be looking at "Salvation One Way," and you might think this is an introductory discussion or something that should be very simple. The reality is in today's world, for those who follow Yeshua, Jesus, no matter what stream you're coming from, there are many different points of view.

We must return to the Word, standing on its promises, and see that come to pass. We identify our salvation from the Scriptures. There is only ONE WAY. You cannot get to the Father any other way than through Yeshua, Jesus, and I hope this is your belief too.

Prayer

Let's take a moment to pray, and then we'll delve into the Word. Let's pray this is a refreshing time as we identify what the Father has done in our life. Every day we want to make sure that we take time for a personal challenge by praying for those around us who are not yet saved and asking the Holy Spirit for opportunities to share our faith with others.

"So, we ask Father, as we take time in the Word that You will empower us by Your Spirit, that we won't just be listening to a talking head, but we will engage together in Your Word and fellowship. I pray, Father, that You will shine Your light on Your Word. That You will shine Your light upon our lives as we give glory to You for what You have done in our lives. Hallelujah! For salvation, thank You, Father! for saving me, and let that be your prayer. Father, we rejoice in what You have done within our lives, and as we spend time together, we ask Father for You to quicken to us those who are not yet saved that we could be ministering to. As we refresh our walk with You through the Scriptures, may You empower us to be effective in evangelism and reach out to make a difference for Your Kingdom, in Yeshua's name. Hallelujah!"

We Must Be Born Again

I want to open up in John 3 and read from *John 3:14-15, "Just as Moses lifted up the snake in the wilderness, so the Son of Man must be lifted up, that everyone who believes may have eternal life in Him." Hallelujah.*

We see in John 3 that Nicodemus, the teacher of the law, comes to Yeshua in the evening, and Yeshua says, "You must be born again." He said, "I want to teach you about being born again of the Spirit." Listen, the devil believes in Elohim, in Yeshua, and that doesn't mean he's saved. We've got to be born again and recognize who Yeshua is, that He is the only way to salvation. We also want to acknowledge how much Yehovah loves the world. It's crucial that we see the deliverance plan that the Father lays out within the Word.

So, in John 3, we read in Verses 14-15. You can see even in the time of Moses and the children of Israel coming out of Egypt, "the Son of Man must be lifted up," so everyone may see Him and believe in Him just as the snake was lifted up in the desert.

Verses 16-21 "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send His Son into the world to condemn the world, but to save the world through Him. Whoever believes in Him is not condemned, but whoever does not believe stands condemned already because they have not believed in the name of God's one and only Son. Jesus Teaches Nicodemus

"Now there was a Pharisee, a man named Nicodemus who was a member of the Jewish ruling council. He came to Yeshua, Jesus at night and said, "Rabbi, we know that You are a teacher who has come from God. For no one could perform the signs You are doing if God were not with Him."

Yeshua, Jesus replied, "Very truly I tell you, no one can see the Kingdom of God unless they are born again."

"How can someone be born when they are old?" Nicodemus asked. "Surely they cannot enter a second time into their mother's womb to be born!"

Yeshua, Jesus answered, "Very truly I tell you, no one can enter the Kingdom of God unless they are born of water and the Spirit. Flesh gives birth to flesh, but the Spirit gives birth to spirit. You should not be surprised at My saying, 'You must be born again.' The wind blows wherever it pleases. You hear its sound, but you cannot tell where it comes from or where it is going. So it is with everyone born of the Spirit."

"How can this be?" Nicodemus asked.

"You are Israel's teacher," said Yeshua, Jesus, "and do you not understand these things? Very truly I tell you, we speak of what we know, and we testify to what we have seen, but still you people do not accept our testimony. I have spoken to you of earthly things and you do not believe; how then will you believe if I speak of heavenly things?

So, we've got to come to the place of coming into the light. I want you to think about the day of your salvation, the day you were transformed. We can also look back at times when you've backslidden and fallen away and when you've seen the restoration of your faith.

You might be watching right now, and you're not in the right place with Elohim; you might be backslidden, you might have stepped out of the purposes and the will of Yehovah. I pray as we go through this time in the Word that you will come on fire and re-dedicate your life to Yeshua, Jesus, and the faith.

Kenny's Backsliding Testimony

One point I want to speak on for a moment is when people sometimes feel like they can't come back because of what they have done and how they've lived their lives.

Well, I've got my own backsliding story to share. I walked away from Elohim when I was fifteen. I said, "God, I'm not walking away because I don't love You. I'm walking away because I'm trying to identify who I am and if I have had a real experience with Yeshua, with the Messiah. Why can't I find other testimonies of people who truly know Elohim's voice?"

It says in the Word, "My sheep know My voice." How do we follow the orders and the walk of faith if we're not walking by the Spirit and the voice of Elohim? We need to know the voice of Elohim, and that voice comes to us by the voice of the Spirit. Do we hear the Holy Spirit speaking to us regularly? Some people hear audible voices from time to time, but you know the Spirit speaks to us in that still small voice and gives us direction and understanding. We've got to get to that place where we understand the voice of the Spirit and how He communicates to us. When we are reading the Word, we're not just going through the information but also through revelation. The Word comes alive to us so that we can walk in the fullness of the Word.

So, I was 15 and persecuted for my faith. I heard the voice of the Holy Spirit and ministered the love of the Holy Spirit daily. I shared my faith and witnessed to people every single day. I heard the Spirit give me words of encouragement and things to say.

This is what I love about being a witness and witnessing Yeshua; every time we communicate, we don't want to speak from the basis of a script, "12 Steps to Salvation." We want to identify the people we share with are important to Elohim. We want to be engaged in conversation and be led by the Spirit on how to witness and share our faith with others but first, we want to identify how the Holy Spirit has dealt with us.

I had that saving experience of salvation when I was 11 years old. It was a radical encounter with Elohim, which I shared in Part one.

But then I was in a place of backsliding at fifteen years old; I walked away from God. I was thinking, "Is this all in my head? Is it real? Am I truly hearing the voice of the Spirit?"

Some people were saying, "What do you mean you hear the voice of the Spirit? That's very prideful to say you hear the voice of the Spirit," but as we read the Scriptures, it says, "My sheep know My voice."

It's about being in a relationship with the Father. The Comforter will come as we see in John chapter 14:26, "But the Advocate, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, will teach you all things and remind you of everything I have said to you. "It is all about a relationship, so why shouldn't we hear the voice of the Spirit? Every day when we get up and come into the presence of Yehovah, are we expecting to receive from the Holy Spirit?

Maybe you come to your devotional time each day, read through a different book or something that someone else has done, say, "Amen," at the end, and walk away to start your day.

Did you genuinely receive, and were you listening, taking the time to meditate and pray, "Father, speak to me through your Word."

I want to encourage you to get to that place of hearing the voice of the Spirit if you will be effective in witnessing and sharing your faith with others—we want to make that proper connection in the Spirit. We want to be those who have a listening ear so that our conversation is laced with the glory of Yehovah. We can speak those words, and maybe those spiritual gifts will be activated. You'll have a word of knowledge and insight from the Holy Spirit on what to say and how to minister directly to that person.

We saw Yeshua when He looked at the crowd and had compassion. He said, "They are sheep without a shepherd." He wanted to bring forth His life to them. He had compassion for the crowd. When we look at people who are not saved, do we have compassion for them? Do you care if we will evangelize and share our faith effectively? We've got to care and have our eyes open to see.

So, I was fifteen years old and saw many signs, wonders, and miracles in my youth, transformation by the Spirit. I heard the voice of Elohim speaking to me by the Spirit every day and on an ongoing basis. That was my life, that's what I walked in, but then people were like, "What do you mean? That doesn't sound normal," but when I go to the Scriptures, yes, it is normal. It is how we should be walking, and I encourage everyone to know how to be devoted in His presence.

The devil used to come to me every day and say, "Imagine serving God your whole life and finding out He is not real," so, I would say, "Devil, that's no temptation. Imagine not serving God your whole life and finding out He is real. I know what's better."

So, that very thing that was no temptation became a temptation to me four years after I had been walking in the Spirit from eleven to fifteen years old.

I said, "God, I'm not walking away from You because I don't love You. It's because I don't know who I am. I can't find a witness and a testimony of people living this life, walking in the Spirit."

I found many sincere Christian believers who prayed, loved, cared, and were genuine in their faith but why weren't people seeking to honestly know the voice of the Spirit like I was walking in? People were condemning me for that walk.

Still, to this day, I hear testimonies and feedback of people who mock others for claiming to hear the voice of the Spirit and the need to listen to the voice of the Spirit each day. We are in a relationship, and I want to encourage you to get to that place with Yehovah.

So, for two years, between the age of fifteen to seventeen, I walked and lived a worldly existence. I didn't serve God, and I didn't pray. I was thinking, "Maybe, because I was brought up in a Christian home in a faith environment, I'm brainwashed. I need to know the reality of God."

But on the sports field that day at school, I said," God, I'm walking away from You. I'm not walking away because I don't love You, God. I'm walking away because I want to discover Your reality. I permit You to reveal Yourself to me, and I will serve You throughout my life."

I served the devil notice, "If I find the living reality of Elohim, the living reality of God, I will come after you to the nations of the world, and you'll wish you never messed with me." Then I walked off that school soccer pitch in the drizzling rain. I'll never forget that day.

Then I just lived my life; I didn't feel any unction to pray, the Holy Spirit left me, and I was on my own. I was drinking most days and smoking cigarettes, doing all the stuff that goes along with living life in the music industry. I was hanging out in the pubs and living a Godless life without God.

So, at seventeen, I was doing what I normally did on the weekends- pub crawling, drinking, engaged in the

world's way of life. Then one night I was in the pub, plastered out my box as we call it in Scotland because I had been drinking most of the day. I had ordered ten double Pernod's with blackcurrant liqueurs to finish the day off and while I was throwing them back, all of a sudden, boom! It's like a bomb went off, a flash, something happened instantly and I become sober. I heard the voice of the Holy Spirit for the first time in two years. He said, "Look around, they're all hurting and crying out saying, 'Please somebody help me.' Look at what you once had and look at what you now have, it is time for you to come home." Wow! What an encounter and as I looked around, the Holy Spirit began showing me what was going on in the lives of my friends and the people around me. All of a sudden I came alive in the Spirit and realised that this was an encounter with the living God. I was being transformed by the power of God. No man was intervening or witnessing to me, I was being supernaturally transformed in that moment. I walked out of that pub completely sober in my right mind and supernaturally transformed.

From the age of seventeen to this very moment, I have served Yehovah faithfully in every way that I know how from that day onwards. I was supernaturally changed and yes I've held to that word, "I'll serve you, Yehovah, all the days of my life," and "Devil, you better watch out!"

I have gone to the nations and preached the gospel causing havoc in the kingdom of hell because Yeshua the Messiah is alive! Hallelujah. Praise the name of Yeshua. He is alive!

I'm not encouraging you to backslide or think, "If I don't have this encounter," No, I'm just telling you my testimony and the journey God took me on. I don't encourage you to be separated from God while trying to work things out. I encourage you to delve into the Word to grow in God, to be His disciples and to experience the richness and fullness of Yehovah. I understood that day that I almost lost my calling and if I did not come back to Yeshua my life calling would have been over. We are all born for such a time as this and let's not miss the destiny Elohim has for us!

There Is Only One Way

John 14:6, "Jesus answered, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me." We want to establish the importance that there is only one way to the Father.

In the fellowship we were in today they were preaching and ministering from Matthew 23. As I was listening to the seven woes in this portion of scripture we see how Yeshua was speaking to and debating with the religious. He's was bringing forth a message before He came to the place of crucifixion.

In John chapters 14,15 and 16, we see Yeshua dealing with His disciples and speaking instructions to them. I want to go to an interesting scripture where Yeshua is dealing with those Pharisees.

In verse 13, we've got seven or eight woes depending if you include verse 14 into it as some manuscripts don't have verse14.

Matthew 23:13, "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You shut the door of the Kingdom of heaven in people's faces. You yourselves do not enter, nor will you let those enter who are trying to." Yeshua is getting it very clear that there is only one way for salvation and, "your way, oh Pharisees is not the right way."

Verse 15, "Woe to you, teachers of the law and Pharisees, you hypocrites! You travel over land and sea to win a single convert, and when you have succeeded, you make them twice as much a child of hell as you are." Yeshua is going straight for the jugular here and making it very clear to them, "You reject me and you don't listen to Moses then I'm going to deal with you on the level that you need to be dealt with," and for what purpose? To open their eyes to see the truth of the Gospel.

The reason why Yeshua was so direct is that some may come to salvation, that people will realise who He is. There is only one Way!

"Because you disobey Moses in Deuteronomy 18:15, 'The Lord your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your fellow Israelites. You must listen to him' or you will be completely cut off." Paraphrase mine.

This is the confidence we have in sharing the Gospel of Yeshua and knowing we are saved. This is a narrow road. We don't walk the Kingdom on a wide road, it's a narrow road.

I remember one Jewish man saying to me, "Don't talk to me about this Jesus stuff. He's not the Messiah." So I shared Jeremiah 32 with him.

It's an interesting scripture and I believe that this scripture in Jeremiah 32:39 is linked to *John 14:6, "I'm the way the truth and the life no one comes to the Father except through Me."* But first in *Jeremiah 32:27, "I am the Lord, the God of all mankind. Is anything too hard for me?"*

As we read in Matthew chapter 23 what we see is something that's really quite unusual. Yeshua is addressing the Pharisees who were engaging in travelling over land and sea for converts. It's a rarity to see Jewish people today going out trying to convert the Goyim, those of the nations to Judaism.

In modern day Judaism today if you say you want to convert to Judaism, the process you go through according to the Rabbinic order today, is that the Rabbi is going to deny you on a number of occasions. He's going to try and convince you that you don't want to convert to Judaism because he wants to do everything to stop you from converting. He wants you to experience the same rejection that was experienced in the Holocaust and the same rejection Jews have experienced throughout history. The purpose behind this is that if you stick around and you're still there one year later then maybe you could be a true Jew, maybe this is the right path for you.

At that point, they'll start to embrace you as you go through the process of becoming accepted and convert to Judaism.

That's not what we see in the Gospel. We see a God who loves the world and wants the Gospel of salvation to go to the whole world.

Jeremiah 32:27, "I am the Lord, the God of all mankind. Is anything too hard for me?" and this takes us back to John 3:16," For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life."

This gospel is not limited just to one group of people, it is for whoever believes in Him. Yes, we are grafted into Israel but not into Judaism. We are grafted into the Commonwealth of Israel as we read in the book of Ephesians. Hallelujah! Praise the name of the Yeshua.

This is the word I shared with the Jewish man that night in North Carolina, Charlotte, the one who was offended by faith in Yeshua, "How can you believe in Yeshua, He's another god, another message." I said, "Listen, the very fact that Jesus, Yeshua says that there is only one way to the Father should confirm to a Jew that this is the Messiah talking because it says in *Jeremiah 32:39, 'I will give them singleness of heart and action, so that they will always fear me and that all will then go well for them and for their children after them."*

I love the Scripture Bible translation, it says, "And I shall give them one heart and one way." Oh Hallelujah! Put a mark in your bibles in that part of scripture and how that relates to Yeshua.

John 14:6, "I am the way and the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me." We see that singleness of heart, there's only one way. You cannot be saved any other way.

We've got organisations out there that talk about dual covenants and saying you don't have to preach to the Jews, just get them home. They're in covenant, God will deal with them directly. There's a covenant for them and there's a covenant for others. No! there's only one Gospel, one way and that way is in Yeshua. Hallelujah!

So, I want us to really celebrate the blessing of the singleness of heart and actions as we rejoice in Yeshua.

Repent And Turn Around

Let's go to Acts 4 and read the testimony there. They were talking about the time of persecution, and Peter, filled with the Spirit, started speaking. Peter 4:12, "Salvation is found in no one else, for there is no other name under heaven given to mankind by which we must be saved." This should be our boldness in

recognizing that we are only saved through Yeshua.

You might be at a place right now, and if you're in a backslidden state, it is time to repent and turn around, "teshuvah" in Hebrew. Meaning to come back to who the Father is called you to be, to be aligned to the will and purpose of Yehovah and salvation.

Repent is what I did in that pub when I had that encounter with Yeshua. He sobered me up by the Spirit and said, "It is time for you to come home."

This may be a word for you right now if you are out of place with Elohim. "It is time for you to come home," says Yehovah, "Come home, come back to who the Father has called you to be."

When that happened to me and I walked out of that pub, I didn't just say glory glory Hallelujah; I came to a place of repentance. "Father, I have done wrong. I identify what You're saying to me; I repent of my sins, I want to be kept in short account with You, I want to have the blood of Jesus washing me, cleansing me. I want to serve you all the days of my life."

Salvation is one way; there's no other name under heaven by which you can be saved.

Yeshua, Our Mediator

I've heard people talk about the scripture of being "unequally yoked," and have said it's ok for them to be yoked with the Jews that deny Yeshua. It doesn't matter if it's a Karaite Jew, a Jew in Judaism or just a Jew that follows the Torah; you cannot be yoked or unequally yoked outside Messiah.

To be yoked is through the Messiah only, through Yeshua HaMachiach.

We have got to experience who He is, and we've got to be found in Him. Hallelujah.

1Timothy 2:5-7, "For there is one God and one Mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, who gave Himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed at the proper time. And for this purpose, I was appointed a Herald and an Apostle—I am telling the truth, I am not lying—and a true and faithful teacher of the Gentiles."

So, Timothy is saying there's one Mediator between God and man, and that's Yeshua, the Messiah. So, you can't just come to salvation through your Catholic priest, baptism in Catholicism, child baptism, the faith of your parents or just because you grew up in a local assembly.

You would be surprised at how many children of those who are saved have thought that they are saved because they have been brought up in this environment. No, you have got to come to a place where you acknowledge Yeshua individually and decide. It is your decision, not the decision of your parents or family members.

I choose to accept and declare that Yeshua is Lord, and we must make that decision before others. So, there's only one Mediator between Elohim and man, and it's Yeshua, the Messiah. We want to stand upon His promises.

We'll bounce around a few scriptures on the importance of "How there is no other way." I love how Yeshua talks. He is saying, "You have got to come through Me. If you don't come through Me, you are not worthy of Me," and boy did he lay into those Pharisees. "You convert people with your method, making them twice the sons of hell as you are. You have a false message; your Father is "hassatan", satan, not God." John 10:7-10, "Therefore Yeshua, Jesus said again, "Very truly I tell you, I am the gate for the sheep. All who have come before Me are thieves and robbers, but the sheep have not listened to them. I am the gate; whoever enters through Me will be saved. They will come in and go out and find pasture. The thief comes only to steal and kill and destroy; I have come that they may have life and have it to the full."

Take a moment to recognize what Yeshua has done in your life. Are you thankful for salvation and for what Yeshua has done for you? Will you be a witness and testimony to others and minister the love of Yeshua to the brokenhearted?

First, we've got to identify if we have compassion for the needs of others and if we accept what Yeshua has done in our lives or has the salvation message becomes old, "Yawn, yawn. Oh... In my faith, I'm further

down the road to the salvation message." Interestingly, many people get upset with fellowships who are constantly preaching the salvation message so that people may be saved. It's like, "Oh, we don't need that anymore; we're past that." Then there are people within their fellowships who are not saved because we are not paying attention to the importance of the salvation message.

This is why my heart is to mobilize the body of the Messiah to be effective in our witness. My heart is that we get to that place where we recognize and can say, "Yeshua, I want to take Your Word to this broken world. I want to take Your promises to this generation."

Yeshua says that He has died for our sins, and we have to believe who He is. Do you believe today that Yeshua died and paid that price?

What a blessing it is when we celebrate during the Passover to look to Yeshua as our Passover lamb and be able to say, "Yeshua, You have paid the price," We want to take time to remember and celebrate the victory of what Yeshua has done for us, especially during that time.

We Are Called To Spread The Good News

Roman 10:14-15, "How, then, can they call on the One they have not believed in? And how can they believe in the One of whom they have not heard? And how can they hear without someone preaching to them? And how can anyone preach unless they are sent? As it is written: "How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news!"

This scripture is taken from *Isaiah 52:7, "How beautiful on the mountains are the feet of those who bring good news, who proclaim peace, who bring good tidings, who proclaim salvation, who say to Zion, "Your God reigns!"* Hallelujah! How beautiful are the feet of those who bring good news.

That brings us to Ephesians and what we love about Ephesians is we see Paul outlining the gospel. As we go through Ephesians 1-6, we see that the gospel that Paul is teaching is the same as Yeshua's. *Ephesians 6:15, "...and with your feet fitted with the readiness that comes from the gospel of peace."* is part of the armor of God so we want our feet shod with the gospel of peace.

Do you find it easy to share your faith? Do you like to share your faith and testimony with others? Do you want to reach out to the brokenhearted because we want to get to where it is our passion to share our faith with others? We should desire to seek opportunities to share our faith daily, and that's what I want us to get to.

Praying For Others

There may be someone you know that is looking for salvation through other ways like New Age practises like yoga or martial arts. You might be thinking, "What's wrong with yoga? Don't you know there is Christian yoga?" Listen, you can never have Christian yoga because every position within yoga is a position of worship to a foreign God.

So, it doesn't matter if you're playing Christian music or enjoying worship music; while you're doing these acts, you're in rebellion and need to repent.

There's only one way to the Father, and that is through Yeshua.

"Yeshua, we thank You for what You have done in our lives; we want to walk in Your ways," My prayer tonight is that we will hear from heaven that He will allow us to share our faith today. Who do you need to talk to? Are you praying for those who are not yet saved, praying for the lost? Do you have a list of people you're praying for that you can minister to, to reach for the Gospel? Hallelujah! Just take a moment and ask the Holy Spirit to speak to you. I pray that you will be given an opportunity to share

with those people that are coming to your mind right now.

"Father, we ask that the veil be taken from their eyes. We ask Father that You will grant them faith and grace to receive you. They will have ears to hear and eyes to see, and they will be able to hear the gospel message and respond to it as we share our faith with others. Father, we worship You; we thank You for salvation. We thank You, Yeshua, that there is only one way, and that way is through the execution stake of Yeshua." Hallelujah

Time To Share And Encourage

Salvation belongs to our God. Hallelujah! Let's be those who make a decision; it's time to be a witness. It's time to share the Gospel of Yeshua and encourage people who are not saved because they have not prayed and accepted Yeshua as their Lord and Saviour. Please encourage them to do it today because you don't know how many days you have on the earth. You don't know if this is your last week or day; you might not even wake up tomorrow. Explain to them that this is the day of salvation, the hour of deliverance.

Romans 13:11, "And do this, understanding the present time: The hour has already come for you to wake up from your slumber, because our salvation is nearer now than when we first believed."

Maybe you're in that place right now, and you've come across this message on social media link, and you're thinking, "Yes! I need salvation, Yeshua save me."

Take this moment to repent and turn around and pray, "Yeshua, I want to understand the fullness of your Gospel; I want to receive the Son. I recognize Yeshua that you died on the cross. You paid the price so that I may be saved. "Take this moment right now to be saved and receive salvation.

Suppose you've prayed to the Father through the Son and accepted Yeshua. In that case, I want you to understand it's not just about praying a prayer, and everything will be hunky dory. No, you've got to commit, lay your life down, and choose to serve the God of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob.

From this day forward, your life is not your own; this is a serious decision. It's not just about agreeing with a message; it's a lifetime commitment. "I'm going to serve you, God, all the days of my life."

If you're in a backslidden state and you're listening right now, and as we're sharing about the only way, the one way, Yeshua, that singleness of heart, that singleness of action, and you're saying, "That's not where I'm at, I'm divided. I'm not serious with my walk with Yeshua."

Maybe you're caught up in religion and go through religious practices, and your faith is dead. You don't know the voice of Elohim. Then call on his name, repent, come back to him today and say, "From this day forward, I'm going to serve you Yehovah, I'm going to walk in your ways, I'm going to walk in the promises of Elohim for my life, through Yeshua today." Hallelujah.

Reflection

I can't wait to see what the Father will do in my life and your life as we are being refreshed with what it truly means to be saved. Think about what He has done in your life.

I think about how I recommitted my life back to God and the transformation. I look at that journey from that encounter with the Holy Spirit and where He has taken me for the last thirty-plus years. What journey have I been on because I chose to walk out of that pub sober and rededicate my life back to Yeshua?

Even though I had that Damascus road experience and that encounter, I could've been rebellious and said, "No," to God. The question of the Holy Spirit was, "It's time for you to come home."

You'll miss your entire destiny if you don't come home now. I look back at these years of what the Father has done in my life. I rejoice at the hundreds of thousands, millions of people I've had the privilege of ministering to on television networks and radio platforms, traveling and speaking worldwide, sharing, encouraging, and seeing salvation, deliverance, and healing. Look what God has done and I sit back today and rejoice, but life is not over; we're still pressing on this journey.

May we flame the gifts that the Father has given us, that we will be effective in our witness and our testimony for the glory of Yehovah.
